DG 463-02 | OLDER



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DESIGN

YARN

OLDER 100 % wool, 50 grams = approx. 95 metres

SIZE

One Size

YARN REQUIREMENTS

2 balls

COLOUR

Mottled Light Grey 424

SUGGESTED NEEDLES

5 mm short circular needles and DPNs

GAUGE

18 sts with shaker st on 5 mm needles = 10 cm

Check your gauge by working a swatch.

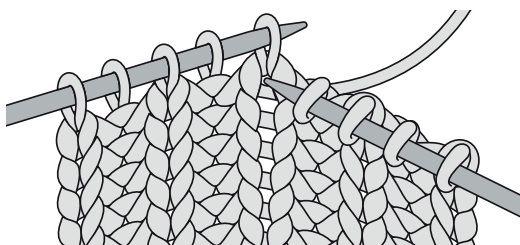
Count the number of sts per 10 cm. If you have more sts than suggested, change to a larger needle size. If you have fewer sts change to a smaller needle size.

ABBREVIATIONS

k = knit, p = purl, st = stitch, R = round/row,
k2tog = knit 2 together, m = marker, PM = place marker,
tbl = through back loop

SHAKER ST

Is worked as a normal knitted st but in the st from previous row instead of st on needle.

SHAKER STITCH

R 1: P across.

R 2: *K 1 through the stitch below, P1*, repeat from *-* to end of row.

Repeat R 1-2.

Cast on 84 sts on 5 mm needles.

Work **shaker st** in the round until the piece measures 10 cm and the next R should be P. Turn piece inside out and continue with **shaker st** as before (1st R = P). Work until piece measures 24 cm and the next R should be purred. PM around the first st (= m st). PM around 5 more sts with 13 sts between each m st = 6 m sts. **NOTE!** All m sts are shaker sts.

Continue as follows:

R 1: *Work 1 shaker st (= m st), K2 tog (1 purred st + 1 shaker st), continue as before to next m st*, repeat from *-* 6 times in total = 78 sts.

R 2: P across.

R 3: *Work 1 shaker st (= m st), P2 tog, continue as before to next m st*, repeat from *-* 6 times in total = 72 sts.

R 4: P across.

NOTE! Tighten working yarn a little when you K2 tog.

Repeat R 1-4 until you have 24 sts left and the next R should be purred.

K2 tog tbl, repeat from *-* to end of R = 12 sts.

Cut yarn, pull through the sts and fasten well.
