YARN

ALPAKKA FORTE 80 % alpaca, 20 % nylon,
50 grams = ca 133 metres

SIZES

S (M) L (XL) XXL

NOTE! See GARMENT MEASUREMENTS to find the right size

GARMENT MEASUREMENTS

Chest measurements approx. 96 (101) 110 (120) 130 cm

Full length approx. 58 (60) 62 (64) 66 cm

Sleeve-length approx. 49 cm (in all sizes)

YARN AMOUNTS

Colour 1: 8 (8) 9 (10) 11 balls

Colour 2: 5 (5) 6 (6) 7 balls

Colour 3: 2 (3) 3 (3) 3 balls

COLOURS

Colour 1: Latte mottled beige 701

Colour 2: Warm mottled brown 709

Colour 3: Curry mottled yellow 702

SUGGESTED NEEDLE SIZES

3 mm and 3.5 mm long and short circular needles and DPNs

DPNs size 2.5 mm (for I-cord)

3.5 mm crochet hook

KNITTING TENSION

25 sts stocking st and pattern with 3.5 mm needles = 10 cm

28 rounds stocking st and pattern with 3.5 mm needles =

10 cm

Check your knitting tension by working a swatch.


Count the number of sts per 10 cm; if you have more sts than suggested, change to a larger needle size. If you have fewer sts, change to a smaller needle size.

FIND THE RIGHT SIZE

1. Measure a garment that fits you.
2. Compare the measurements with the pattern.
3. Choose your size from the width of the body.
4. Body and sleeves can be worked longer or shorter as needed.

ABBREVIATIONS

K = knit, P = purl, st. = stitch, r = row, DPN = double pointed needles, m1r = make one right, m1l = make one left



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BODY

Cast on 240 (252) 276 (300) 324 sts with colour 1 and size 3 mm needle. Work 6 cm stocking st in the round.

At the same, when the piece measures 4 cm, work 2 holes in each side as follows: *K1, K2 together, 2 yarn overs, slip 1 st, slip next st, place the 2 sts back on left needle and K twisted together, K 110 (116) 128 (140) 152, K2 together, 2 yarn overs, slip 1 st, slip the next st, place the 2 sts back on left needle and K twisted together, K1 *, repeat from *-*.

On the next row work the yarn overs K1, K1 twisted.

Change to size 3.5 mm needles and work pattern according to the diagram until the piece measures 37 (38) 39 (40) 41 cm. **At the same time**, on the last round, cast off 12 sts mid-under each sleeve for the armholes (= 6 sts on each side of marker) = 108 (114) 126 (138) 150 sts on both front and back pieces. Lay the piece to one side and work the sleeves.

SLEEVES

TEMPORARY CAST-ON EDGE

Use crochet hook size 3.5 mm and cast on 110 (112) 116 (120) 120 loose chain sts, using a contrasting colour. Cut the yarn without pulling it through the st. Knit up 104 (108) 114 (120) 120 sts with colour 1 and needle size 3.5 mm, from wrong side of chain-st cord - see explanation.

Continue with stocking st and pattern according to the diagram. Count from middle of sleeve where diagram should begin and start on left side for your size.

Insert a marker mid-under sleeve. Work until the piece measures approx. 47 cm. **NOTE!** End with same round as on body. **At the same time**, on last round, cast off 12 sts mid-under sleeve (= 6 sts on each side of marker) = 92 (96) 102 (108) 108 sts. Leave the stitches on the needle.


Place the sts from the temporary cast-on edge on needle size 3.5 mm.



Work 1 round stocking st as follows (insert a marker at beginning of round): K 28 (30) 32 (34) 34, place 8 sts on one extra needle, place 8 sts on another extra needle. Fold second extra needle behind first extra needle (wrong side to wrong side), fold main needle behind second extra needle (right side to right side). Work 1 sts from each of the 3 needles together to 1 st, work like this until all sts on the rows have been worked together = 8 sts.

Place 8 sts on one extra needle, 8 sts on another extra needle, fold the second extra needle in front of the first extra needle (right side to right side), fold the main needle in front of the second extra needle (wrong side to wrong side). Work 1 sts from each of the 3 needles together to 1 st, work like this until all sts on the rows have been worked together = 8 sts (see illustration). K to end of round = 72 (76) 82 (88) 88 sts. Change to size 3 mm needle and work 10 rounds stocking st. **At the same**, on round 3, work 2 holes as follows: *K1, K2 together, 2 yarn overs, slip 1 st, slip the next st, place the 2 sts back on left needle and K twisted together, K 62 (76) 72 (78) 78, K2 together, 2 yarn overs, slip 1 st, slip the next st, place the 2 sts back on left needle and K twisted together, K1. On the next row work the yarn overs K1, K1 twisted. Cast off. Work one more sleeve.

Illustration leg:



YOKE

Place left sleeve, front piece, right sleeve and back piece on needle size 3.5 mm = 400 (420) 456 (492) 516 sts.

Continue in the round with pattern according to the diagram.

At the same time, on round 1, K 2 together in each join (= 1 st from front/back piece together with 1 st from sleeve = 4 marker-sts) = 396 (416) 452 (488) 512 sts.

At the same, on round 2, decrease for raglan as follows:

Before each marker-st: Work until there are 2 sts left before marker-st. Slip 1 st, slip the next st, place these 2 sts back on left needle and K twisted together, P1 (= marker-st).

After each marker-st: K2 together.

Repeat the raglan decreases every 2nd round a total of 21 (23) 24 (24) 26 times, then every round until you have decreased a total of 31 (33) 34 (36) 38 times = 148 (152) 180 (200) 208 sts.

ASSEMBLY

Fold bottom 3 cm on body and 5 rounds on sleeves to wrong side. Sew down with loose sts.

Sew together under each sleeve.

NECKLINE

= 148 (152) 180 (200) 208 sts.


Continue with size 3.5 mm needle and colour 1. Work stocking st in the round. **At the same**, on round 1, decrease

8 (10) 34 (52) 58 sts evenly spaced = 140 (142) 146 (148) 150 sts. Work until neckline measures approx. 25 cm.


Insert a marker 3 cm on each side of mid-front. Make a hole at each marker as follows: K2 together, 2 yarn overs, slip 1 st, slip next st, place these sts back on left needle. On the next row work the yarn overs K1, K1 twisted.

Work 3 cm stocking st for folding edge. Cast off.

Fold the edge to the wrong side and sew down, a little below the holes. Work 2 cords for the bottom of the body and 1 for each sleeve and for neckline as follows: Cast on 4 sts with DPN size 2.5 mm. Work in the round as follows: *Push the sts to the right end of the needle, tighten the strand at the back and K4 *, repeat from *-* and work to desired length. Cast off. Use a knitting mill if you wish.





TEMPORARY CAST-ON EDGE



Cast on chain-sts, shown here from right side.





How the wrong side looks. Begin 1-2 sts in from end and knit up sts from "cross-strands".




