YARN

ALPAKKA FORTE 80 % finest alpaca, 20 % nylon, 50 grams = approx. 133 metres

SIZES

XS-S (M) L-XL

GARMENT MEASUREMENTS

Chest measurements approx. 115 (128) 139 cm Full length approx. 65 (67) 69 cm Sleeve-length approx. 42 (42) 42 cm

YARN AMOUNTS

Colour 1: 6 (7) 8 balls Colour 2: 5 (5) 6 balls Colour 3: 4 (5) 6 balls

COLOURS

Colour 1: Mottled anthracite 710 Colour 2: Latte mottled beige 701 Colour 3: Mottled denim 707

SUGGESTED NEEDLE SIZES

Long circular needle size 3.5 mm Long and short circular needle size 2.5 mm

KNITTING TENSION

22 sts English rib with needle size 2.5 mm = 10 cm **NOTE!** When counting sts, 1 st + 1 yarn over = 1 st

Check your knitting tension by working a swatch.

Count the number of sts per 10 cm; if you have more sts than suggested, change to a larger needle size. If you have fewer sts, change to a smaller needle size.

FIND THE RIGHT SIZE

- 1. Measure a garment that fits you.
- 2. Compare the measurements with the pattern.
- 3. Choose your size from the chest measurements.
- 4. Body and sleeves can be worked longer or shorter as needed.

ABBREVIATIONS

K = knit, P = purl, st. = stitch, r = row, DPN = double pointed needles, <math>m1r = make one right, m1l = make one left



ENGLISH RIB I ONE COLOUR

Row 1: (= wrong side) Work 1 edge-st, *K1, 1 yarn over + slip 1 st purl-wise*, repeat from *_*, finish with K1, 1 edge-st.

Row 2: (= right side) Work 1 edge-st, *1 yarn over + 1 slip 1 st purl-wise, K together 1 yarn over + 1 st*, repeat from * -*, finish with 1 yarn over + slip 1 st purl-wise, 1 edge-st.

NOTE! The yarn over should lie above the st when knitting together yarn over + 1 st.

Row 3: (= wrong side) Work 1 edge st, *K together 1 yarn over + 1 st, 1 yarn over + slip 1 st purl-wise*, repeat *-*, finish with K together 1 yarn over + 1 st, 1 edge st. Repeat rows 2 - 3.

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ENGLISH RIB IN TWO COLOURS (colour 2 and colour 1) NOTE! Work alternately 2 rows from the right side and 2 rows from the wrong side.

Row 1: (= right side) Colour 2: Work 1 edge-st, *1 yarn over + slip 1 st purl-wise, K together 1 yarn over + 1 st*, repeat from *-*, finish with 1 yarn over + slip 1 st purl-wise, 1 edge-st. **Row 2:** (= right side) Colour 1: Work 1 edge-st, *K together 1 yarn over + 1 st, 1 yarn over + slip 1 st purl-wise*, repeat from

Row 3: (= wrong side) Colour 2: Work 1 edge st, *1 yarn over + slip 1 st purl-wise, K together 1 yarn over + 1 st*, repeat from $^{*-*}$, finish with 1 yarn over + 1 slip 1 st purl-wise, 1 edge st.

-, finish with P together 1 yarn over + 1 st, 1 edge-st.

Row 4: (= wrong side) Colour 1: Work 1 edge st, *K together 1 yarn over + 1 st, 1 yarn over + 1 slip 1 st purl-wise*, repeat from *-*, finish with K together 1 yarn over + 1 st, 1 edge st. Repeat rows 1 - 4.

FRONT PIECE

Cast on 129 (143) 155 sts with colour 3 and needle size 3.5 mm. Change to needle size 2.5 mm (without working the sts), then work **English rib in one colour** as described. Note the first row is worked from wrong side and the outermost st on each side is an edge st which is knitted on all rows.

When the piece measures 20 (21) 22 cm, and the last row was from wrong side, change to colour 1. Work **English rib in one colour** until the piece measures 27 (28) 29 cm and the last row was from wrong side. Change to colours 2 and 1 and work **English rib in two colours** until the piece measures approx. 44 (45) 46 cm and the last row was row 4 in pattern. Change to colour 2 and work English rib in one colour until the piece measures 53 (54) 56 cm. Change to colour 1 and work as before until the piece measures 57 (59) 61 cm. Cast off the middle 25 (27) 29 sts. Finish each shoulder separately; cast off for neck every 2nd row, 2,2,1,1,1 sts. When decreasing, 1 yarn over + 1 st are together counted as 1 st. Work until the piece measures 65 (67) 69 cm. Cast off the last 45 (51) 56 sts Work the other shoulder in the same way but in reverse.

BACK PIECE

Is worked in the same way as front piece but work until back piece is 2.5 cm shorter than front piece Cast off the middle 33 (35) 37 sts. Finish each side separately and cast off every 2nd row for the neck, 2,1 sts. Work until the back piece is the same length as the front piece. Cast off the last 45 (51) 56 sts Work the other shoulder in the same way but in reverse.

SLEEVES

Cast on 69 (71) 73 sts with colour 3 and size 3.5 mm circular needle. Change to needle size 2.5 mm (without working the sts), then work **English rib in one colour** as described. Note the first row is worked from wrong side and the outermost st on each side is an edge st which is knitted on all rows. Increase 1 st on each side, inside the edge st, every 2.5 cm, 13 (14) 15 times = 95 (99) 103 sts. New sts are knitted into the pattern. When the piece measures 9 cm, and the last row was from wrong side, change to colour 1. Work **English rib in one colour** until the piece measures 16 cm and the last row was from wrong side. Change to colours 2 and 1 and work **English rib in two colours** until the piece measures approx. 33 cm and the last row was row 4 in pattern. Change to colour 2 and work English rib in one colour until the sleeve measures 42 cm. Cast off. Work one more sleeve in the same way.

ASSEMBLY

Sew together the shoulder seams. The armhole starts where the colour 2 section begins. Sew in the sleeves and sew the side seams.

NECKLINE

Begin by one shoulder seam. Use needle size 2.5 mm and colour 1 yarn. Lay the strand under the edge and knit up 13-14 sts per 5 cm round the neck opening. St-number should be divisible by 2. Work rib in the round (K1, P1) for 5 cm. Cast off with K and P and without the cast-off edge being tight. Fold the neck double to the inside and sew down with loose stitches.

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
