YARN

FAERYTALE 100 % alpaca, 50 grams = approx. 175 metres

SIZES

XXS–XS (S–M) L (XL–XXL) XXXL

NOTE! See MEASUREMENTS to find your size

MEASUREMENTS

Upper body approx. 89 (107) 113 (124) 132 cm

Full length approx. 49 (50) 57 (58) 59 cm

Sleeves approx. 45 (45) 48 (48) 48 cm

YARN REQUIREMENTS

4 (5) 6 (7) 8 balls

COLOUR

Dusty Jade Green 715

SUGGESTED NEEDLES

3.5 mm and 4.5 mm long and short circular needles and DPNs

GAUGE

18 sts textured pattern on 4.5 mm needles = 10 cm

24 R textured pattern on 4.5 mm needles = 10 cm

Check your gauge by working a swatch.

Count the number of sts per 10 cm. If you have more sts than suggested, change to a larger needle size. If you have fewer sts change to a smaller needle size.

FIND THE RIGHT SIZE

1. Measure a garment that fits you.
2. Compare your measurements with those in the pattern.
3. Select your size based on the upper body measurements.
4. Body and sleeves may be worked longer or shorter as desired.

ABBREVIATIONS

k = knit, p = purl, st = stitch, R = round/row,
DPN = double pointed needles, Y/O = yarn over,
K2tog = knit 2 together, m = marker, PM = place marker,
tbl = through back loop, m1l = make one left,
m1r = make one right, RS/WS = right/wrong side

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BODY

Cast on 160 (192) 204 (224) 238 sts on 3.5 mm circular needles. Work 6 (7) 5 (6) 7 cm twisted rib in the round (K1 tbl, P1). Change to 4.5 mm needles. Work pattern according to diagram **A (A) C (B) C**. Repeat the 28 (28) 32 (32) 32 R inside the brackets twice vertically. **At the same time**, cast off as follows on the last R: Cast off the first 16 (16) 17 (16) 17 sts (= 1 pattern repeat), work 64 (80) 85 (96) 102 sts (= front piece), cast off 16 (16) 17 (16) 17 sts (= 1 repeat), and work 64 (80) 85 (96) 102 sts (= back piece). The piece measures approx. 29 (30) 32 (33) 34 cm. Lay aside and work the sleeves.

SLEEVES

Cast on 38 (40) 44 (46) 48 sts on 3.5 mm DPNs. Work 10 (10) 8 (8) 8 cm twisted rib in the round (K1 tbl, P1). **NOTE!** If you prefer the sleeves longer or shorter, or if your gauge gives you more R than indicated in the pattern, you can make the required changes to sleeve length by adjusting the length of the ribbed edge. Change to 4.5 mm needles. K 1 R and increase 26 (24) 24 (34) 37 sts evenly spaced = 64 (64) 68 (80) 85 sts. Work pattern according to diagram **A (A) C (B) C**. Repeat the 28 (28) 32 (32) 32 R inside the brackets 3 times vertically. **At the same time** on the last round, cast off the first 16 (16) 17 (16) 17 sts (= 1 pattern repeat) = 48 (48) 51 (64) 68 sts. The sleeve measures approx. 45 (45) 48 (48) 48 cm. Lay aside and work one more sleeve in the same way.


YOKE

Place the left sleeve, front piece, right sleeve, and back piece on 4.5 mm circular needles = 224 (256) 272 (320) 340 sts. R now begins between the back piece and left sleeve. Continue with pattern according to the diagram, starting at the arrow. Work until there are 3 R left of the diagram (= ribbed edge) = 84 (96) 96 (120) 120 sts. Change to 3.5 mm circular needles and work the last 3 R of the diagram for 7 cm. Cast off loosely with K and P sts.

ASSEMBLY

Join underarm seams. Fold the neck double to the WS and sew down with loose stitches.
