## DESIGN

YARN
MYK PÅFUGL 73 \% mohair, 22 \% wool, 5 \% polyamide, 50 grams $=90$ metres

## SIZES

S (M) L (XL) XXL
NOTE! See GARMENT MEASUREMENTS to find the right size

## GARMENT MEASUREMENTS

Chest measurements approx. 91 (99) 107 (117) 129 cm
Full length approx. 55 (57) 59 (61) 63 cm
Sleeve length approx. 51 (51) 51 (51) 52 cm

## YARN AMOUNTS

7 (8) 8 (9) 10 balls

## COLOURS

Pink 7946

## SUGGESTED NEEDLE SIZES

5.5 and 7 mm long and short circular needles and DPNs

## ACCESSORIES

10 buttons

## KNITTING TENSION

12 sts with stocking st on 7 mm needles $=10 \mathrm{~cm}$

## Check your knitting tension by working a swatch

 Count the number of sts per 10 cm if you have more sts than suggested, change to a larger needle size. If you have fewer sts, change to a smaller needle size.
## FIND THE RIGHT SIZE

1. Measure a garment that fits you
2. Compare the measurements with the pattern.
3. Choose your size from the chest measurements.
4. Body and sleeves can be worked longer or shorter as needed.

## ABBREVIATIONS

$K=$ knit, $P=$ purl, st $=$ stitch, $y / \mathrm{o}=$ yarn over,
DPN = double pointed needles, tbl = through back loop

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## FRONT AND BACK PIECES

Cast on 116 (126) 136 (146) 161 sts on 5.5 mm circular needle Work back and forth as follows:
Row 1: (wrong side) P7, P2 tbl, *K3, P2 tbl *, repeat from *_* until there are 7 sts left, P7.
Row 2: K7, K2 tbl, *P3 , K2 tbl*, repeat from *-* until there are 7 sts left, K7.
Repeat rows $1-2$ another 3 times, at the same time on row 4, work 2 buttonholes on the right band as follows (right side): K1, *slip 1 st knit-wise, K1, pass the slipped st over, 1 y/o, K2, 1 y/o, k2 together, knit to end of row.
Change to 7 mm needles and P 1 row from the wrong side,
at the same time as the st count is adjusted to 117 (125) 137 (147) 161 sts. Place a marker in each side, with 55 (59) 65 (71) 77 sts on the back piece and 31 (33) 36 (38) 42 sts on each front piece. Continue with stocking st. Work until the piece measures $7(7) 7(8) 8 \mathrm{~cm}$. Work buttonholes on the right band as before. Then work buttonholes every 5.5 (5.5) 5.5 (6) 6 cm , until there are 9 buttonholes. At the same time, when the piece measures 34 (35) 36 (37) 38 cm , divide the piece at the side markers and finish each piece separately

## BACK PIECE

$=55$ (59) 65 (71) 77 sts.
Continue with stocking st back and forth and cast off for the armholes at the beginning of each row, $3,2,1(3,2,1,1)$ $3,2,1,1(3,2,2,1) 3,3,2,1,1$ sts on each side $=43$ (45) 51 (55) 57 sts. Continue working until the piece measures 52 (54) 56 (58) 60 cm . Work diagonal shoulders by casting off at the beginning of each row, 4,3,2 (4,3,3) 4,4,4 (5,4,4) 5,4,4 sts on each side. NOTE! When the piece measures 53 (55) 57 (59) 61 cm , cast off the middle 21 (21) 23 (25) 27 sts for the neckline and finish each shoulder separately. Continue casting off for the neckline every 2nd row, 1,1 st. When all the neck and shoulder decreases are finished, all sts have been cast off. Work the other side in the same way but in reverse

## RIGHT FRONT PIECE

$=31$ (33) 36 (38) 42 sts.
Work back and forth and cast off for the armhole every 2nd row, 3,2,1 (3,2,1,1) 3,2,1,1 (3,2,2,1) 3,3,2,1,1 sts = 25 (26) 29 (30) 32 sts. Continue working until the piece measures 49 (51) 54 (55) 57 cm . NOTE! Remember to work the buttonholes as before. Place the 7 band sts on a st-holder. Cast off for the neck every 2nd row, 3,3,2,1 (3,3,2,1) 4,3,2,1 (4,3,2,1) 6,3,2,1 sts. NOTE! When the piece measures 52 (54) 56 (58) 60 cm , work diagonal shoulders by casting off from the armhole side every 2 nd row, $4,3,2(4,3,3) 4,4,4(5,4,4) 5,4,4$ sts. When all the neck and shoulder decreases are finished, all sts have been cast off. Work the left front piece in the same way but without the buttonholes.

## SLEEVES

Cast on 20 (20) 25 (25) 30 sts on 5.5 mm DPNs and work rib in the round for $10 \mathrm{~cm}(\mathrm{~K} 2 \mathrm{tbl}, \mathrm{P} 3)$. Change to 7 mm needles and continue with stocking st. At the same time, increase 16 (18) 15 (17) 16 sts evenly on round 1 (= 36 (38) 40 (42) 46 sts) and 14 (14) 12 (14) 12 sts evenly on round $3=$

50 (52) 52 (56) 58 sts. Continue with stocking st. When the sleeve measures 51 (51) 51 (51) 52 cm, cast off 4 (4) 4 (6) 6 sts mid-under the sleeve. Finish the sleeve cap back and forth. Cast off at the beginning of each row, 1,1 (1,1,1) 1,1,1 (2,1,1) 2,1,1,1 sts on each side $=42$ sts. Continue working without further decreases until the sleeve cap measures 16 (17) 18 (19) 20 cm . Finish with a row from the wrong side. Finish the sleeve cap as follows:
Row 1: Cast off 2 sts, K1, *place 3 sts on a needle in front of the piece and K1 st from the front needle together with 1 st from the back needle, 3 times (all sts on the front needle have been worked). Place 3 sts on a needle behind the piece, $K 1$ st from the front needle together with 1 st from the back needle 3 times*, repeat from*-* two more times, K3 = 22 sts.
Row 2: Cast off 2 sts, P to end of row.
Row 3: Cast off 1 st, move st on right needle back onto left needle.
*Slip 2 sts (as if to K together), K1, pass the slipped st over*, repeat from*-* 5 more times, K1 = 7 sts.
Row 4: Cast off 2 sts, P to end of row $=5$ sts. Cast off.

## ASSEMBLY

Join the shoulder seams and sew in the sleeves.

## NECK

Place sts from the st-holder on 5.5 mm circular needles and pick up 6 sts per 5 cm along the neckline. The st count should be divisible by $5+1$. Continue as follows:
Row 1 (wrong side): P7, P2 tbl, *K3, P2 tbl *, repeat from *_* until there are 7 sts left, P7.
Row 2: K7, K2 tbl, *P3 , K2 tbl*, repeat from *_* until there are 7 sts left, K7. Repeat rows 1 - 2 . On row 4, work the final buttonholes on the right band in the same way as on the bottom of the front piece. Continue working until the neck measures 3 cm . Cast off. Fold the outermost 3 sts on each front piece to the wrong side and sew down with loose sts. Lightly steam-iron the edges and sew buttonhole-st around the buttonholes if you wish.
