LILLE LERKE 53\% merino wool, 47\% Egyptian cotton, 50 grams $=142$ metres

## SIZES

Jacket, top and jumpsuit
3 (6) 12 (24) months

## Socks and beanie

36 (12) 24 months

## GARMENT MEASUREMENTS

## Jacket

Chest size approx. 51 (55) 58 (62) cm
Full length approx. 27 (30) 33 (36) cm
Sleeve length approx. 16 (18) 20 (24) cm

## Top

Chest size approx. 51 (54) 58 (62) cm
Full length approx. 27 (30) 33 (36) cm
Sleeve length approx. 1.5 (2) 2.5 (2.5) cm

## Jumpsuit

Hip-width approx. 44 (48) 51 (54) cm
Length (without straps) approx. 22 (25) 28 (32) cm

## YARN AMOUNTS

## Jacket

Colour 1: 2 (2) 3 (3) balls
Colour 2: 2 (2) 3 (3) balls

## Top

Colour 2: 2 (2) 3 (3) balls
Colour 1: 1 ball in all sizes

## Jumpsuit

Colour 1: 2 (2) 3 (3) balls

## Socks

Colour 1: 1 ball in all sizes

## Beanie

Colour 1: 1 ball in all sizes

## COLOURS

Colour 1: Jade green
Colour 2: Half-bleached white 0017

## SUGGESTED NEEDLE SIZE

2.5 and 3 mm circular needles and
double pointed needles (DPNs)
2.5 mm crochet hook

## ACCESSORIES

Approx. 6-8 buttons for the jacket; 2-3 buttons for the top and 2 buttons for the jumpsuit

## KNITTING TENSION

28 sts pattern A, B, C, D, E, F, G with 3 mm needles $=10 \mathrm{~cm}$ 34 rounds of pattern $\mathbf{A}, \mathbf{B}, \mathbf{C}, \mathbf{D}, \mathbf{E}, \mathbf{F}, \mathbf{G}$ with 3 mm needles $=$ 10 cm


Check your knitting tension by working a swatch.
Count the number of sts per 10 cm ; if you have more sts than suggested, change to a larger needle size. If you have fewer sts, change to a smaller needle size.

## FIND THE RIGHT SIZE

1. Measure a garment that fits
2. Compare the measurements with the pattern
3. Choose size from the chest measurements
4. Body and sleeves can be worked longer or shorter as needed.

## ABBREVIATIONS

$K=$ knit, $P=$ purl, st $=$ stitch,
$r=$ row, chst $=$ chain stitch, $d c=$ double crochet

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## JACKET

## BODY

Cast on 140 (150) 160 (170) sts with colour 2 (colour 2) colour 2 (colour 1) using 2.5 mm circular needles. Work a lining in stocking st back and forth (row 1 from the wrong side) for 2 cm . Change to 3 mm needles, cast on 5 sts at the beginning of the round and work pattern in the round according to diagram $\mathbf{A}(\mathbf{A}) \mathbf{A}(\mathbf{B})$ depending on your selected size. NOTE! The 5 new sts are purled onwards and not included in the pattern. They will be used to cut through. On the last round, cast off for the armholes. Work 30 (33) 35 (38) sts, cast off 8 sts, work 64 (68) 74 (78) sts, cast off 8 sts, work 30 (33) 35 (38) sts. Lay the piece to one side and work the sleeves.

## SLEEVES

Cast on 37 (39) 41 (43) sts with colour 1 on 2.5 mm DPNs. Work 2 cm stocking st in the round for the lining and 1 round of purl for the folding edge. Change to 3 mm needles. Count outwards so the middle of the pattern matches the middle of the sleeve and work according to diagram $\mathbf{C}$. Increase 2 sts every 1.5 cm mid-under the sleeve 7 (9) 11 (13) times $=51$ (57) 63 (69) sts. Work the new sts into the pattern. Finish at the arrow for your size and, on the last round, cast off 8 sts mid-under sleeve $=43$ (49) 55 (61) sts. Work the other sleeve in the same way.

## YOKE

Place right front piece, one sleeve, back piece, other sleeve and left front piece on the same 3 mm circular needles $=$ 210 (232) 254 (276) sts. Work pattern in the round according to diagram $\mathbf{D}(\mathbf{E}) \mathbf{F}(\mathbf{G})$ and decrease sts evenly as described = 75 (79) 83 (87) sts left.


## NECK

Cast off the 5 sts mid-front. Change to 2.5 mm needles and yarn colour 1. Work rib back and forth with K1, P1 (finish with K1) for 4 (4) $5(5) \mathrm{cm}$. Cast off a little loosely with $K$ and $P$.

## ASSEMBLY

Sew 2 double machine seams down the 5 sts mid-front and cut between the seams. Fold the neck double to the inside and sew down with loose stitches. Sew together the armholes. Fold the lining at the bottom of the jacket up to the right side and sew the short edges together. Then fold the lining to the inside and sew down. Fold the lining on the sleeves to the wrong side and sew down.

## LEFT BAND GIRL/RIGHT BAND BOY

Begin at the top/bottom and knit up from the right side 1415 sts pr 5 cm with colour 1 and 2.5 mm needles. Make sure to knit up through both layers on the neck.
Work stocking st back and forth (first row from wrong side) for approx. 1.5 cm . Cast off. Fold the band to the wrong side so it covers the cut edge and sew down.

## RIGHT BAND GIRL/LEFT BAND BOY

Is worked in the same way as the first band but work buttonholes to finish as follows: Crochet 1 row of double crochets along the edge and work 6-8 button-loops with chain stitches. The number of chain sts depends on the size of the buttons. Sew on the buttons.

## TOP

## BODY

Cast on 144 (150) 162 (174) sts with colour 2 on 2.5 mm circular needles. Work rib in the round with K1, P1 for 3 (3.5) $4(4.5) \mathrm{cm}$. Change to 3 mm needle and work pattern according to diagram $\mathbf{H}$ until the piece measures approx. 18 (20) 22 (24) cm. Finish on a round marked ' $x$ ' or ' $y$ ' in the diagram and cast off for the armholes on the last round as follows: Cast off 4 sts, work 64 (67) 73 (79) sts, cast off 8 sts, work 64 (67) 73 (79) sts, cast off 4 sts. Cut the yarn. Continue with yarn colour 2, but now starting the round mid-back. Knit 2 rounds and, on round 1, cast on 41 (46) 50 (54) sts in each side over the 8 cast-off sts $=210(226) 246(266)$ sts. Work pattern according to diagram I and decrease evenly spaced as described $=108$ (126) 150 (168) sts. Continue back and forth to leave an opening mid-back.
3 months: Insert a marker thread after the 9th, 27th, 45th, 63rd, 81st and 99th sts.
6 months: Insert a marker thread after the 10th, 31st, 52nd, 73rd, 94th and 115th sts.

12 months: Insert a marker thread after the 13th, 38tht, 63rd, 88th, 113th and 138th sts.

24 months: Insert a marker thread after the 14th, 42nd, 70th, 98th, 126th and 154th sts
All sizes: Work stocking st with colour 2 and decrease on the 3rd row as follows: Before the marker threads, slip 1 st, K1 and pass the slipped st over the knitted st. After the marker threads, K2 together.


A total of 12 sts decreased on row 1 . Repeat these decreases every 3rd row a total of $2(3) 5(6)$ times $=84(90) 90(96)$ sts.
NOTE! When decreasing from the wrong side, work as follows: Before the marker threads, P2 together. After the marker threads, P1, place this st back on the left needle, pass st no. 2 (which has not been worked) over st no. 1 (which you have just worked) and move the st onto the right needle. After the decreases work 1 (2) 1 (1) more row and decrease $9(11) 7$ (9) sts evenly spaced $=75(79) 83$ (87) sts. Change to 2.5 mm needles and work 3.5 (4) 4.5 (5) cm rib with K1, P1 (finish with K1). Cast off slightly loosely.

## ASSEMBLY

Knit up 44 (50) 56 (62) sts around one armhole with colour 2 and 2.5 mm DPNs. Work rib in the round with K1, P1 for 1.5 (2) 2.5 (2.5) cm. Cast off. Work the other sleeve-edge in the same way. Fold the neck double to the inside and sew down with loose stitches. Work double crochets around the opening at the back and work 2-3 chain-st loops. The number of chain sts in each loop depends on the size of the buttons. Sew on the buttons.

## JUMPSUIT

Cast on 54 (58) 62 (66) sts with yarn colour 1 on 2.5 mm circular needles. Work rib in the round with K1, P1 for 2 (2.5) 2.5 (3) cm. Change to 3 mm needles. The outermost st on each side is knitted on all rows = edge st. Work 8 (9) 10 (11) rows of pattern according to diagram $\mathbf{J}$ and increase 1 st on each row inside each edge st $=70(76) 82(88)$ sts. Work 1 row without increasing. Work one more leg in the same way. Place both legs on the same circular needle and continue the pattern according to diagram $\mathbf{J}$ in the round over all sts. $=140(152) 164(176)$ sts. Start the round mid-back. Insert a marker around 2 sts mid-front and 2 sts mid-back $=$ marker sts. On round 3, K 2 together after the marker sts and K 2 twisted together before the marker sts =

4 sts decreased on round 1. Repeat this decrease every 2nd round a total of 4 (4) 5 (6) times $=124$ (136) 144 (152) sts. Work until the trousers measure 12 (14) 16 (18) cm from the crotch. Insert a marker mid-back = beginning of round. Continue with diagram $\mathbf{J}$ and work the back of the trousers higher as follows: Work 6 sts. Turn, slip 1 st and work 11 sts. Turn, slip 1 st and work 17 sts. Turn, slip 1 st and work 23 sts. Continue like this, working 6 sts more each time you turn, until you have turned 4 (5) 5 (6) times on each side. Move all sts onto 2.5 mm circular needles. Work rib in the round with K1, P1. When the waistband measures 4.5 (5.5) 6 (7) cm, work 2 buttonholes mid-front. Leave 18 (20) 22 (24) sts between them and work the buttonholes as follows: K2 together, make 1 double yarn over, K2 twisted together. On the next round work the double yarn over as K1, P1 (or P1, K1). Continue with K1, P1 over all sts until the waistband measures 6 (7) 8 (9) cm. Cast off with $K$ and $P$.

## STRAPS

Cast on $8(8) 8(10)$ sts with colour 1 on 2.5 mm needles. Work garter st back and forth (knit from both right and wrong side) for 20 (22) 24 (26) cm. Cast off. Work the other strap in the same way

## ASSEMBLY

Sew the crotch of the trousers together. Sew the straps to mid-back, approx. 1 cm down on the wrong side of the waistband. Sew a button onto the end of each strap.

## SOCKS

Cast on 37 (41) 45 sts with colour 1 on 2.5 mm needles. Work garter st back and forth (all rows knitted) for 5 (5.5) 6 cm . On the next row, work a row of holes: K1, *1 yarn over, K2 together*, repeat from *-* to the end of the row. Work approx. 1 cm of garter st, finishing from the wrong side. Place the outermost 13 (14) 15 sts on each side on a thread

and continue garter st over the middle 11 (13) 15 sts until the instep measures approx. 5 (6) 7 cm , with the last row from the wrong side. Cut the yarn. Work the 13 (14) 15 sts from the right side onto 2.5 mm needles and knit up 14 (16) 18 sts along one side of the instep, work the 11 (13) 15 sts mid-front, knit up 14 (16) 18 sts along the other side of the instep and work the last 13 (14) 15 sts $=65$ (73) 81 sts. Work garter st back and forth over all sts and decrease 1 st on each side every 4th row 3 times $=59$ (67) 75 sts. When you have worked a further 3.5 (4) 4.5 cm , cast off 24 (27) 30 sts on each side. Continue working the 11 (13) 15 sts for the sole.

When the sole measures 6.5 (7.5) 9 cm , decrease 1 st on each side every 2 nd row, do this 3 times. Cast off. Work the other sock in the same way. Sew each sock together. Twist 2 cords of double strands and thread them through the row of holes or insert a silk ribbon.

## BEANIE

Cast on 106 (114) 122 sts with yarn colour 1 on short 2.5 mm circular needles. Work rib in the round, with K1, P1, for 8 (9) 10 cm . Change to 3 mm needles and work pattern according to diagram $\mathbf{J}$ until the piece measures approx. 7 (8) 9 cm from the rib, and the last 2 rounds in the pattern have been purled. Adjust the number of sts on the next round $(K)$ to 108 (108) 120. On the next round (K) decrease 12 sts as follows: *K7 (7) 8, K2 together*, repeat from *_* to the end of the round $=96$ (96) 108 sts. $K 1$ round. On the next round (K) decrease again: *K6 (6) 7, K2 together*, repeat from *_* to the end of the round $=84(84) 96$ sts. $P 2$ rounds, $K 1$ round without decreasing. On the next round $(K)$ decrease again: K5 (5) 6, K2 together*, repeat from *-* to the end of the round $=72(72) 84$ sts. $K 1$ round. On the next round (K) decrease again: *K4 (4) 5, K2 together*, repeat from *_* to the end of the round $=60(60) 72$ sts. Continue like this, decreasing 12 sts every 2 nd and 4 th round in the stocking st stripes until there are 12 sts left. Knit 1 round then $K 2$ together for the whole of the next round. Change to 2.5 mm needles and work a small "stalk" over the last 6 sts Work from the same side the whole time, pulling the working yarn from the left, behind the piece to the right and working stocking st for 2.5 cm . K2 together for the whole of the next row, cut the yarn, pull it through the last 3 sts and fasten well.
Fold up the bottom edge on the beanie. DIAGRAM



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
