

Bear head with music box

Material

- 20 cm fabric
- Music box no. 51007
- Embroidery thread and eyes
- Soft toy filling about 50 gram
- Cord or ribbon
- Wooden ring
- Optional: patch
- Optional: Vlies/interlining for thin or very elasticated fabric qualities

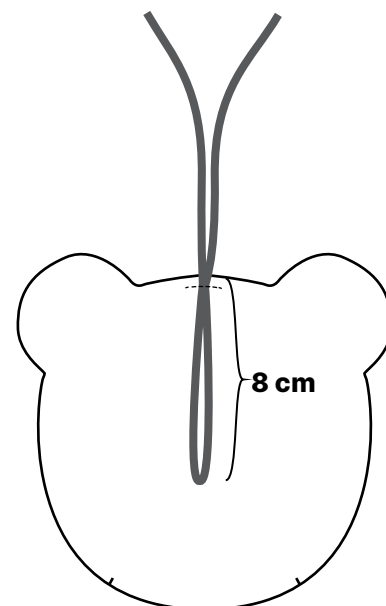

Instructions:

- Cut 2 pieces for the head from the templet
- Iron on vlies/interlining onto the wrong side
- Embroider the nose onto one of the pieces for the head, mount eyes
- Fold one 40 cm piece of cord/ribbon double and stitch it onto one of the pieces at the notch. See fig. 1.
- Stitch the 2 pieces together right side against right side, let the piece between the bottom notches stay open, to turn through.
- Trim the seam allowance in the curve and turn inside out, press.
- Tie the music box onto the cord/ribbon and place it about 3 cm from the seam allowance.
- Fill the bear head with soft toy filling and around the musical box.
- Stitch the hole together with small invisible stitches, leave a small piece open for the cord from the musical box and so it can slide easily.
- Tie the wooden ring to the musical box's cord.
