#### MARIVOLL DRESS

#### **DESIGN**

Ane Kydland Thomassen

#### YARN

ALPAKKA FORTE 80 % alpaca, 20 % nylon, 50 grams = approx. 133 metres

#### **SIZES**

3-6 (9-12) months 2 (4) 6 years

**NOTE!** See GARMENT MEASUREMENTS to find the right size

## **GARMENT MEASUREMENTS**

Chest measurements approx. 48 (52) 56 (59) 64 cm Full length, measured mid-front, approx. 36 (41) 46 (51) 56 cm Width at bottom approx. 84 (96) 108 (120) 132 cm Sleeve length approx. 17 (19) 24 (27) 33 cm

## YARN AMOUNTS

4 (4) 5 (6) 7 balls

#### **COLOURS**

Mottled crimson 724

# **SUGGESTED NEEDLE SIZES**

3 and 3.5 mm long and short circular needles and DPNs

# **KNITTING TENSION**

25 sts with stocking st and needle size 3.5 mm = 10 cm 30 rounds stocking st with needle size 3.5 mm = 10 cm

Check your knitting tension by working a swatch.

Count the number of sts per 10 cm; if you have more sts than suggested, change to a larger needle size. If you have fewer sts, change to a smaller needle size.

## **FIND THE RIGHT SIZE**

- 1. Measure a garment that fits you.
- 2. Compare the measurements with the pattern.
- 3. Choose your size from the chest measurements.
- 4. Body and sleeves can be worked longer or shorter as needed.

## **ABBREVIATIONS**

K = knit, P = purl, st. = stitch, r = row, DPN = double pointed needles, m1r = make one right, m1l = make one left

The piece is worked top down.

#### **LACE PATTERN**

**Round 1:** \*K2 together, 1 yarn over,\* repeat from \*-\* to end of round.

Round 2: Repeat round 1.

#### YOK

Loosely cast on 88 (90) 92 (94) 98 sts with circular needle size 3 mm and work rib in the round for 5 (5) 5 (6) 6 cm (K1 twisted, P1).

Work 5 (5) 6 (6) 7 rounds of stocking st, **at the same time** on round 2, increase 16 (20) 24 (26) 30 sts evenly spaced = 104 (110) 116 (120) 128 sts.

Work **lace pattern**. Continue with 5 (5) 6 (6) 7 rounds of stocking st, **at the same time** on round 2, increase 16 (18) 24 (26) 30 sts evenly spaced = 120 (128) 140 (146) 158 sts.

Work **lace pattern**. Continue with 5 (5) 6 (6) 7 rounds of stocking st, **at the same time** on round 2, increase 16 (18) 24 (28) 34 sts evenly spaced = 136 (146) 164 (174) 192 sts.





Work **lace pattern**. Mark the piece into sections as follows: Work 1 marker-st, 38 (41) 46 (49) 54 sts (= back piece), 1 marker-st, 28 (30) 34 (36) 40 sts (= left sleeve), 1 marker-st, 38 (41) 46 (49) 54 sts (= front piece), 1 marker-st, 28 (30) 34 (36) 40 sts (= right sleeve). Continue with stocking st. On round 2. increase for raglan by each marker-st by **m1r** before each marker-st and **m1l** after each marker-st = 8 increased sts. Repeat the increases for raglan every 2nd round a total of 7 (8) 8 (9) 9 times = 192 (210) 228 (246) 264 sts. Divide the piece by each marker-st, with 42 (46) 50 (54) 58 sts on each sleeve and 54 (59) 64 (69) 74 sts on front and back piece.

#### **SLEEVES**

Cast on 6 sts mid-under sleeve and place the sts for the sleeve on needle size 3.5 mm = 48 (52) 56 (60) 64 sts. Work 14 (15) 16 (18) 23 cm stocking st in the round. Decrease 14 (16) 18 (20) 22 sts evenly spaced on the last round = 34 (36) 38 (40) 42 sts. Change to needle size 3 mm and work 3 (4) 8 (9) 10 cm rib in the round (K1 twisted, P1). Loosely cast off with K and P. Work one more sleeve in the same way.

# **SKIRT**

Knit up 6 sts under each sleeve and place the sts for the front and back pieces on needle size 3.5 mm = 120 (130) 140 (150) 160 sts. Work stocking st in the round, **at the same time**, on round 1, increase as follows: Work \*12 (13) 14 (15) 16 sts, increase 1 st \*, repeat from \*-\* to end of round = 10 increased sts. Repeat the increase every 2 cm a total of 9 (11)


13 (15) 17 times = 210 (240) 270 (300) 330 sts. Work until the piece measures 32 (37) 42 (47) 52 cm from neckline. Work **lace pattern**, then 3 rounds of stocking st. Finish with  $^*$ P 1 round, K 1 round\*, repeat from \*-\* 2 more times. Cast off with P.

## **ASSEMBLY**


Fold the neck double to the inside and sew down.

# M1R AND M1L

M1l: Pick up the strand between 2 sts, place it on left needle as shown in picture, work through the back loop.



M1r: Pick up strand between 2 sts, place it on left needle as shown in picture, work the front loop.
