# **DESIGN**

House of Yarn

### YARN

FAERYTALE 100 % finest alpaca, 50 grams = approx. 175 metres

## SIZES

XXS-XS (S-M) L-XXL

**NOTE!** This garment is designed to be oversized. Find your size based on the measurements table.

# **MEASUREMENTS**

Upper body approx. 101 (119) 139 cm Full length mid-front approx. 52 (54) 57 cm Sleeves approx. 45 (44) 43 cm or desired length

### YARN REQUIREMENTS

Colour 1 4 (5) 5 balls Colour 2 1 (1) 2 balls Colour 3 1 (2) 2 balls

### **COLOURS**

Colour 1 Grey-Green 787 Colour 2 White 702

Colour 3 Light Sea Green 780

# SUGGESTED NEEDLES

3.5 mm and 4.5 mm long and short circular needles and DPNs

# GAUGE

18 sts x 23 R stocking st and colourwork on 4.5 mm needles =  $10 \times 10 \text{ cm}$ 

Check your gauge by working a swatch.

Count the number of sts per 10 cm. If you have more sts than suggested, change to a larger needle size. If you have fewer sts change to a smaller needle size.

# FIND YOUR SIZE

- 1. Measure a knitted garment that fits you.
- 2. Compare your measurements with those in the pattern.
- 3. Select your size based on the upper body measurements.
- 4. Body and sleeves may be worked longer or shorter as needed.

# **ABBREVIATIONS**


k = knit, p = purl, st = stitch, R = round/row, DPN = double pointed needles, K2tog = knit 2 together, m = marker, PM = place marker, tbl = through back loop, m1l = make one left, m1r = make one right, RS/WS = right/wrong side






# M1R AND M1L

M11: Pick up the strand between 2 sts, place it on left needle as shown in picture, work through the back loop.



M1r: Pick up strand between 2 sts, place it on left needle as shown in picture, work the front loop.



### **BODY**

Using 3.5 mm needles, cast on 210 (242) 288 sts with colour 1.

Work a twisted rib in the round (K1 tbl, P1) for 10 cm. Change to 4.5 mm needles and continue with stocking st.

**At the same time** on R 1, decrease 28 (28) 38 sts evenly spaced = 182 (214) 250 sts.

PM in each side with 91 (107) 125 sts for both the front and back pieces.

When the piece measures 22 (22) 24 cm, begin working diagram  ${\bf A}$ .

Begin at the arrow for your size on each side.

(The colourwork pattern will not match up on the sides.) When you have completed the diagram, cast off 20 sts on each side for armholes (= 10 sts on each side of each m) = 71 (87) 105 sts on the front and back pieces.

The piece measures approx. 29 (29) 31 cm. Set aside and work the sleeves.

### **SLEEVES**

Using 3.5 mm DPNs, cast on 48 (52) 56 sts with colour 1. Work a twisted rib in the round (K1 tbl, P1) for 10 cm. Change to 4.5 mm needles and continue working stocking st **while at the same time** decreasing 1 st on R 1 = 47 (51) 55 sts.

PM around the first and last sts (= m sts).

When the sleeve measures 11 cm, increase 1 st on each side of the marker-sts: **m1r** before the m sts and **m1l** after the m sts.

Repeat the increases every 2.5 (2) (1.5) cm until you have increased 11 (13) 17 times in total = 69 (77) 89 sts.

**At the same time** when the sleeve measures 38 (37) 36 cm, work diagram **A**. Count outwards from the middle of the sleeve to determine where the diagram should begin.

The increased stitches are worked into the pattern as you go. On the last R of the diagram cast off 20 (20) 26 underarm sts (= m sts + 9 (9) 12 sts on each side) = 49 (57) 63 sts. Work one more sleeve.

# YOKE

Place left sleeve, front piece, right sleeve, and back piece on 4.5 mm needles = 240 (288) 336 sts. Work diagram **B**. Make sure that the colourwork from the body/sleeves matches up with the rest of the body, you may need to move the beginning of the R a little in order to begin R with a full diagram. When you have completed the diagram there are 90 (96) 104 sts left.

# **NECKLINE**


= 90 (96) 104 sts.

Change to 3.5 mm short circular needles and work a twisted rib in the round (K1 tbl, P1) with colour 1 for 8 cm. Cast off with K and P sts.

Fold the neck double to the WS and sew down.

# **ASSEMBLY**

Join the underarm seams.



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
