## COSETTE PONCHO

## DESIGN

Brit Frafjord Ørstavik

## YARN

MULTI POPKORN 12 \% mohair, 24 \% wool, 24 \% acrylic, $9 \%$ nylon, $31 \%$ polyester, 50 grams = approx. 135 metres

## SIZES

2-4 (6-8) 10-12 years

## MEASUREMENTS

Width, sleeve edge to sleeve edge approx. 53 (69) 80 cm Full length approx. 36 (43) 54 cm

## YARN REQUIREMENTS

5 (6) 7 balls

## COLOUR

Powder Pink 503

## SUGGESTED NEEDLES

3 mm long circular needles
2.5 mm short circular needles

## GAUGE

22 sts stocking st on 3 mm needles $=10 \mathrm{~cm}$

Check your gauge by working a swatch. Count the number of sts per 10 cm . If you have more sts than suggested, change to a larger needle size. If you have fewer sts change to a smaller needle size.

## FIND THE RIGHT SIZE

1. Measure a knitted garment that fits.
2. Compare your measurements with those in the pattern.
3. Select a size based on the upper body measurements.
4. Body and sleeves may be worked longer or shorter as needed.

## ABBREVIATIONS

$\mathrm{k}=$ knit, $\mathrm{p}=\mathrm{purl}$, st $=$ stitch, $\mathrm{R}=$ round/row(s),
DPN = double pointed needles, K 2 tog $=$ knit 2 together,
tbl = through back loop, m1l/r = make one (new st) left/ right, $\mathrm{m}=$ marker, $\mathrm{PM}=$ place marker, $\mathrm{RS} / \mathrm{WS}=$ right/wrong side

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## MOSS ST

R 1: ( $=W$ ) *K1, P1*, repeat from *-* to end of R.
R 2: $P$ through $K$ sts and $K$ through $P$ sts.
Repeat R 2.

Edge sts: $K$ first st, slip last st $P$-wise.

The poncho is worked in one piece, from the front piece to the back piece.

Cast on 116 (152) 176 sts on 3 mm needles. Work for 4 cm as follows: 1 edge st, moss st until 1 st remains, 1 edge st.
Continue as follows: Work 1 edge st, 8 sts moss st, stocking st until 9 sts remain, 8 sts moss st, 1 edge st. Work until the piece measures 29 (35) 44 cm , finish with 1 WS R. Work 42 (60) 71 sts as before, work the next 32 (32) 34 sts as before, then place these sts on a st holder for neckline, work 42 (60) 71 sts as before. Finish each side separately.


## M1R AND M1L

M11: Pick up the strand between 2 sts, place it on left needle as shown in picture, work through the back loop.


M1r: Pick up strand between 2 sts, place it on left needle as shown in picture, work the front loop.


## RIGHT SIDE

R 1: (= WS) Work 1 edge st, 8 sts moss st, stocking st until 1 st remains, m 1 (lift up the bar between 2 sts and P it tbl), place final st on a st holder.
R 2: Slip 1 st K-wise, K2, K2tog tbl, work in pattern until 9 sts remain, 8 sts moss st, 1 edge st.
Repeat R 1-2 a total of 7 (9) 10 times $=35$ (51) 61 shoulder sts.
PM = middle of shoulder
Work further neck increases as follows:
R 1: (= WS) Work 1 edge st, 8 sts moss st, stocking st until 1 st remains, $\mathbf{m 1 l}(P$ st tbl), place final st on a st holder.
R 2: Slip 1 st K-wise, K2, m1l, work in pattern until 8 sts remain, 8 sts moss st, 1 edge st.
Repeat R 1-2, 4 times in total (same for all sizes).

## LEFT SIDE

R 1: (= WS) Slip 1 st P-wise, work in pattern until 9 sts remain, 8 sts moss st, slip 1 st P-wise.
R 2: 1 edge st, 8 sts moss st, stocking st until 5 sts remain, slip 1 st K-wise, slip next st K-wise, place the 2 sts back on left needle and K2tog tbl, K2, m11, place final st on a st holder. Repeat R 1-2 a total of 7 (9) 10 times $=35$ (51) 61 shoulder sts.
Work further neck increases as follows:
R 1: (= WS) Slip 1 st P-wise, work in pattern until 9 sts remain, 8 sts moss st, 1 edge st.
R 2: Work 1 edge st, 8 sts moss st, stocking st until 3 sts remain, $\mathbf{m 1 r} \mathrm{K} 2, \mathbf{m 1 l}$, place final st on a st holder. Repeat R 1-2, 4 times in total (same for all sizes). Turn, and cast on 38 (42) 46 sts at beginning of $R$ as follows ( $=$ neck sts): *K1 through first st, place st back on left needle*, repeat from *_*. Place sts on a st holder

## BACK PIECE

Place all sts on the same 3 mm needles $=116$ (152) 176 sts. Continue working as on front piece until back piece is 4 cm shorter than the front piece, measured from the shoulder $m$. Work for 4 cm as follows: 1 edge st, moss st until 1 st remains, 1 edge st. Finish with 1 R from WS.
Cast off as follows: *Insert needle into the first st, pull the second st through the first st and $K$ the st. Place st back onto left needle*, repeat from *-* to end of R.

## ASSEMBLY

Place sts on 2.5 mm needles. Begin to the left of the neckline and work a rib (K1, P1) in the round for 14 (16) 18 cm .
At the same time on R 1, pick up 1 st through each st across the neck sts. On the next R, work these sts into the rib = 94 (102) 110 sts.
Turn the piece inside out and cast off as follows: *Insert needle into the first st, pull the second st through the first st and $K$ the st. Place st back onto left needle*, repeat from *-* to end of $R$.
