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## **DESIGN**

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## **YARN**

MYK PÅFUGL 73 % mohair, 22 % wool, 5 % polyamide, 50 grams = approx. 90 metres

#### SIZE

One size

## YARN AMOUNT

3 balls

#### **COLOUR**

Pink 1931

# SUGGESTED NEEDLE SIZE

8 mm long circular needles

## **KNITTING TENSION**

10 sts English rib with double yarn on 8 mm needles = 10 cm

Check your knitting tension by working a swatch.

Count the number of sts per 10 cm; if you have more sts than suggested, change to a larger needle size. If you have fewer sts, change to a smaller needle size.

# **ABBREVIATIONS**

K = knit, P = purl, y/o = yarn over, st. = stitch, DPN = double pointed needles

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The edge-sts are knitted on all rows.

## **ENGLISH RIB**

**Row 1:** (wrong side) Work 1 edge-st, \*K1, 1 y/o + slip 1 st purl-wise\*, repeat from \*-\*, finish with K1 and 1 edge-st.

**Row 2:** (= right side) Work 1 edge-st, \*1 y/o + slip 1 st purlwise, K together 1 y/o + 1 st\*, repeat from \*-\*, finish with 1 y/o + slip 1 st purl-wise, 1 edge-st.

**NOTE!** The y/o should lie over the st when knitting together y/o + 1 st.

**Row 3:** Work 1 edge st, \*K together 1 y/o + 1 st, 1 y/o + slip 1 st purl-wise\*, repeat \*-\*, finish with K together 1 y/o + 1 st, 1 edge st. Repeat rows 2 - 3.

Cast on 43 sts on 8 mm needles and work **English rib** back and forth until the piece measures approx. 11 cm, with the last row from the wrong side.

Work 2 rows for the folding edge as follows:

**Row 1:** Work 1 edge-st, \*slip 1 y/o and 1 st + 1 y/o (from previous row) purl-wise, K1\*, repeat from\* $_-$ \* to end of row, finish with 1 y/o and 1 st + 1 y/o, 1 edge st.

**Row 2:** Work 1 edge-st, \*K together 1 y/o + 1 st + 1 y/o, slip 1 y/o + 1 st purl-wise\*, repeat from \*-\*, finish with K together 1 y/o + 1 st + 1 y/o, then 1 edge st.

Continue back and forth with  ${\bf English\ rib}$  as before.

**NOTE!** From now on, row 2 in the **English rib** will be from the wrong side and row 3 from the right side.

Work until the piece measures approx. 33 cm. Cast off.

# **ASSEMBLY**

Sew the beanie together mid-back and across the top. Sew together to form an "ear" on each side.

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
