RIME MITTENS

DESIGN

House of Yarn

YARN

FAERYTALE 100 % finest alpaca, 50 grams = approx. 175 metres

SIZE One Size

One size

YARN REQUIREMENTS 2 balls

COLOUR Mottled Dark Grey/Brown 726

SUGGESTED NEEDLES

4.5 mm and 5 mm DPNs

GAUGE

16 sts stocking st with yarn held double on 5 mm needles = 10 cm

Check your gauge by working a swatch. Count the number of sts per 10 cm. If you have more sts than suggested, change to a larger needle size. If you have fewer sts change to a smaller needle size.

FIND YOUR SIZE

- 1. Measure a knitted garment that fits you.
- 2. Compare your measurements with those in the pattern.
- 3. Select a size based on the upper body measurements.
- 4. Body and sleeves may be worked longer or shorter as needed.

ABBREVIATIONS

k = knit, p = purl, st = stitch, R = round/row, DPN = double pointed needles, K2tog = knit 2 together, m = marker, PM = place marker, tbl = through back loop

The entire garment is knitted with yarn held double.

RIGHT MITTEN

Cast on 32 sts on 4.5 mm DPNs. Work a twisted rib in the round (K1 tbl, P1) for 8 cm. Change to 5 mm needles and continue with stocking st, **while at the same time** on R 1 increasing 4 sts evenly spaced = 36 sts. PM in each side with 18 sts on each side of m. Work until the piece measures 5 cm from the ribbing. Work in a piece of contrasting yarn across the first 5 sts on R (= thumb sts). Place the sts back onto your left needle and continue as before until the piece measures 16 cm from the ribbing. Work next R as follows: *K2tog, K 4*, repeat from *-* to end of R = 30 sts. Decrease like this on every 2nd round a total of 4 times, with 1 less st between each decrease = 12 sts. Cut yarn and pull through the remaining sts.

THUMB

Remove contrasting yarn and place sts on 5 mm needles. Pick up 1 more st in each side = 12 sts. Work stocking st in the round until thumb measures 7 cm. K2 tog across R = 6 sts. Cut yarn and pull through the remaining sts.

LEFT MITTEN

Worked in the same way as right mitten but with the thumb on the opposite side, at the end of the R.
