DIWAN JUMPER

DESIGN

Brit Frafjord Ørstavik

YARN

TYNN KIDSILK ERLE 53 % mohair, 34 % silk, 13 % wool, 25 grams = approx. 287.5 metres

SIZES

S (M) L (XL) XXL

NOTE! See MEASUREMENTS to find your size

MEASUREMENTS

Upper body approx. 96 (104) 112 (122) 135 cm Full length approx. 52 (54) 56 (58) 60 cm

YARN REQUIREMENTS

Colour 1 3 (3) 3 (3) 4 balls Colour 2 1 ball in all sizes

COLOUR

Colour 1 Rose 4006 Colour 2 Copper 4007

SUGGESTED NEEDLES

3 mm and 3.5 mm long circular needles 3.5 mm short circular needles

GAUGE

26 sts with stocking st on 3.5 mm needles = 10 cm

Check your gauge by working a swatch.

Count the number of sts per 10 cm. If you have more sts than suggested, change to a larger needle size. If you have fewer sts change to a smaller needle size.

FIND YOUR SIZE

- 1. Measure a knitted garment that fits you.
- 2. Compare your measurements with those in the pattern.
- 3. Select your size based on the upper body measurements.
- 4. Body and sleeves may be worked longer or shorter as desired.

ABBREVIATIONS

k = knit, p = purl, st = stitch, R = round/row, k2tog = knit 2 together, m = marker, PM = place marker, tbl = through back loop, m1l = make one left, m1r = make one right

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Edge sts are knitted on all rows.

BODY

Cast on 250 (270) 290 (318) 350 sts using colour 1 on 3 mm needles. Work 3 cm stocking st in the round, then P 1 R for the folding edge.

NOTE! The piece is now measured from here.

Continue with stocking st. **At the same time**, when your work measures 3 cm, change to 3.5 mm needles. PM in each side with 125 (135) 145 (159) 175 for the front and back pieces.

Work until the piece measures 32 (33) 34 (35) 36 cm. Divide at side markers (SM) and work front and back pieces separately.

BACK PIECE

= 125 (135) 145 (159) 175 sts.

Continue the stocking st working flat, **while at the same time** increasing 1 st inside 1 st on each side.

Use m1l and m1r for increases.

Reapeat the increases every 5 (5) 5 (5) 6 R until you have increased 12 times in total = 149 (159) 169 (183) 199 sts.

At the same time, once your work measures 42 (44) 46 (48) 50 cm, change to colour 2 and work to full length. When your work measures 50 (52) 54 (56) 58 cm, begin casting off for the shoulders on each side, every other R: 17,16,16 (18,17,17) 19,18,18 (20,20,20) 22,22,21 sts.

Cast off the remaining 51 (55) 59 (63) 69 sts (= neckline).



= 125 (135) 145 (159) 175 sts.

Work as back piece until the piece measures 50 (52) 54 (56) 58 cm.

Cast off the middle 41 (45) 49 (53) 59 sts for the neckline and finish each side separately.

Continue casting off for neckline every other R, 3,2 sts, while at the same time decreasing for shoulders as on the back piece.

Work the other side in the same way, but in reverse.

ASSEMBLY

Join the shoulder seams.

CUFF

Pick up 1 st through each st using 1 strand of colour 2 on 3.5 mm needles.

Continue with 2 strands and work an **i-cord** bind-off as follows: *K1 through 1st st without removing the st from the needle, place the new st onto your left needle*, repeat from *-* 2 more times (= 3 st increase).

Continue as follows: *K2, K2tog tbl (= 3 sts), place 3 sts back onto your left needle*. Repeat from *-* until 3 sts remain on your needle.

Slide the sts to the left side of your needle and cast off as follows: K1, K2tog tbl, pass 1st st over.

Cut yarn. Sew the cast-on and cast-off edges together. Work the other cuff in the same way.


NECKLINE

Pick up 1 st through each st using 1 strand of colour 2 on 3.5 mm needles.

Begin at one shoulder.

Continue with 2 strands of yarn and work an **i-cord** bind-off in the same way as on the sleeves.
