## DESIGN

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## YARN

NATURAL LANOLIN WOOL 100\% pure new wool,
50 grams = approx. 100 metres

Alternative yarns: MERINO 22, LERKE, ØKO COTTON

## SIZES

XS (S) M (L) XL

## GARMENT MEASUREMENTS

Chest size approx. 92 (100) 108 (116) 124 cm
Full length approx. 58 (60) 62 (64) 66 cm
Sleeve-length approx. 46 cm (in all sizes)

## YARN AMOUNTS

11 (12) 13 (15) 16 balls

## COLOURS

Raspberry 1447

## SUGGESTED NEEDLE SIZE

Short and long circular needles and double pointed needles size 3 mm and 4 mm .
Extra needle

## KNITTING TENSION

22 sts with stocking st and needle size $4 \mathrm{~mm}=10 \mathrm{~cm}$ 24 sts cable-knit and needle size $4 \mathrm{~mm}=10 \mathrm{~cm}$

Check your knitting tension by working a swatch. Count the number of sts per 10 cm ; if you have more sts than suggested change to a larger needle size. If you have less sts, change to a smaller needle size.

## FIND THE RIGHT SIZE

1. Measure a garment that fits you
2. Compare the measurements with the pattern.
3. Choose your size from the width of the body.
4. Length of body and sleeves; you can work them longer or shorter if you wish

## ABBREVIATIONS

$K=$ knit, $P=$ purl, st. $=$ stitch, $r=$ row

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HOLE BORDER
Round 1: P.
Rounds 2 and 3: $K$.
Round 4: *1 yarn over, K2 together*. Repeat from *-*
Rounds 5 and 6: K.
Round 7: P

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## DIAGRAM






 $K 1:$ wow

BODY
Cast on 202 (220) 238 (256) 272 sts with circular needle size 3 mm.
Work 7 rounds of hole border in the round. Change to needle size 4 mm and work stocking st.
Insert a marker in each side with 101 (110) 119 (128) 136 sts on both the front and back pieces. Work until the piece measures approx 39 (40) 41 (42) 43 cm. Increase 2 (2) 2 (2) 4 sts evenly spaced $=102$ (111) 120 (129) 138 sts on each piece. Cast off 12 sts on each side ( $=6$ sts on each side of the markers) for the armholes $=90$ (99) 108 (117) 126 sts on each piece. Lay the piece to one side and work the sleeves.

## SLEEVES

Cast on 52 (52) 55 (58) 58 sts with double pointed needles size 3 mm .

Work 7 rounds of hole border in the round. Change to needle size 4 mm and work stocking st. Insert a marker at beginning of round.
Increase 2 sts under the sleeve every 2.5 (2.5) 2 (2) 2 cm until you have 84 (84) 93 (102) 102 sts. Work until the sleeve measures 46 cm (in all sizes). Cast off 12 sts under the sleeve (= 6 sts on each side of marker) $=72$ (72) 81 (90) 90 sts. Lay the piece to one side and work the other sleeve.

## YOKE

Place all pieces on long circular needle size 4 mm . First left sleeve, then front piece, right sleeve and back piece $=324$ (342) 378 (414) 432 sts. The round starts back left shoulder. Work pattern according to diagram A approx. 4 (5) 6 (7) 8 cm . On the next round decrease 1 st in each purled section by purling the first 2 sts together $=288$ (304) 336 (368) 384 sts. Continue with 1 cable, P4, approx. 3 cm (same in all sizes). On the next round decrease 1 st in each purled section by purling the first 2 sts together $=252$ (266) 294 (322) 336 sts. Continue with 1 cable, P3, approx. 3 cm (same in all sizes). On the next round decrease 1 st in each purled section by purling the first 2 sts together $=216$ (228) 252 (276) 288 sts. Continue with 1 cable, P2, approx. 3 cm (same in all sizes). On the next round decrease 1 st in each purled section by purling the first 2 sts together $=180$ (190) 210 (230) 240 sts. Continue with 1 cable, P1, approx. 3 cm (same in all sizes). On the next round work as follows: *K2 together (= P1 + 1 st from cable), K3*, repeat from *_* $=144$ (152) 168 (184) 192 sts.
Continue with just cables approx 3 cm (same in all sizes)
NOTE! Change to needle size $3 \mathrm{~mm}, \mathrm{~K} 1$ round, at the same
time decrease $0(0) 8(16) 16$ sts evenly spaced $=144$ (152) 160 (168) 176 sts.
Work 7 rounds of hole border. Cast off with P, making sure the cast-off edge is not tight.

## ASSEMBLY

Sew together under the sleeves.
