YARN

MERINO 22, 100 % extra fine merino wool, 50 grams = approx. 125 metres

Alternative yarns: NATURAL LANOLIN WOOL, ALPAKKA TWEED CLASSIC, LERKE, STERK, ØKO BOMULL

SIZES

S (M) L (XL) XXL **NOTE!** See GARMENT MEASUREMENTS to find the right size

GARMENT MEASUREMENTS

Chest measurements approx. 91 (99) 107 (117) 129 cm Full length approx.55 (57) 59 (61) 63 cm Sleeve length approx. 27 (27) 27 (27) 28 cm

YARN AMOUNTS

9 (10) 11 (12) 13 balls

COLOURS

Lollipop 2034

SUGGESTED NEEDLE SIZES 3 and 4 mm long and short circular needles and DPNs

KNITTING TENSION 22 sts with stocking st on 4 mm needles = 10 cm

Check your knitting tension by working a swatch. Count the number of sts per 10 cm; if you have more sts than suggested, change to a larger needle size. If you have fewer sts, change to a smaller needle size.

FIND THE RIGHT SIZE


- 1. Measure a garment that fits you.
- 2. Compare the measurements with the pattern.
- 3. Choose your size from the chest measurements.
- 4. Body and sleeves can be worked longer or shorter as needed.

ABBREVIATIONS

K = knit, P = purl, st. = stitch, y/o = yarn over, DPN = double pointed needles, tbl = through back loop

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BODY

Cast on 160 (175) 190 (205) 230 sts on 3 mm circular needles and work rib in the round for 6 cm (K2 tbl, P3). Change to 4 mm needles and knit 1 round, **at the same time** as you increase 40 (43) 46 (53) 54 sts evenly spaced = 200 (218) 236 (258) 284 sts.

Place a marker in each side, with 100 (109) 118 (129) 142 sts on both the front and back pieces.

Continue with stocking st. Work until the piece measures 34.5 (35.5) 36.5 (37.5) 38.5 cm.

Divide the piece at each marker and finish the front and back pieces separately.



BACK PIECE

= 100 (109) 118 (129) 142 sts.

Work stocking st back and forth and cast off for the armholes at the beginning of each row, 3,2,1,1,1 (4,2,1,1,1) 5,2,1,1,1 (5,3,2,2,1,1) 6,5,3,2,2,1 sts on each side = 84 (91) 98 (101) 104 sts. Continue working until the piece measures 52.5 (54.5) 56.5 (58.5) 60.5 cm. Work diagonal shoulders by casting off at the beginning of each row, 5,5,5,4 (7,6,5,4) 7,6,5,5 (8,6,5,5) 8,6,6,5 sts on each side.

NOTE! When the piece measures 53 (55) 57 (59) 61 cm, cast off the middle 38 (39) 44 (45) 46 sts for the neckline and finish each shoulder separately. Continue casting off for the neckline every 2nd row, 2,1,1 st. When all neck and shoulder decreases are finished, all sts have been cast off. Work the other shoulder in the same way.

FRONT PIECE

= 100 (109) 118 (129) 142 sts.

Work in the same way as back piece until the front measures approx. 50 (52) 54 (56) 58 cm.

Cast off the middle 32 (33) 38 (39) 40 sts for the neckline and finish each shoulder separately. Continue to decrease for the neckline every 2nd row, 3,2,1,1 sts. **NOTE!** When the piece measures 52,5 (54,5) 56,5 (58,5) 60,5 cm, work the diagonal shoulder by casting off from the sleeve side every 2nd row, 5,5,5,4 (7,6,5,4) 7,6,5,5 (8,6,5,5) 8,6,6,5 sts. When all neck and shoulder decreases are finished, all sts have been cast off. Work the other shoulder in the same way.

SLEEVES

Cast on 70 (70) 70 (75) 80 sts on 3 mm DPNs size and work rib in the round for 12 cm (K2 tbl, P3). Place a marker in the middle of the rib. **The sleeve is measured from this marker**. Change to 4 mm needles and knit 1 round, **at the same time** as you increase 22 (26) 30 (35) 40 sts evenly spaced = 92 (96) 100 (110) 120 sts. Continue with stocking st. Work until the piece measures 21 (21) 21 (21) cm.

Cast off 6 (8) 10 (10) 12 sts mid-under sleeve and finish the sleeve cap back and forth. Cast off at the beginning of each row, 2,1,1,1 (2,1,1,1) 2,1,1,1 (3,2,2,1,1) 5,3,2,2,1 sts on each side = 76 (78) 80 (82) 82 sts. Continue by casting off 1 st on each side every 1 cm, for a total of 9 (10) 11 (12) 12 times = 58 sts. **NOTE!** Cast off from the right side by K2 together at the beginning of the row, and slip 1 st, K1, pass the slipped st over at the end of the row. Work until the sleeve cap measures 13 (14) 15 (16) 16 cm. Finish with a row from the wrong side. Finish the sleeve cap as follows:

Row 1: Cast off 3 sts, K2, *place 4 sts on a needle in front of the piece and K1 st from the front needle together with 1 st from the back needle 4 times (all sts on the front needle have been worked). Place 4 sts on a needle held behind the piece, K1 st from the front needle together with 1 st from the back needle 4 times*, repeat from*-* two more times, K5 = 31 sts.

Row 2: Cast off 3 sts, P to end of row.

Row 3: Cast off 2 sts, move st on right needle back onto left needle. *Slip 2 sts (as if to K together), K1, pass the slipped sts over*, repeat from*-* 7 more times, K2 = 10 sts. **Row 4:** Cast off 2 sts, P to end of row = 8 sts. Cast off.

ASSEMBLY

Join the shoulder seams and sew in the sleeves. Fold the bottom edges of the sleeves double to the inside and sew down.

NECK

Knit up approx. 12 sts per 5 cm around the neckline, with 3 mm circular needles. The number of sts should be divisible by 5. Work 8 cm rib in the round with K2 tbl, P3. Cast off. Fold the neck double to the inside and sew down with loose stitches.

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
