# Felt angels

## Materials

- Felt: 1.3 mm thick
- Felt: 3 mm thick
- Iron-on transfer foil
- Glue gun and glue cartridges
- Marker pen, felt tip pen
- Scissors
- Embroidery thread and embroidery needle
- Bells

*By the way...! you can make angels in any colour you like.*



**1.** Make sure you have everything you need. Print the template.



**2.** Cut out the templates. Draw all the parts on felt with the marker pen. The body, face and halo are made of 3 mm felt. The wings and back are made of 1.3 mm felt. Cut out.



**3.** Draw embroidery lines as shown on the template. Backstitch with 3 strands of embroidery thread.



**4.** Draw the halo on iron-on transfer foil (see template). Cut out.



**5.** Iron the foil onto the felt halo (refer to instructions on iron-on transfer foil packaging):.



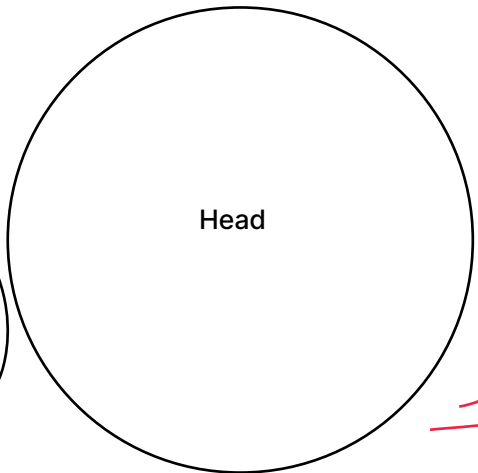
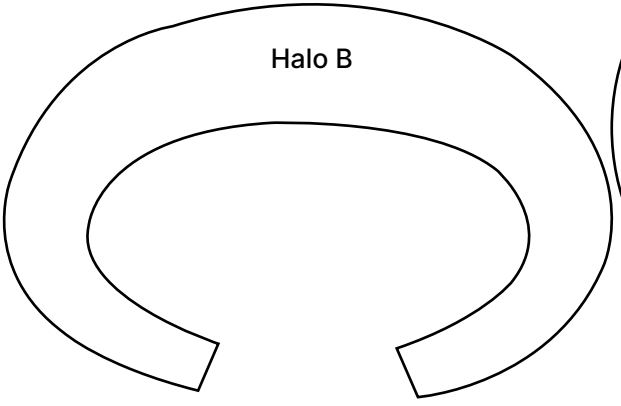
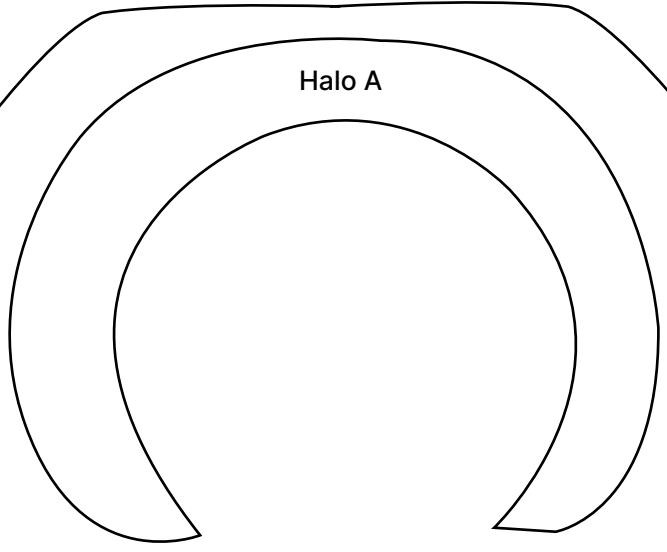
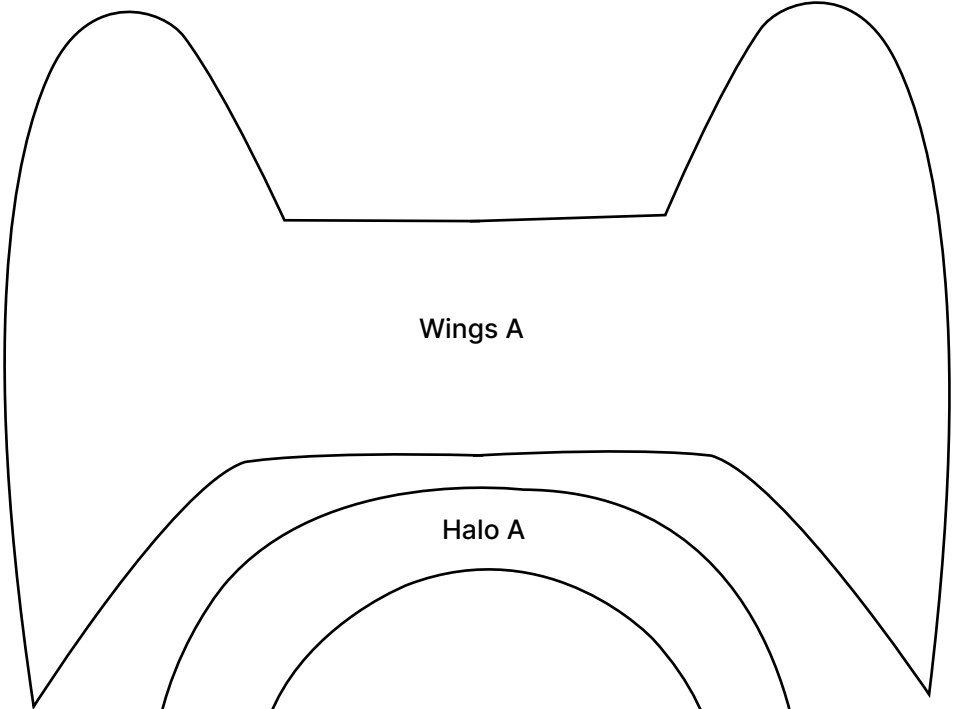
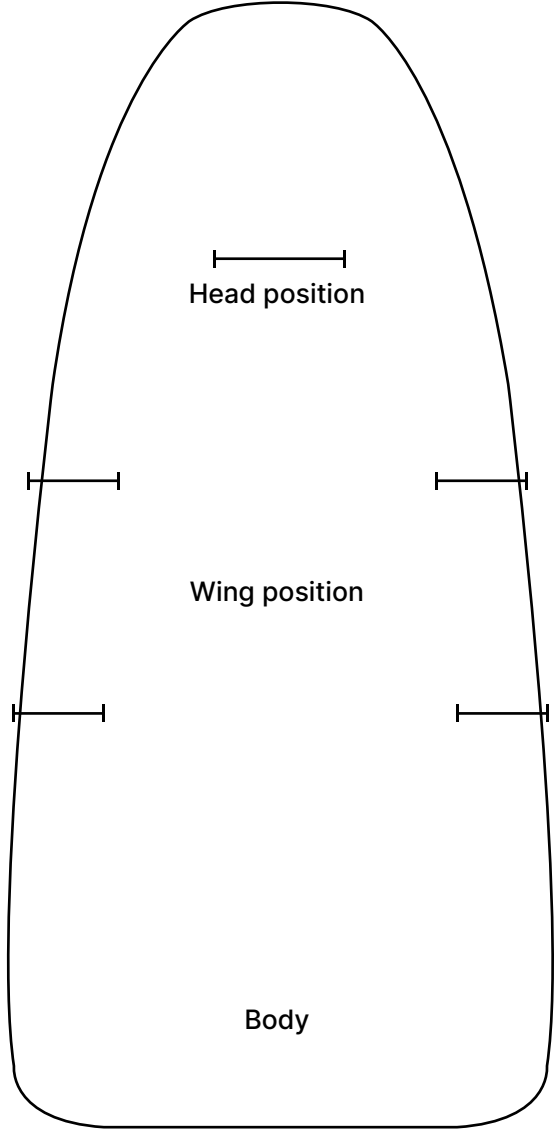
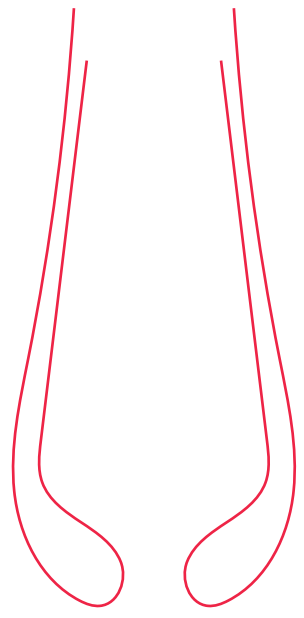
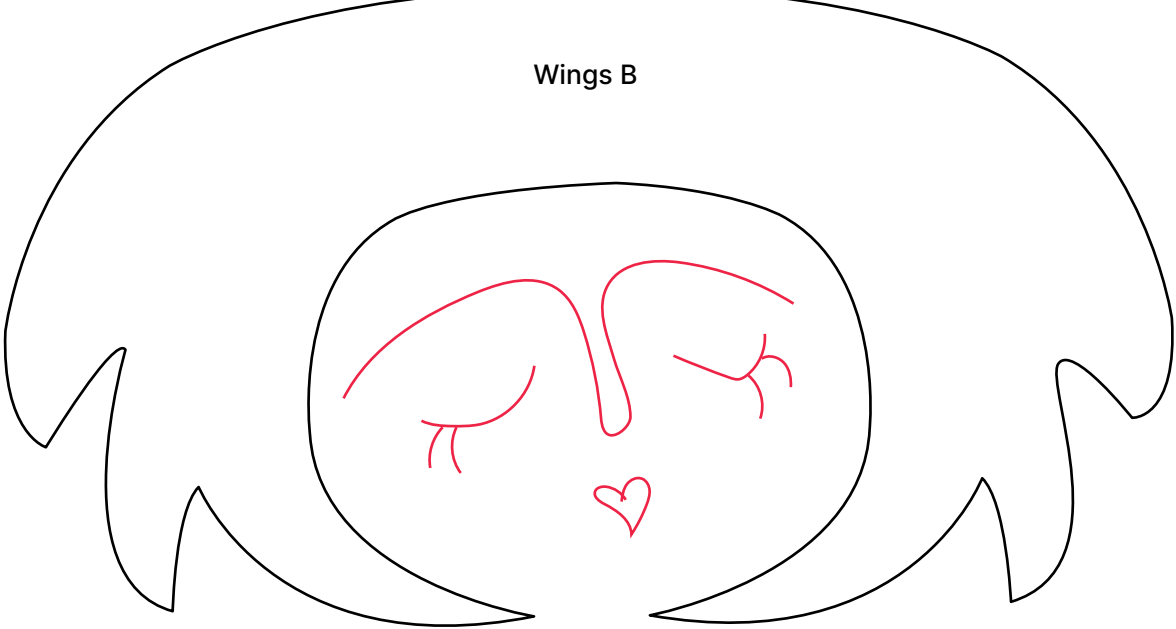
**6.** Allow the halo to cool, then remove the foil backing.

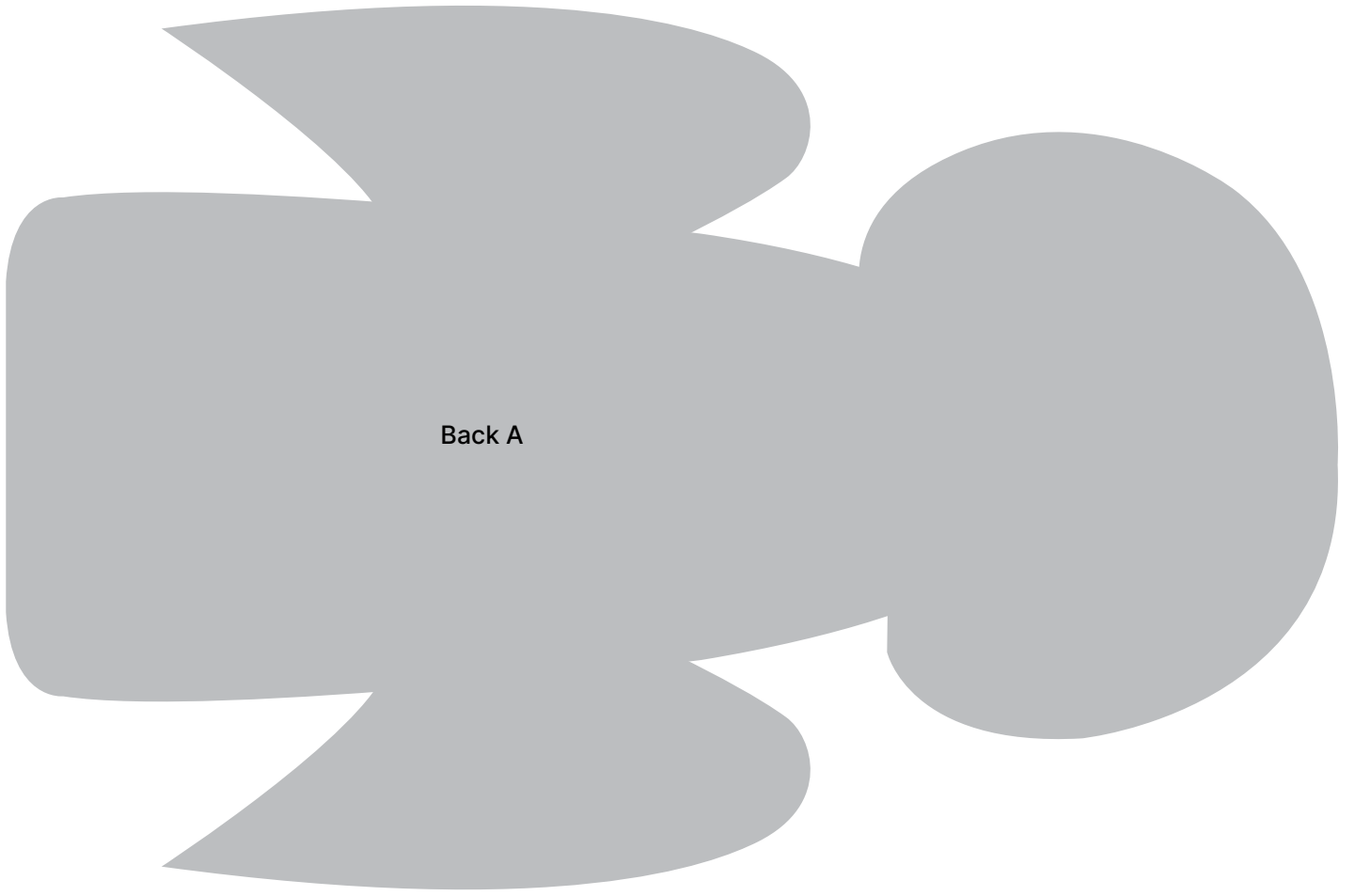


**7.** Glue all the parts together with a glue gun. Insert the wings between the body and the back. Glue the face on last.

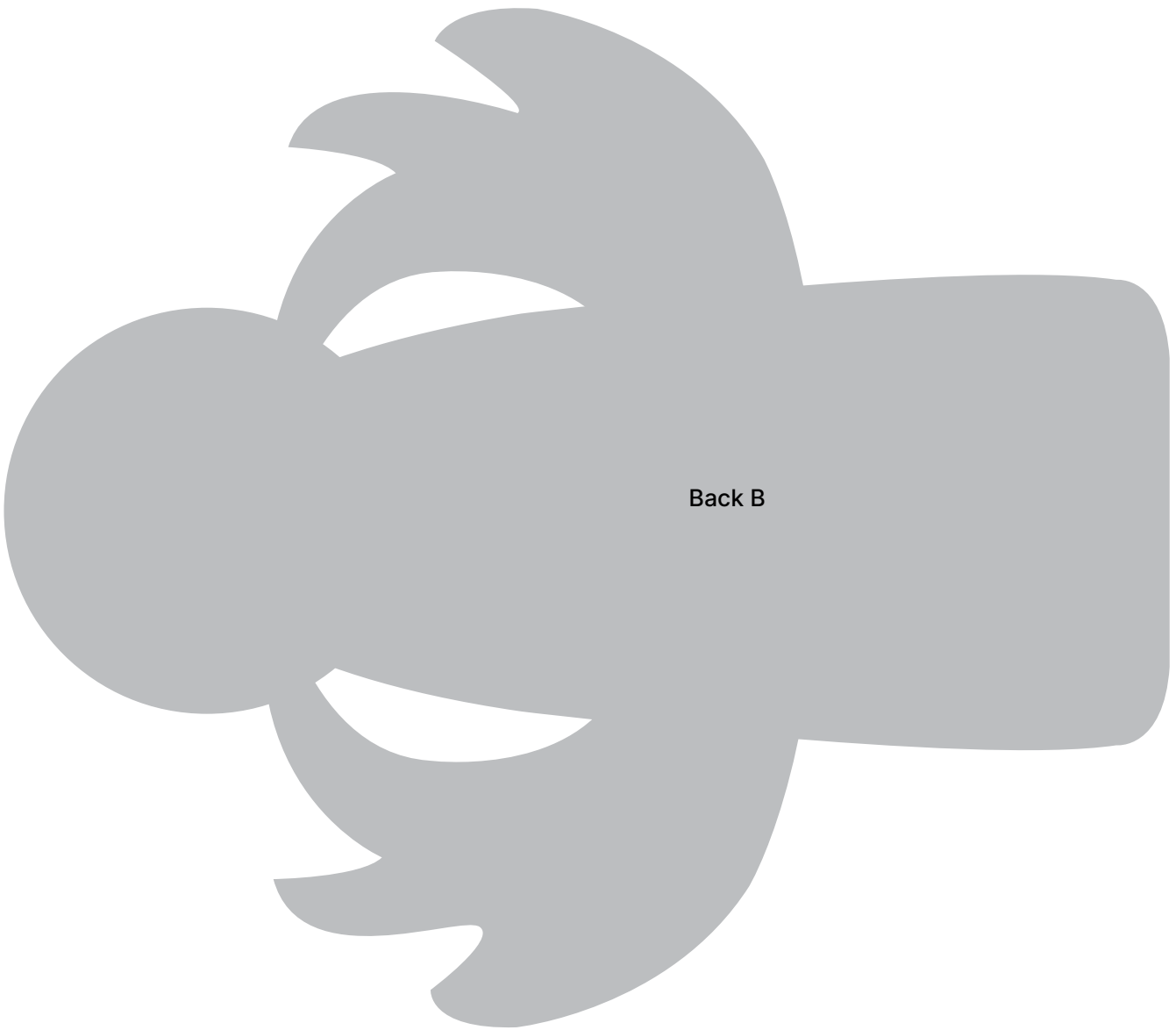


**8.** We used embroidery thread for hanging. If you wish, you can tie a bell to the embroidery thread.
