## RIME BEANIE

## DESIGN

House of Yarn

YARN
FAERYTALE 100 \% finest alpaca,
50 grams = approx. 175 metres

## SIZE

One Size

## YARN REQUIREMENTS

2 balls

## COLOUR

Mottled Dark Grey/Brown 726

## SUGGESTED NEEDLES

4.5 and 5 mm short circular needles

5 mm DPNs

## GAUGE

16 sts stocking st with yarn held double on 5 mm needles $=10 \mathrm{~cm}$

Check your gauge by working a swatch.
Count the number of sts per 10 cm . If you have more sts than suggested, change to a larger needle size. If you have fewer sts change to a smaller needle size.

## FIND YOUR SIZE

1. Measure a knitted garment that fits you.
2. Compare your measurements with those in the pattern.
3. Select a size based on the upper body measurements.
4. Body and sleeves may be worked longer or shorter as needed

## ABBREVIATIONS

$\mathrm{k}=\mathrm{knit}, \mathrm{p}=$ purl, st $=$ stitch, $\mathrm{R}=$ round $/$ row,
DPN $=$ double pointed needles, $\mathrm{K} 2 \mathrm{tog}=$ knit 2 together $\mathrm{m}=$ marker, $\mathrm{PM}=$ place marker, tbl = through back loop, RS/WS = right/wrong side

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Free patterns for the whole set on houseofyarn.no
The entire garment is knitted with yarn held double.

Cast on 72 sts on 4.5 mm short circular needles.
Work rib in the round (K1, P1) for 9 cm .
P 1 R ( = folding edge). Work rib in the round (K1, P1) for a further 9 cm . Turn piece inside out so that the RS faces out when you fold the edge. Continue working rib as before until the piece measures 18 cm .
Change to 5 mm needles and continue with stocking st. Work until the piece measures approx. 25 cm . PM around sts no. 1, 13, 25, 37, 49 and 61 ( $=6 \mathrm{~m}$ sts; 11 sts between each m st). Continue as follows:
R 1: *K2, K2 tog, work stocking st to 3 sts before next m st, K2 tog tbl, K1*, repeat from *-* 6 times
$=60$ sts.
R 2-4: K all sts.
R 5: Work in the same way as R 1.
R 6-7: K all sts.
R 8: Work in the same way as R 1.
R 9: K all sts
R 10: *K2, slip 1 st, K2 tog, pass the slipped st over, K1* repeat from *_* 6 times $=24$ sts

R 11: K all sts.
R 12: K 2 tog across $R=12$ sts.
Cut yarn, pull through remaining sts and fasten well.
Fold the rib edge double to the RS.
