YARN

KIDSILK ERLE 56 % mohair, 26 % silk, 18 % wool,
50 grams = approx. 325 metres

SIZES

S (M) L (XL) XXL

NOTE! See MEASUREMENTS to find your size

MEASUREMENTS

Upper body approx. 91 (99) 107 (117) 129 cm

Full length approx. 55 (57) 59 (61) 63 cm

Sleeves approx. 51 (51) 51 (51) 52 cm

YARN REQUIREMENTS

4 (4) 4 (5) 5 balls

COLOUR

Army Green 9054

SUGGESTED NEEDLES

2.5 mm and 3.5 mm long and short circular needles and DPNs

GAUGE

22 sts of stocking st on 3.5 mm needles = 10 cm

Alternative yarn: TYNN KIDSILK ERLE held double

Check your gauge by working a swatch.

Count the number of sts per 10 cm. If you have more sts than suggested, change to a larger needle size. If you have fewer sts change to a smaller needle size.

FIND YOUR SIZE

1. Measure a knitted garment that fits you.
2. Compare your measurements with those in the pattern.
3. Select your size based on the upper body measurements.
4. Body and sleeves may be worked longer or shorter as desired.

ABBREVIATIONS

k = knit, p = purl, st = stitch, R = round/row,
DPN = double pointed needles, k2tog = knit 2 together,
m = marker, PM = place marker, tbl = through back loop,
RS/WS = right/wrong side

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BODY

Cast on 200 (215) 235 (260) 285 sts on 2.5 mm circular needles and work a twisted rib in the round for 6 cm (K2 tbl, P3). Change to 3.5 mm needles and work 1 round of stocking st, **while at the same time** adjusting your stitch count to 200 (218) 236 (258) 284 sts. PM in each side, with 100 (109) 118 (129) 142 sts for both the front and back pieces. Continue with stocking st. Work until the piece measures 34.5 (35.5) 36.5 (37.5) 38.5 cm. Divide the piece at each m and work the front and back pieces separately.

BACK PIECE

= 100 (109) 118 (129) 142 sts.

Work stocking st flat and cast off for the armholes at the beginning of each R: 3,2,1,1,1 (4,2,1,1,1) 5,2,1,1,1 (5,3,2,2,1,1) 6,5,3,2,2,1 sts on each side = 84 (91) 98 (101) 104 sts.

Continue working until the piece measures 52.5 (54.5) 56.5 (58.5) 60.5 cm. Work diagonal shoulders by casting off at the beginning of each R: 5,5,5,4 (7,6,5,4) 7,6,5,5 (8,6,5,5) 8,6,6,5 sts on each side.



NOTE! When the piece measures 53 (55) 57 (59) 61 cm, cast off the middle 38 (39) 44 (45) 46 sts for the neckline and finish each side separately. Continue casting off for the neckline every 2nd row, 2,1,1 st. When all neck and shoulder decreases are finished, all sts have been cast off. Work the other side in the same way.

FRONT PIECE

= 100 (109) 118 (129) 142 sts. Work in the same way as back piece until the piece measures approx. 50 (52) 54 (56) 58 cm. Cast off the middle 32 (33) 38 (39) 40 sts for the neckline and finish each side separately. Continue to cast off for the neckline every 2nd R: 3,2,1,1 sts. **At the same time**, when the piece measures 52.5 (54.5) 56.5 (58.5) 60.5 cm, work the diagonal shoulder by casting off from the armhole side every 2nd R: 5,5,5,4 (7,6,5,4) 7,6,5,5 (8,6,5,5) 8,6,6,5 sts. When all neck and shoulder decreases are finished, all sts have been cast off. Work the other side in the same way.

SLEEVES

Cast on 40 (40) 45 (45) 50 sts on 2.5 mm DPNs and work a twisted rib in the round for 10 cm (K2 tbl, P3). Change to 3.5 mm needles and continue with stocking st. **At the same time**, increase 26 (28) 28 (32) 35 sts evenly spaced on R1 (= 66 (68) 73 (77) 85 sts) and 26 (28) 27 (33) 35 sts evenly on R3 = 92 (96) 100 (110) 120 sts. Continue with stocking st. When the sleeve measures 51 (51) 51 (51) 52 cm, cast off 6 (8) 10 (10) 12 sts under the sleeve. Finish the sleeve cap working flat. Cast off at the beginning of each R:

2,1,1,1 (2,1,1,1) 2,1,1,1 (3,2,2,1,1) 5,3,2,2,1 sts on each side = 76 (78) 80 (82) 82 sts. Continue by casting off 1 st on each side every 1 cm, 9 (10) 11 (12) 12 times in total = 58 sts.

NOTE! Cast off from the RS by K2tog at the beginning of R and, at the end of R slip 1 st, K1, pass the slipped st over. Work until the sleeve cap measures 13 (14) 15 (16) 16 cm. Finish with a WS R. Finish the sleeve cap as follows:

R1: Cast off 3 sts, K2, *place 4 sts on a needle held in front of the piece and K 1 st from the front needle together with 1 st from the back needle 4 times (all sts on the front needle have been worked). Place 4 sts on a needle held behind the piece, K 1 st from the front needle together with 1 st from the back needle 4 times*, repeat from*-* two more times, K5 = 31 sts.

R2: Cast off 3 sts, P to end of R.

R3: Cast off 2 sts, move sts from the right hand needle back onto the left hand needle. *Slip 2 sts (as if to K tog), K1, pass the slipped sts over*, repeat from*-* 7 more times, K2 = 10 sts.

R4: Cast off 2 sts, P to end of R = 8 sts. Cast off.

ASSEMBLY

Join the shoulder seams and sew in the sleeves.

NECKLINE

Pick up approx. 12 sts per 5 cm around the neckline, using 2.5 mm circular needles. Your st count must be divisible by 5. Work 8 cm twisted rib in the round with K2 tbl, P3. Cast off loosely. Fold the neck double to the inside and sew down with loose stitches.

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
