## RIME ACCESSORIES

## DESIGN

House of Yarn

YARN
MYK PÅFUGL 73 \% mohair, 22 \% wool, 5 \% polyamide, 50 grams = approx. 90 metres

## SIZE

One Size

## YARN REQUIREMENTS

5 balls

## COLOUR

Beige 3041

## SUGGESTED NEEDLES

5 mm short circular needles and DPNs
4.5 mm short circular needles and DPNs

6 mm short circular needles
7 mm long circular needles

## GAUGE

16 sts with stocking st on 5 mm needles $=10 \mathrm{~cm}$ 12 sts with stocking st on 7 mm needles $=10 \mathrm{~cm}$

## Check your gauge by working a swatch.

Count the number of sts per 10 cm . If you have more sts than suggested, change to a larger needle size. If you have fewer sts change to a smaller needle size.

## ABBREVIATIONS

$k=k n i t, p=p u r l$, DPN $=$ double pointed needles,
st $=$ stitch, $R=$ round $/$ row, k2tog $=$ knit 2 together,
$\mathrm{m}=$ marker, $\mathrm{PM}=$ place marker, tbl = through back loop, RS/WS = right/wrong side

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## HAT

Cast on 72 sts on 4.5 mm circular needles.
Work 9 cm rib in the round (K1, P1).
P 1 R (= folding edge). Work rib in the round (K1, P1) for a further 9 cm . Turn inside out so that the RS faces outwards when you fold the edge. Continue working rib as before until the piece measures 18 cm from the folding edge. Change to 5 mm needles and continue with stocking st. Work until the piece measures approx. 25 cm from the folding edge. PM around sts number 1, 13, 25, 37, 49, and 61 ( $=6 \mathrm{~m}$ sts with 11 sts between each m st). Continue as follows:
R 1: *К2, к2 tog, work stocking st until 3 sts remain before next $m$ st, K 2 tog tbl, K1*, repeat from *_* 6 times $=60$ sts.
R 2-4: K all sts.
R 5: Work in the same way as R 1.
R 6-7: $K$ all sts.
R 8: Work in the same way as R 1.
R 9: K all sts.
R 10: *K2, slip 1 st, K2 tog, pass the slipped st over, K1*, repeat from *-* 6 times $=24$ sts.
R 11: $K$ all sts.
R 12: $k 2$ tog across $R=12$ sts.
Cut yarn, pull through remaining sts and fasten well.
Fold the rib edge double to the RS.


## MITTENS

## RIGHT MITTEN

Cast on 32 sts on 4.5 mm needles. Work 8 cm twisted rib in the round ( $\mathrm{K} 1 \mathrm{tbl}, \mathrm{P} 1$ ). Change to 5 mm needles and continue with stocking st, while at the same time increasing 4 sts evenly spaced on R $1=36$ sts. PM in each side, with 18 sts on top of and underneath the mitten. Work until the piece measures 5 cm from the ribbing. Work in a piece of scrap yarn in a contrasting colour across the first 5 sts on $R$ (= thumb sts). Place the sts back onto your left needle and continue as before until the piece measures 16 cm from the ribbing. Work next $R$ as follows: *K2tog, K 4*, repeat from *_* to end of $R=30$ sts. Decrease like this every 2nd round a total of 4 times, with 1 less st between each decrease and until there are 12 sts left. Cut yarn and pull through the remaining sts.

## THUMB

Remove scrap yarn and place sts on 5 mm needles. Pick up 1 more st in each side $=12$ sts. Work stocking st in the round until thumb measures 7 cm . K 2 tog across $R=6 \mathrm{sts}$. Cut yarn and pull through the remaining sts.

## LEFT MITTEN

Worked in the same way as right mitten but with the thumb on the opposite side, at the end of the $R$.

## NECK WARMER

## BACK PIECE

Cast on 47 sts on 6 mm needles and work 4 cm rib flat as follows:
R 1: (= WS) Slip 1 st, P1, *K1, P1*, repeat from *_* to end of R. R 2: Slip 1 st, *K1, P1*, repeat from *_* to end of R. Change to 7 mm needles and continue working flat as follows:

Work 5 sts rib as before, 37 sts stocking st, 5 sts rib as before. When the piece measures 32 cm , cast off the middle 15 sts for the neckline and finish each side separately. Cast off 1 st on next R towards the neck $=15$ shoulder-sts.
Work until the piece measures 33 cm . Cast off.
Work the other side in the same way but in reverse.

## FRONT PIECE

Cast on and work in the same way as the back piece. When the piece measures 23 cm , cast off the middle 9 sts for the neckline and finish each side separately. Continue casting off for the neckline on every 2nd row, 2,1,1 sts $=15$ shoulder sts.
Work until the piece measures 33 cm . Cast off. Work the other side in the same way but in reverse.

## ASSEMBLY

Join the shoulder seams.

## NECKLINE

Pick up 60 sts around the neckline, on 6 mm short circular needles. St count must be divisible by 2 . Work rib in the round (K1, P1) for 24 cm . Cast off with rib sts. Fold the neck double to the RS.
