YARN

ALPAKKA FORTE 80 % alpaca, 20 % nylon, 50 grams = approx. 133 metres

SIZES

3-6 (9-12) months 2 (4) 6 (8) 10 (12) years **NOTE!** See GARMENT MEASUREMENTS and find the right size

GARMENT MEASUREMENTS

Jumper

Chest measurement approx. 54 (59) 61 (64) 68 (76) 76 (80) cm Full length measured mid-front approx. 32 (34) 38 (40) 44 (48) 52 (55) cm

Sleeve-length approx. 17 (19) 24 (27) 33 (36) 38 (40) cm

Beanie

Circumference approx. 38 (43) 45 cm

YARN AMOUNTS

Jumper

3 (3) 4 (4) 5 (6) 7 (8) balls

Beanie

1 (2) 2 balls

COLOURS

Mottled grey 715

SUGGESTED NEEDLE SIZES

3 and 3.5 mm long and short circular needles and DPNs

KNITTING TENSION

25 sts with stocking st and needle size 3.5 mm = 10 cm 30 rounds stocking st with needle size 3.5 mm = 10 cm

Check your knitting tension by working a swatch.

Count the number of sts per 10 cm; if you have more sts than suggested, change to a larger needle size. If you have fewer sts, change to a smaller needle size.

FIND THE RIGHT SIZE

- 1. Measure a garment that fits you.
- 2. Compare the measurements with the pattern.
- 3. Choose your size from the chest measurements.
- 4. Body and sleeves can be worked longer or shorter as needed.

ABBREVIATIONS

K = knit, P = purl, st. = stitch, r = row, DPN = double pointed needles, m1r = make one right, m1l = make one left

The piece is worked top down.

LACE PATTERN

Round 1: *K2 together, 1 yarn over,* repeat from *-* to end of round.

Round 2: Repeat round 1.

JUMPER

YOKE

Loosely cast on 90 (92) 94 (96) 100 (102) 104 (106) sts with circular needle size 2.5 mm and work rib in the round for 5 (5) 5 (6) 6 (6) 6 (6) cm (K1 twisted, P1). Change to size 3 mm needles. Work 6 (6) 7 (7) 7 (9) 9 (9) rounds of stocking st, **at the same time** on round 2, increase 26 (28) 36 (38) 40 (46) 50 (54) sts evenly spaced = 116 (120) 130 (134) 140 (148) 154 (160) sts.

Work **lace pattern**. Continue with 6 (6) 7 (7) 7 (9) 9 (9) rounds of stocking st, **at the same time** on round 2, increase 22 (26) 34 (36) 42 (48) 48 (54) sts evenly spaced = 138 (146) 164 (170) 182 (196) 202 (214) sts.

Work **lace pattern**. Continue with 6 (6) 7 (7) 7 (9) 9 (9) rounds of stocking st, at the same time on round 2, increase 20 (24) 26 (26) 30 (48) 48 (46) sts evenly spaced = 158 (170) 190 (196) 212 (244) 250 (260) sts.

Work **lace pattern**. Mark the piece into sections as follows: Work 1 marker-st, 48 (52) 56 (58) 62 (70) 72 (75) sts (= back piece), 1 marker-st, 29 (31) 37 (38) 42 (50) 51 (53) sts (= left sleeve), 1 marker-st, 48 (52) 56 (58) 62 (70) 72 (75) sts (= front piece), 1 marker-st, 29 (31) 37 (38) 42 (50) 51 (53) sts (= right sleeve). Continue with stocking st. On round 2 increase for raglan by **m1r** before each marker-st and **m1l** after each marker-st = 8 increased sts. Repeat the increases for raglan every 2nd round a total of 8 (9) 9 (10) 10 (11) 11 (12) times = 222 (242) 262 (276) 292 (332) 338 (356) sts.

Divide the piece at each marker-st, with 45 (49) 55 (58) 62 (72) 73 (77) sts on each sleeve and 66 (72) 76 (80) 84 (94) 96 (101) sts on the front and back piece.

SLEEVES

Cast on 7 (7) 7 (6) 8 (8) 7 (7) sts mid-under sleeve and place sts from sleeve on needle size 3 mm = 52 (56) 62 (64) 70 (80) 80 (84) sts. Work 14 (15) 16 (18) 23 (26) 28 (30) cm stocking stitch in the round.

Decrease 16 (18) 20 (20) 24 (32) 30 (34) sts evenly spaced on the last round= 36 (38) 42 (44) 46 (48) 50 (50) sts.

Change to needle size 2.5 mm and work rib in the round for

3 (4) 8 (9) 10 (10) 10 (10) cm (K1 twisted P1). Loosely cast off with K and P. Work one more sleeve in the same way.

BODY

Knit up 7 (7) 7 (6) 8 (8) 7 (7) sts under each sleeve, and place sts from front and back pieces on needle size 3 mm = 146 (158) 166 (172) 184 (204) 206 (216) sts. Work stocking st in

the round for 17 (18) 20 (21) 24 (27) 28 (30) cm. Change to needle size 2.5 mm and work rib for 3 (4) 5 (5) 5 (6) 7 (7) cm (K1 twisted, P1). Loosely cast off with K and P.

ASSEMBLY

Fold the neck double to the inside and sew down.

BFANIF

Cast on 96 (108) 112 sts with short circular needle size 3 mm. Work rib in the round for 4 (5) 6 cm (K1 twisted, P1). Change to needle size 3.5 mm and work *5 rounds of stocking st, then **lace pattern***, repeat from*-* one more time

Continue with stocking st until piece measures 13 (17) 20 cm, **at the same time** on the last round, adjust the st-number to 96 (108) 108 sts.

Continue decreasing for the top of the beanie as follows: *K10, K2 together* repeat from $*_-*$ to the end of the round = 88 (99) 99 sts.

Work 4 rounds without decreasing.

K9, K2 together repeat from *-* to the end of the round = 80 (90) 90 sts.

Work 4 rounds without decreasing.

Continue decreasing in this way, with 1 sts less between each decrease and until there are 16 (18) 18 sts left.

K2 together along the whole round = 8 (9) 9 sts.


Cut the yarn, pull it through the sts and fasten well.

ASSEMBLY


Make a pom pom and sew it to top of beanie.

M1R AND M1L

M1l: Pick up the strand between 2 sts, place it on left needle as shown in picture, work through the back loop.



M1r: Pick up strand between 2 sts, place it on left needle as shown in picture, work the front loop.



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
