

MOOR WRAP TOP

DG 408-16 | KIDSILK ERLE



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DESIGN

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YARN

KIDSILK ERLE 56 % mohair, 26 % silk, 18 % wool, 50 grams = approx. 325 metres

Alternative yarn: 2 strands of TYNN KIDSILK ERLE

SIZES

S (M) L (XL) XXL

NOTE! See MEASUREMENTS to find your size

MEASUREMENTS

Upper body approx. 93 (100) 107 (118) 127 cm Full length approx. 52 (54) 56 (58) 60 cm Sleeves approx. 48 cm in all sizes

YARN REQUIREMENTS

3 (4) 4 (4) 5 balls

COLOUR

Honey 9048

SUGGESTED NEEDLES

3 mm and 3.5 mm long and short circular needles and DPNs 2 mm DPNs

GAUGE

22 sts of stocking st on 3.5 mm needles = 10 cm 32 rows stocking st on 3.5 mm needles = 10 cm

Check your gauge by working a swatch.

Count the number of sts per 10 cm. If you have more sts than suggested, change to a larger needle size. If you have fewer sts change to a smaller needle size.

FIND YOUR SIZE

- 1. Measure a knitted garment that fits you.
- 2. Compare your measurements with those in the pattern.
- 3. Select your size based on the upper body measurements.
- 4. Body and sleeves may be worked longer or shorter as desired.

ABBREVIATIONS

k = knit, p = purl, st = stitch, R = round/row, DPN = double pointed needles, k2tog = knit 2 together, m = marker, PM = place marker, tbl = through back loop, RS/WS = right/wrong side

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Edge sts are knitted on all rows.

The entire garment is knitted with 1 strand of KIDSILK ERLE

FRONT AND BACK PIECES

Cast on 274 (292) 310 (336) 358 sts on 3 mm circular needles. Working flat, work a K1, P1 rib for 2 cm. PM in each side, with 86 (91) 96 (103) 109 sts for each front piece and 102 (110) 118 (130) 140 sts for the back piece. Change to 3.5 mm needles and work stocking st. When your work measures 14 cm and the last R was worked from the WS, begin decreasing for the V-neck. K1 (edge st), K2tog tbl, K until 3 sts remain, K2tog, K1 (edge st). Repeat the decreases every 2nd row a total of 27 (28) 29 (32) 34 times = 59 (63) 67 (71) 75 sts left for each front piece.

On the next R (WS), cast off 8 sts in each side (= 4 sts on each side of the m) = 55 (59) 63 (67) 71 sts for each front piece and 94 (102) 110 (122) 132 sts for the back piece. Put aside and work the sleeves.



SLEEVES

Cast on 48 (50) 52 (54) 56 sts on 3 mm DPNs. Work rib in the round (K1, P1) for 6 cm. K across 1 R, **while at the same time** increasing 8 sts evenly spaced = 56 (58) 60 (62) 64 sts. PM around the first and last sts = m sts.

Change to 3.5 mm needles and work stocking st. When the sleeve measures 8 cm, increase 1 st on each side of m sts. Repeat the increases every 3 (3) 2.5 (2.5) 2 cm a total of 12 (13) 14 (15) 16 times = 80 (84) 88 (92) 96 sts. Work until the sleeve measures 48 cm, **while at the same time** casting off 8 sts under the sleeve on the last R = 72 (76) 80 (84) 88 sts. Work the other sleeve in the same way.

YOKE

Place the right front piece, right sleeve, back piece, left sleeve and left front piece on the same 3.5 mm circular

needles = 348 (372) 396 (424) 450 sts.

Working flat, continue in stocking st (R1 = WS) and continue decreasing for the V-neck as before. On R2, K1 st from the sleeve together with 1 st from the front or back piece in each transition = m sts.

M sts are always P from the RS and K from the WS. On R3, continue the V-neck decreases while also decreasing for raglan as follows: K2tog before each m st and K2tog tbl after each m st = decreased 8 sts. Continue decreasing for both V-neck and raglan on every other R until 14-15 sts remain between the edge sts and the m sts on the front pieces. Continue as follows: Continue the raglan decreases, while working the V-neck decrease every 4th R. Repeat until there is 1 st left. Cast off.

ASSEMBLY

Join underarm seams.

I-CORD EDGE, FRONT

NOTE! Both rows worked from the RS. Begin with a long tail of yarn when picking up sts, and use the tail end for knitting. Begin at the bottom of the right front piece. Pick up approx. 10–11 sts per 5 cm on 3.5 mm needles along the right front piece, back piece, and left front piece.


From the RS: *K1 through the 1st st without taking it off the needle, place the new st onto the left needle*, repeat from *-* 2 more times (= 3 new sts).

Continue as follows: *K2, K2tog tbl (= 3 sts), place 3 sts back onto your left needle*. Repeat from *-* until 3 sts remain on your needle. Cast off as follows: K1, K2tog tbl, pass 1st st over.

BELT

Cast on 4 sts on 3.5 mm DPNs and work in the round as follows: K4, *push the sts to the right end of the needle, tighten the working yarn at the back and K4*, repeat from *-* until the cord measures 2.5 metres or your preferred length. Cast off.

Work an i-cord belt loop like this: Cast on 3 sts on 2 mm DPNs and work in the round as follows: K3, *push the sts to the right end of the needle, tighten the working yarn at the back and K3*, repeat from *-* until the cord measures 3 cm. Work another loop in the same way. Attach the belt loops on each side at the waist.



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
