YARN

ALPAKKA FORTE 80 % alpaca, 20 % nylon,
50 grams = approx. 133 metres

SIZES

S (M) L (XL)

NOTE! See GARMENT MEASUREMENTS to find the right size

GARMENT MEASUREMENTS

Chest measurements approx. 103 (109) 115 (120) cm

Full length approx. 66 (68) 70 (72) cm

Sleeve-length approx. 54 cm or to desired length

YARN AMOUNTS

Colour 1: 10 (11) 12 (13) balls

Colour 2: 2 balls in all sizes

COLOURS

Colour 1: Light mottled grey 716

Colour 2: Mottled curry yellow 702

SUGGESTED NEEDLE SIZES

3 and 3.5 mm long and short circular needles and DPNs

ACCESSORIES

5 buttons

KNITTING TENSION

25 sts with stocking st and needle size 3.5 mm = 10 cm

28 rounds stocking st with needle size 3.5 mm = 10 cm

Check your knitting tension by working a swatch.

Count the number of sts per 10 cm; if you have more sts than suggested, change to a larger needle size. If you have fewer sts, change to a smaller needle size.

FIND THE RIGHT SIZE

1. Measure a garment that fits you.
2. Compare the measurements with the pattern.
3. Choose your size from the chest measurements.
4. Body and sleeves can be worked longer or shorter as needed.

ABBREVIATIONS

K = knit, P = purl, st. = stitch, r = row, DPN = double pointed needles, m1r = make one right, m1l = make one left

FRONT AND BACK PIECES

Cast on 269 (283) 297 (311) sts with colour 2 and 3 mm needles.

Work 5 cm rib back and forth, with P1, K1 (row 1 = wrong side). **At the same time**, when the piece measures 2 cm, work a buttonhole on the left side as follows: Work 3 sts, cast off 3 sts, work to end of row.

On next row cast on 3 new sts over the cast-off sts. Place 10 sts on each side (= front edges) on st-holder = 249 (263) 277 (291) sts. Insert a marker in each side, with 60 (63) 67 (70) sts on each front piece and 129 (137) 143 (151) sts on back piece. Change to colour 1 and needle size 3.5 mm. Continue with stocking st back and forth until piece measures 38 (39) 40 (41) cm. Finish with a row from the wrong side.

Decrease for V-neck on next row as follows: K2, slip 1 st, K1, pass slipped st over. Work until there are 4 sts left. K2 together, K2. Repeat the decreases every 1.5 cm a total of 15 (15) 17 (17) times. **At the same time**, when the piece measures 41 (42) 43 (44) cm, cast off 8 (8) 8 (10) sts in each side (= 4 (4) 5 (5) sts on each side of side-markers). Finish each piece separately.

BACK PIECE

= 121 (129) 135 (141) sts.

Continue back and forth with stocking st and cast off for the armholes on both sides every 2nd row, 2,2,1,1,1 sts = 107 (115) 121 (127) sts.

Work until the piece measures 63 (65) 67 (69) cm. Cast off for diagonal shoulders at beginning of each row from the armholes, 7,7,7,7,6 (8,8,8,8,5) 8,8,8,8,7 (9,9,9,9,5) sts. Cast off the remaining 39 (41) 43 (45) sts. Work the other side in the same way but in reverse.

RIGHT FRONT PIECE

Continue stocking st back and forth and cast off for the armhole every 2nd row, 2,2,1,1,1 sts, **at the same time** continue to decrease for V-neck until you have decreased a total of 15 (15) 17 (17) times. Work until the piece measures 63 (65) 67 (69) cm. Work the diagonal shoulder in the same way as on back piece.

LEFT FRONT PIECE

Work in the same way as the right front piece but in reverse.

SLEEVES

Cast on 60 (62) 64 (66) sts with colour 2 and needle size 3 mm.

Work rib in the round (K1, P1) for 6 cm. Change to colour 1 and needle size 3.5 mm. Insert a marker round 2 sts mid-under sleeve = marker-sts. Continue with stocking st. When the sleeve measures 7 cm, increase 1 st on each side of the marker-sts. Repeat the increase every 1.5 cm a total of 23 (24) 25 (26) times = 106 (110) 114 (118) sts.

Work until the sleeve measures 54 cm, or to desired length.

At the same time, on the last round, cast off 8 (8) 8 (10) sts mid-under sleeve (= marker-sts and 3 (3) 3 (4) sts on each side) = 98 (102) 106 (108) sts. Continue stocking st back and forth and cast off for the sleeve cap every 2nd row 5,4,3,2,2 sts, then 1 st 6 (7) 8 (9) times, 6 sts 1 time, 8 sts 1 time = 26 (28) 30 (30) sts. Cast off the remaining sts. Work one more sleeve in the same way.

ASSEMBLY

Sew together the shoulder seams. Sew in the sleeves.

RIGHT FRONT EDGE

Place sts from the st-holder on 3 mm needles and cast on 1 st towards the front piece = 11 sts. Continue the rib with colour 2 until it reaches mid-back of neck when slightly stretched.

Cast off.

Mark positions for 5 buttons. The bottom position corresponds to the buttonhole on left side, the top approx. 0.5 cm below the beginning of V-neck.

LEFT FRONT EDGE

Is worked in the same way as right edge but with buttonholes corresponding to the button positions

ASSEMBLY

Sew the front edges to front pieces and neckline. Sew the front edges together at the back of the neck. Sew on the buttons.
