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## **ÅSTA JUMPER**

## **DESIGN**

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#### **YARN**

FAERYTALE 100 % alpaca, 50 grams = approx. 175 metres

# **SIZES**

XXS (XS) S-M (L-XL)

**NOTE!** This garment is designed to be oversized. Please choose your size based on the measurements below.

# **MEASUREMENTS**

Upper body approx. 110 (126) 142 (162) cm Bottom widt approx. 98 (114) 130 (150) cm Full length approx. 48 (52) 56 (60) cm Sleeves approx. 46 (46) 44 (42) cm or desired length

## YARN REQUIREMENTS

6 (7) 8 (9) balls

## **COLOUR**

Lilac 805

## SUGGESTED NEEDLES

7 mm and 8 mm long and short circular needles and DPNs

# **GAUGE**

10 sts x 14 R stocking st with yarn held double on 8 mm needles =  $10 \times 10 \text{ cm}$ 

Check your gauge by working a swatch.

Count the number of sts per 10 cm. If you have more sts than suggested, change to a larger needle size. If you have fewer sts change to a smaller needle size.

# **FIND YOUR SIZE**

- 1. Measure a knitted garment that fits you.
- $2. \ \ Compare your measurements with those in the pattern.$
- 3. Select your size based on the upper body measurements.
- 4. Body and sleeves may be worked longer or shorter as needed.

# **ABBREVIATIONS**

k = knit, p = purl, st = stitch, R = round/row, DPN = double pointed needles, K2tog = knit 2 together, m = marker, PM = place marker, tbl = through back loop, m1l = make one left, m1r = make one right, RS/WS = right/wrong side

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Make your yarn changes at the sides, so they are less visible.

The entire garment is knitted with yarn held double.

## BODY

Cast on 116 (134) 150 (174) sts on 7 mm circular needles. Work rib in the round (K1, P1) for 8 cm.

Change to 8 mm needles and continue with stocking st.

At the same time on R 1, decrease 18 (20) 20 (24) sts evenly spaced = 98 (114) 130 (150) sts. PM in each side with 49 (57) 65 (75) sts for both the front and back pieces.

When the piece measures approx. 10 cm, increase on each side as follows: Work to 1 st before m, **m1r**, K 2, **m1l**\*, repeat from \*-\* at the other m = 4 sts increased.

Repeat the increase every 4.5 (5) 6 (6.5) cm a total of 3 times = 110 (126) 142 (162) sts.

When the piece measures 24 (26) 28 (30) cm, divide at each side m = 55 (63) 71 (81) sts for front and back pieces. Finish each piece separately.

# **BACK PIECE**

= 55 (63) 71 (81) sts.

Continue working stocking st flat. When the piece measures approx. 43 (47) 51 (55) cm and the next R is RS, work diagonal shoulders with short rows and **turning sts** as follows: Work to the last 7 (8) 9 (10) sts on R. Turn with 1 **turning st** (see

illustration) and work until there are 7 (8) 9 (10) sts left on the other side, turn with 1 **turning st**. Continue working like this with 6,6 (7,7) 8,8 (10,10) fewer sts for each turn = 17 (19) 21 (21) sts for neckline and 19 (22) 25 (30) shoulder sts. Work 1 R stocking st across all sts, **at the same time** as the 2 loops/legs of the **turning sts** are worked together as 1 st. Cast off.

## **FRONT PIECE**

= 55 (63) 71 (81) sts.

Work in the same way as the back piece. When the piece measures 41 (45) 49 (53) cm, cast off the middle 5 (7) 9 (9) sts for the neckline. Finish each side separately, and continue casting off for the neckline at the beginning of every other R: 3,2,1 sts = 19 (22) 25 (30) shoulder sts. **At the same time**, work the diagonal shoulders when the piece is the same length as the back piece.

Work 1 R stocking st across the shoulder sts, **at the same time** as the 2 loops/legs of the **turning sts** are worked together as 1 st.

Cast off. Work the other side in the same way but in reverse.

#### **ASSEMBLY**

Join the shoulder seams.

## **SLEEVES**

Begin at the bottom of one armhole. Pick up 38 (42) 46 (50) sts around the armhole on 8 mm needles. PM around the first and last sts = m sts. Continue in the round with stocking st. When the sleeve measures 2 cm, decrease 1 st on each side of the m sts: K2tog tbl before the m, and K2tog after the m. Repeat the decreases every 6 cm, 5 times in total = 28 (32) 36 (40) sts. Work until the sleeve measures 38 (38) 36 (34) cm or to desired length. **At the same time** on the last R, decrease 6 (8) 10 (12) sts evenly spaced = 22 (24) 26 (28) sts.

Change to 7 mm needles and work rib for 8 cm (K1, P1). Cast off with rib sts. Work one more sleeve in the same way.

#### **NECKLINE**

Begin on one shoulder and pick up approx. 5 sts per 5 cm on 7 mm short circular needles.


Work 1 R of stocking st, **while at the same time** adjusting your st count to 50 (54) 58 (62) sts.

Work rib in the round for 3 cm (K1, P1). P 1 R (= folding edge). Work rib in the round (K1, P1) until the neck measures 6 cm. Cast off loosely.


Fold the neckline double to the WS and sew down with loose stitches.

# M1R AND M1L


M1l: Pick up the strand between 2 sts, place it on left needle as shown in picture, work through the back loop.




M1r: Pick up strand between 2 sts, place it on left needle as shown in picture, work the front loop.



# **TURNING ST**



1 Turning st: Slip 1 st as if to P.



2 Pull st to back of right needle (tighten).

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
