YARN

LERKE 53 % merino wool, 47 % Egyptian cotton, 50 grams = approx. 115 metres

Alternative yarn: ALPAKKA FORTE CLASSIC, NATURAL LANOLIN WOOL, MERINO 22

SIZES

2 (4) 6 (8) 10 (12) years **NOTE!** See MEASUREMENTS to find the right size

MEASUREMENTS

Upper body approx. 61 (65) 68 (72) 77 (83) cm Full length approx. 30 (34) 36 (40) 44 (47) cm Sleeves approx. 24 (27) 33 (36) 38 (40) cm

YARN REQUIREMENTS

4 (5) 6 (8) 9 (10) balls

COLOUR

Pink 8161

SUGGESTED NEEDLES

3.5 mm and 4 mm short and long circular needles and DPNs

GAUGE

22 sts textured pattern on 4 mm needles = 10 cm

Check your gauge by working a swatch.

Count the number of sts per 10 cm. If you have more sts than suggested, change to a larger needle size. If you have fewer sts change to a smaller needle size.

FIND THE RIGHT SIZE

- 1. Measure a knitted garment that fits.
- 2. Compare measurements with those in the pattern.
- 3. Select a size based on the upper body measurements.
- 4. Body and sleeves may be worked longer or shorter as desired.

ABBREVIATIONS

k = knit, p = purl, st = stitch, R = round/row,
DPN = double pointed needles, k2tog = knit 2 together,
m = marker, PM = place marker, tbl = through back loop,
RS/WS = right/wrong side

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BODY


Cast on 132 (140) 148 (156) 168 sts on 3.5 mm circular needles. Work 5 (5) 6 (6) 7 (7) cm rib in the round (K2, P2). Change to 4 mm circular needles. K across 1 R, **while at the same time** adjusting your st count to 134 (142) 150 (158) 170 (182) sts.

PM in each side with 67 (71) 75 (79) 85 (91) sts for both the front and back pieces.

Continue as follows: Work *67 (71) 75 (79) 85 (91) sts in pattern according to diagram* = front piece. Repeat from *-* = back piece. Begin diagram at the arrow for your chosen size. Work until the piece measures 19 (22) 25 (28) 31 (34) cm. **At the same time** on the last round, cast off 8 sts on each side for the armholes (= 4 sts on each side of m) = 59 (63) 67 (71) 77 (83) sts on the front and back pieces. Lay to one side and work the sleeves.



DIAGRAM



Place the 3 sts back onto your left needle and k3, repeat from *-* 1 more time. Place the st back onto your left needle and k3tog

SLEEVES

Using 3.5 mm DPNs, cast on 36 (40) 40 (44) 44 (48) 48 sts. Work 8 (8) 10 (10) 12 (12) cm rib in the round (K2, P2). Change to 4 mm needles. K across 1 R, **while at the same time** increasing 17 (17) 21 (21) 21 (25) sts evenly spaced = 53 (57) 61 (65) 69 (73) sts.

Work textured pattern according to diagram. Begin on the R marked with an arrow for your size on the left hand side of diagram. Count outwards from middle of sleeve to determine where the diagram should begin. **NOTE!** If less than 4 sts remains between the middle knots under the sleeve, work stocking st instead of knots.

Work until the sleeve measures approx. 24 (27) 33 (36) 38 (40) cm. NOTE! End with the same R in the diagram as on the body/front and back pieces. At the same time on the last round, cast off the middle 8 sts under the sleeve (= first 4 and final 4 sts on R) = 45 (49) 53 (57) 61 (65) sts. Work the other sleeve in the same way.

YOKE

Place left sleeve, front piece, right sleeve and back piece on 4 mm circular needles = 208 (224) 240 (256) 276 (296) sts. PM in each transition = 4 markers. Continue with textured pattern as before.

At the same time on R3, decrease for raglan by working to 2 sts before each m, K2tog, slip 1 st, K1, pass slipped st over = 8 sts decreased. **NOTE!** If less than 1 st remains between the knots and the raglan decreases, work stocking st instead of knots.

Repeat the raglan decreases every 2nd R, 13 (14) 15 (16) 17 (18) times in total = 104 (112) 120 (128) 140 (152) sts. Place the middle front 11 (13) 13 (15) 17 (19) sts on a st-holder for the neckline. Continue working flat. Continue working raglan decreases as before, **while at the same time** casting off for neckline at the beginning of each R, 2 sts in each side, then 1 st until the raglan decreases meet the neckline. **NOTE!** When decreasing for raglan from the WS, P2tog tbl before each m and P2 together after each m.

NECKLINE

Change to 3.5 mm needles. Pick up approx. 2 st per cm along the neckline and work in the sts from the st holder. The st count must be divisible by 4. Work 6 cm rib (K2, P2) in the round.

Cast off with K and P sts.

ASSEMBLY

Join underarm seams. Fold the neck double to the inside and sew down.

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
