## FUNFETTI JUMPER

## DESIGN

House of Yarn

## YARN

MERINO 22, 100 \% extra fine merino wool,
50 grams = approx. 125 metres

## SIZES

2 (4) 6 (8) 10 (12) years
NOTE! See GARMENT MEASUREMENTS to find the right size

## GARMENT MEASUREMENTS

Chest size approx. 62 (64) 69 (73) 80 (87) cm
Full length approx. 36 (38) 41 (43) 47 (52) cm
Sleeve-length approx. 24 (28) 34 (35) 38 (40) cm

## YARN AMOUNTS

| Colour 1 | $2(2) 2(3) 3(3)$ balls |
| :--- | :--- |
| Colour 2 | $3(3) 4(4) 5(6)$ balls |
| Colour 3 | $1(1) 1(1) 2(2)$ balls |
| Colour 4 | 1 ball in all sizes |

## COLOURS

Colour $1 \quad$ Bright green 2031
Colour 2 Lollipop 2034
Colour 3 Ice blue 2028
Colour 4 Yellow 2030

## SUGGESTED NEEDLE SIZES

3.5 and 4 mm long and short circular needles and DPNs

## KNITTING TENSION

22 sts $\times 31$ rounds on 4 mm needles $=10 \times 10 \mathrm{~cm}$
NOTE! The knitting tension in height is important in this project. If you do not get 31 rounds in height, you should adjust the striped pattern to get the correct body and sleeve lengths.

Check your knitting tension by working a swatch. Count the number of sts per 10 cm ; if you have more sts than suggested, change to a larger needle size. If you have fewer sts, change to a smaller needle size.

## FIND THE RIGHT SIZE

1. Measure a garment that fits you
2. Compare the measurements with the pattern.
3. Choose your size from the chest measurements.
4. Body and sleeves can be worked longer or shorter as needed

## ABBREVIATIONS

$K=$ knit, $P=$ purl, st. = stitch, $y / o=$ yarn over, DPN = double pointed needles, tbl = through back loop


## STRIPED PATTERN A

Work *4 rounds with colour 2, 2 rounds with colour 1*, repeat from *_* a total of 5 (6) 7 (7) 7 (8) times, *4 rounds with colour 2,2 rounds with colour3*, repeat from *-* a total of $2(2) 3(3) 5(6)$ times, $4(4) 0(4) 0(0)$ rounds with colour 2.

## STRIPED PATTERN B

Work *4 rounds with colour 2, 2 rounds with colour 1*, repeat from *_* a total of 6 (7) 9 (9) 10 (10) times, *4 rounds with colour 2, 2 rounds with colour3*, repeat from *_* a total of $3(4) 6(6) 7(8)$ times, $4(4) 0(4) 0(0)$ rounds with colour 2.

## STRIPED PATTERN C

Work 2 (2) 0 (2) $0(0)$ rounds with colour 3, *4 rounds with colour 2, 2 rounds with colour 3*, repeat from *_* a total of $2(2) 3(2) 2(2)$ times (you now have 5 (5) 6 (6) 7 (8) stripes with colour 3 on the body + yoke).
*4 rounds with colour 2,2 rounds with colour 4*, repeat from *_* until the yoke is finished.

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## BODY

Cast on 136 (140) 152 (160) 176 (192) sts with colour 1 on 3.5 mm circular needle

Work rib in the round (K2, P2) for 6 cm . Place a marker in each side with $68(70) 76(80) 88(96)$ sts on both the front and back pieces.
Change to 4 mm needles. Work stocking st and striped
pattern A. At the same time, on the last round cast off 8 (8) 10 (10) 12 (12) sts on each side for the armholes (= 4 (5) 5 (5) $6(6)$ sts on each side of the markers) $=60$ (62) 66 (70) 76 (84) sts on the front and back pieces. The piece measures approx. 21 (23) 25 (27) 29 (33) cm. Leave the stitches on the needle.

## SLEEVES

Cast on 36 (36) 40 (40) 44 (44) sts with colour 1 on 3 mm DPNs. Work rib in the round (K2, P2) for 5 cm . Change to 4 mm needles
Place a marker around the first and last sts = marker sts. Continue with stocking st and striped pattern B
At the same time, when the sleeve measures 6 cm , increase 1 st on each side of the marker-sts. Repeat the increase every 2.5 (2) 3.5 (2.5) 3 (2.5) cm a total of 7 (9) 8 (10) 10 (11) times = 50 (54) 56 (60) 64 (66) sts.
On the last round in the striped pattern, cast off 8 (8) 10 (10) 12 (12) sts mid-under the sleeve (= 4 (5) 5 (5) 6 (6) sts on each side) $=42$ (46) 46 (50) 52 (54) sts. The sleeve measures approx. 24 (28) 34 (35) $38(40) \mathrm{cm}$.
Leave the stitches on the needle. Work the second sleeve

## YOKE

Place the left sleeve, front piece, right sleeve and back piece on 4 mm circular needles = 204 (216) 224 (240) 256 (276) sts. Place a marker around 2 sts in each transition ( $=1$ st from sleeve and 1 st from front or back piece) $=4$ markers Continue with stocking st and striped pattern C
At the same time, on round 1, decrease for raglan by knitting 2 sts together tbl before each marker and knitting 2 together after each marker. Repeat the raglan decreases every 4th round a total of 8 (8) 8 (7) 9 (10) times, then every 2 nd round 6 (7) 8 (10) 9 (10) times. At the same time, when you have decreased 10 (11) 12 (12) 13 (15) times for raglan, cast off 10 (10) 12 (14) 16 (16) sts mid-front for the neck. Cast off for the neck, at the beginning of each row, 3,2 sts on each side then 1 st until you have decreased 14 (15) 16 (17) 18 (20) times for raglan. At the same continue to decrease for raglan every 2nd row as before. NOTE! When decreasing for raglan from the wrong side, P2 together before each marker and P2 together tbl after each marker.

## NECKLINE

Change to 3 mm circular needles and knit up approx. 10 sts per 5 cm with colour 1, including the sts on the needle. The stitch count should be divisible by 4 . Work 3.5 cm rib in the round with $\mathrm{K} 2, \mathrm{P} 2$. Loosely cast off with $K$ and $P$.

## ASSEMBLY

Sew together the openings under the sleeves
