

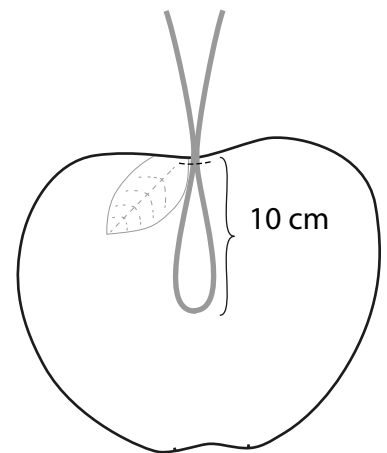
Apple with music box

FREE
DIY



Materials

- 20 cm fabric
- Lightweight interface
- Anorak cord
- Music box no. 51007
- Fibre filling
- Optional: wooden ring and patch



- Using the template, cut 2 apple pattern pieces in fabric.
- Iron lightweight interface onto the wrong side of the fabric.
- Using the template, cut 2 leaves in fabric.
- Sew leaves together right sides together. Leave gap open at bottom.
- Mitre corner, turn leaves right side out.
- Fill leaf with a little fibre filling. Topstitch as shown on the template.
- Sew leaf to one apple (as shown on the template). NB: 0.5cm seam allowance.
- Cut a 35cm length of anorak cord. Fold cord in half.
- Sew to one apple (at the notch). See fig. 1
- Sew apple pattern pieces together with right sides together.
- Leave gap between notches open.
- Turn right side out.
- Tie the music box to the cord. Fill the apple with fibre filling.
- Close the gap at the bottom with invisible stitching.
- Make sure you can still pull the musical box cord.
