



VINDE HOOD

DG 465-07 | ALPAKKA FORTE



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DESIGN

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YARN

ALPACA FORTE 80 % alpaca, 20 % nylon,
50 grams = approx. 133 metres

SIZE

One Size

MEASUREMENTS

Full length approx. 65 cm

YARN REQUIREMENTS

4 balls

COLOUR

Mottled Beige Latte 701

SUGGESTED NEEDLES

3 mm and 3.5 mm long circular needles

GAUGE

25 sts x 28 R stocking st on 3.5 mm needles = 10 x 10 cm

Check your gauge by working a swatch.

Count the number of sts per 10 cm. If you have more sts than suggested, change to a larger needle size. If you have fewer sts change to a smaller needle size.

ABBREVIATIONS

k = knit, p = purl, DPN = double pointed needles,
st = stitch, R = round/row, k2tog = knit 2 together,
m = marker, PM = place marker, tbl = through back loop,
RS/WS = right/wrong side

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For the pattern for Mara Cardigan, see GG 306-02 on houseofyarn.no

Edge-st: Slip first st purlwise, K last st.

BACK PIECE

Cast on 87 sts on 3 mm needles and work 4 cm rib flat as follows:

1. p: (= WS) 1 edge st, P1, *K1, P1*, repeat from *-* to end of R, finish with 1 edge st.

R2: 1 edge st, K1, *P1, K1*, repeat from *-* to end of R, finish with 1 edge st.

Finish with a WS R.

Change to 3.5 mm needles and work stocking st with 5 sts of rib as before on each side. **At the same** on R 1, decrease 9 sts evenly spaced = 78 sts. **NOTE!** Leave the outer 5 sts on each side out of the decreases.

When the piece measures 28 cm, place the middle 22 sts on a st holder for the neckline and finish each side separately.

Continue decreasing for the neckline every 2nd row, 2,1 sts = 25 shoulder sts.

Work until the piece measures 30 cm. Cast off.

Work the other side in the same way but in reverse.

FRONT PIECE

Cast on and work in the same way as the back piece.

When the piece measures 23 cm, cast off the 16 sts centre front for the neckline and finish each side separately.

Continue decreasing for the neckline at the beginning of every 2nd row, 2,2,1,1 sts = 25 shoulder sts.

Work until the piece measures 30 cm. Cast off.

ASSEMBLY

Join the shoulder seams.

HOOD

Begin centre front and pick up 128 sts around the neckline, using 3.5 mm needles. PM around 2 sts in the middle of the back piece. **NOTE!** Make sure you have the same number of sts on each side of m on the back.

Work stocking st flat (R 1 = WS). On R2 increase 1 st on each side of m by **m1r** before m and **m1l** after m = 2 sts increased. Repeat increases every 4th R a total of 12 times = 152 sts.

Work until the hood measures 24 cm.

On the next RS R decrease 1 st on each side of the m st: K2 tog tbl before the m and K2 tog after the m. Repeat the decreases every 4th R, 1 more time.

Continue to decrease on every 2nd R 5 times, then on every R 11 times = 116 sts. **NOTE!** When decreasing for from the WS, P2 tog before m and P2 tog tbl after m.

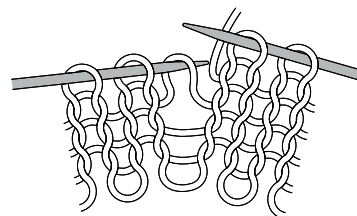
The hood now measures approx. 33 cm. Place sts on 2 needles with 58 sts on each needle, hold the piece with RS facing RS (WS out) and K together 1 st from each needle, **at the same time** as you cast off.

HOOD EDGE

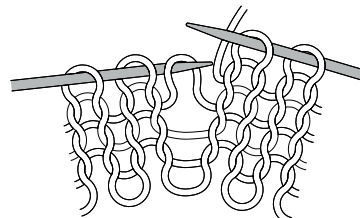
Pick up approx. 12 sts per 5 cm around the hood, using 3 mm needles. Work stocking st flat until the edge measures approx. 4 cm. Cast off loosely. Fold the edge double to the WS and sew down with loose stitches. Place one end of edge behind and one in front, at the bottom of the split in front, and sew down.

M1R AND M1L

M1l: Pick up the strand between 2 sts, place it on left needle as shown in picture, work through the back loop.



M1r: Pick up strand between 2 sts, place it on left needle as shown in picture, work the front loop.



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
