## KIMMI T-SHIRT

### DESIGN

Mari Kalberg Skjæveland

### YARN

ØKO BOMULL 100 % organic cotton,  
50 grams = approx. 100 metres

**Alternative yarns:** LERKE, MERINO 22

### SIZES

2 (4) 6 (8) 10 (12) years

**NOTE!** See GARMENT MEASUREMENTS to find the right size

### GARMENT MEASUREMENTS

Chest size approx. 61 (64) 69 (74) 80 (87) cm

Length approx. 36 (40) 44 (48) 52 (56) cm

Sleeve-length approx. 4 (5) 5 (6) 6 (6) cm

### YARN AMOUNTS

Colour 1 3 (3) 4 (5) 5 (6) balls

Colour 2 1 (1) 1 (1) 2 (2) balls

Colour 3 1 (1) 1 (1) 2 (2) balls

### COLOURS

Colour 1 Off-white 302

Colour 2 Jade green 305

Colour 3 Flax 303

### SUGGESTED NEEDLE SIZES

3 mm and 4 mm long and short circular needles and DPNs

### KNITTING TENSION

22 sts x 30 rounds stocking st on 4 mm needles = 10 cm

**Check your knitting tension by working a swatch.**

**Count the number of sts per 10 cm; if you have more sts than suggested, change to a larger needle size. If you have fewer sts, change to a smaller needle size.**

### FIND THE RIGHT SIZE

1. Measure a garment that fits you.
2. Compare the measurements with the pattern.
3. Choose your size from the chest measurements.
4. Body and sleeves can be worked longer or shorter as needed.

### ABBREVIATIONS

K = knit, P = purl, st. = stitch, y/o = yarn over,

DPN = double pointed needles, tbl = through back loop



#### TIP!

To get a neat transition when working stripes: Change colour and work 1 round. On round 2 work the first st on the round as follows: K the st from the previous round instead of the st on the needle. K to end of round.

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### BODY

Cast on 134 (140) 152 (162) 176 (192) sts with colour 1 on 3 mm circular needles. Work rib in the round (K1, P1) for 3 cm. Change to 4 mm needles and continue with stocking st and pattern according to the diagram. Place a marker in each side with 67 (70) 76 (81) 88 (96) sts on both the front and back pieces. Work until the piece measures approx. 20 (23) 26 (29) 32 (34) cm. On the last row, cast off 8 (8) 10 (10) 12 (12) sts each side for the armholes (= 4 (4) 5 (5) 6 (6) sts on each side of the markers) = 59 (62) 66 (71) 76 (84) sts on both the front and back pieces. Leave the sts on the needle.

### SLEEVES

Cast on 50 (52) 56 (60) 64 (68) sts with colour 1 on 3 mm circular needles. Work rib in the round (K1, P1) for 2 cm. Change to 4 mm needles and continue with stocking st and pattern according to the diagram. Begin at the arrow for your chosen size. Work until the piece measures approx. 4 (5) 5 (6) 6 (6) cm. Finish on the same round as on the body. On the last round, cast off 8 (8) 10 (10) 12 (12) sts mid-under sleeve (= marker-st + 3 (3) 4 (4) 5 (5) sts on each side) = 42 (44) 46 (50) 52 (56) sts. Work one more sleeve in the same way.

### YOKE

Place the left sleeve, front piece, right sleeve and back piece on 4 mm circular needles = 202 (212) 224 (242) 256 (280) sts. Place a marker around 2 sts in each transition (= 1 st from sleeve and 1 st from front or back piece) = 4 markers. Marker-sts are always knitted. Continue working as before. **At the same time** on round 2, decrease for raglan: K2 together tbl before each marker and K2 together after each marker = 8 sts decreased. Repeat the raglan decreases every 4th round 8 more times, then every 2nd round 3 (4) 5 (7) 8 (11) times.

**At the same time** when you have decreased for raglan 8 (8) 9 (10) 11 (14) times, cast off 11 (12) 14 (15) 16 (18) sts mid-front for the neckline. Continue working back and forth and cast off for the neckline at the beginning of each row, 2,2 (2,2) 2,2, (2,2,2) 3,2,2, (3,2,2) sts on each side, then 1 st on each side until the raglan decreases are finished. **NOTE!** When decreasing for raglan from the wrong side, P2 together before each marker and P2 together tbl after each marker. Cast off.

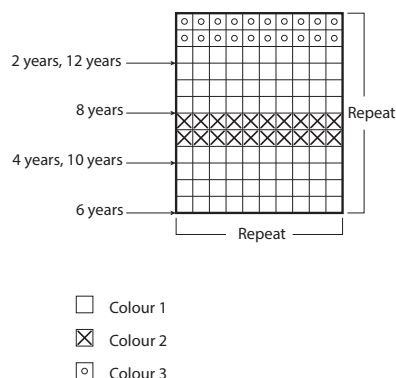
### NECK

Use 3 mm needles and colour 1. Begin on the left back shoulder and pick up 10-11 sts per 5 cm around the neckline. Work 1 round of stocking st, **at the same time** as you adjust your stitch count to 106 (108) 112 (114) 118 (120) sts. Work 3 cm rib in the round with K1, P1. Loosely cast off with rib.

### ASSEMBLY

Sew together the openings under the sleeves.
