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TALVOR MITTENS

DESIGN House of Yarn

YARN OLDER 100 % wool, 50 grams = approx. 95 metres

SIZES 6-8 (10-12) women (men)

YARN AMOUNTS 1 (2) 2 (3) balls

COLOUR Putty 408

SUGGESTED NEEDLE SIZES 6 and 7 mm short circular needles and DPNs

KNITTING TENSION BEFORE FELTING 15 sts stocking st on 7 mm needles = 10 cm

Check your knitting tension by working a swatch. Count the number of sts per 10 cm; if you have more sts than suggested, change to a larger needle size. If you have fewer sts, change to a smaller needle size.

ABBREVIATIONS

K = knit, P = purl, st. = stitch, y/o = yarn over, DPN = double pointed needles, tbl = through back loop

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The copying and publication of materials and patterns, or their use for commercial purposes, is not allowed without prior agreement with House of Yarn AS. **Increase 1:** Pick up the yarn between 2 sts and place it on the needle, K tbl.

Cast on 30 (34) 38 (38) sts on 6 mm DPNs.

Work 3 rounds of garter st (= alternately K 1 round, P 1 round).

Work 3 rounds of stocking st. Change to 7 mm needles and work stocking st.

When the piece measures 13 (14) 15 (16) cm, increase for the thumb gusset:

Round 1: K1, increase 1, work to end of round, increase 1 = 32 (36) 40 (40) sts.

Round 2 (and every 2nd round until the increases are finished): Work stocking st.

Round 3: K2, increase 1, work until there is 1 st left on the round, increase 1, K1 = 34 (38) 42 (42) sts (2 more sts between the increases on each increase-round).

Continue increasing like this every 2nd round another 4 (4) 5 (5) times = 42 (46) 52 (52) sts.

Place the first 7 (7) 8 (8) and last 6 (6) 7 (7) sts on the round on a st-holder (= 13 (13) 15 (15) thumb-sts).

Continue with stocking st, **at the same time** cast on 1 st over the thumb (= side-st) = 30(34) 38(38) sts.

Place a marker in each side with 15 (17) 19 (19) sts both on top and underneath the mitten.

Work until the piece measures 24 (28) 32 (36) cm. Decrease by K1, K2 together after each marker and K2 together, K1 before each marker (= 4 sts decreased). Repeat the decreases every 2nd round a total of 3 times, then every round until there are 6 sts left. Cut the yarn and pull it through the remaining sts.

Place the 13 (13) 15 (17) thumb-sts on the needles and work stocking st in the round until the thumb measures approx. 4 (5) 7 (8) cm. **At the same time** on round 1, pick up 1 st in the side-st on the mitten.

On the next round decrease by K2 together the whole round, cut the yarn and pull it through the remaining sts. Work one more mitten.

FELTING

The work is felted in the washing machine, using a delicate programme and a wool detergent. If the felting is not sufficient, you can re-felt or felt in the tumble dryer. **NOTE!** Washing machines vary; try felting a swatch before felting the mittens. Shape the piece before drying.
