# Braided Christmas Hearts in PAP FAB

## Materials

- PAP FAB
- Templates
- Ribbon
- Cutting mat
- Metal ruler
- Pencil
- Scissors
- Sticky tape

*By the way...! These lovely Christmas hearts will look great on your Christmas tree, front door and elsewhere.*



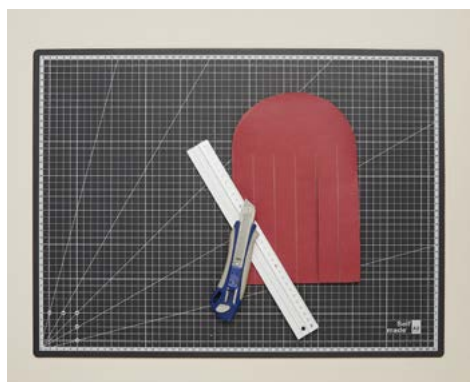
**1.** Make sure you have everything you need. Print the templates. Cut them out. There are 5 sizes. For the 2 largest sizes, decide how many squares you want in the finished heart before starting to draw.



**2.** Steam iron the PAP FAB sheet at medium heat to ensure that it is completely flat. Draw around the template, using a pencil. Don't forget the fold.



**3.** It is important that your drawing is very precise. Cut along the outer edge.



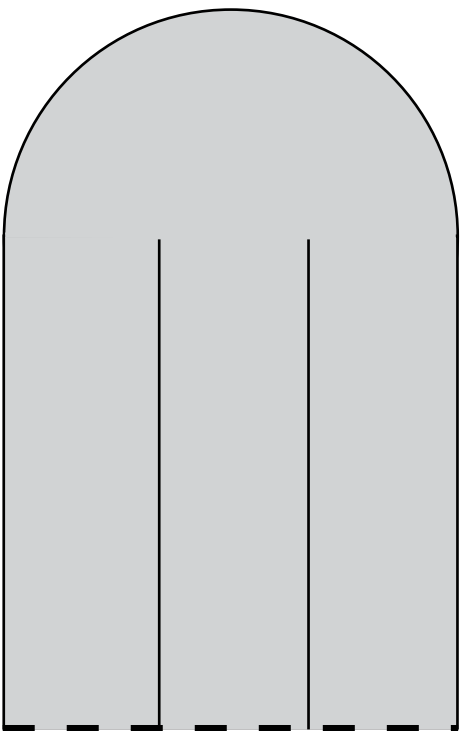
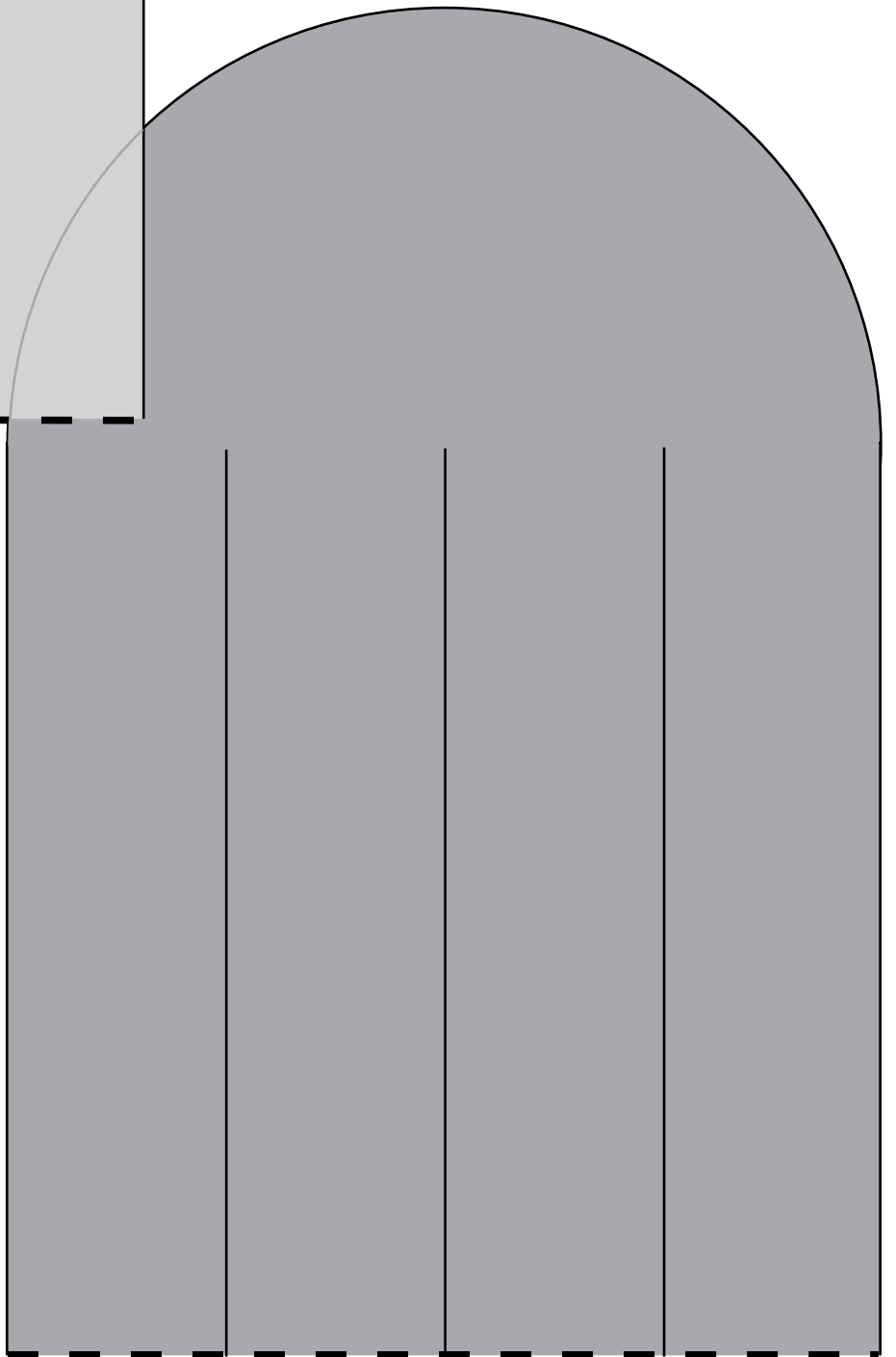
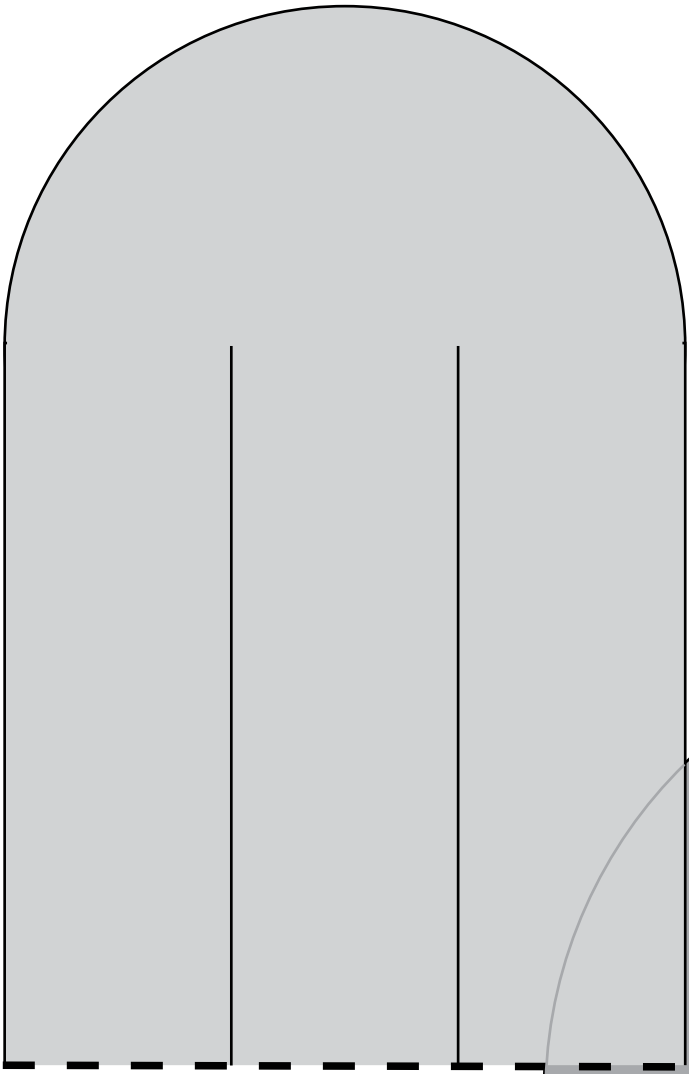
**4.** Fold the pattern piece before cutting the strips. Then fold the pattern piece the other way so that the pencil lines are concealed on the inside.



**5.** Braid the strips. Make sure that your braiding is firm.

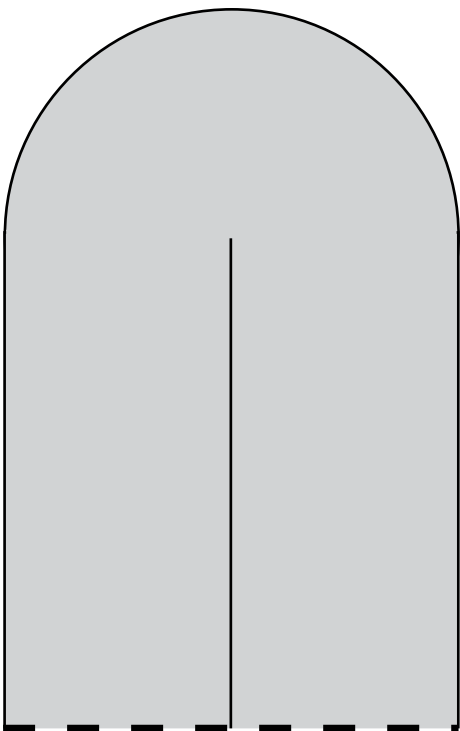
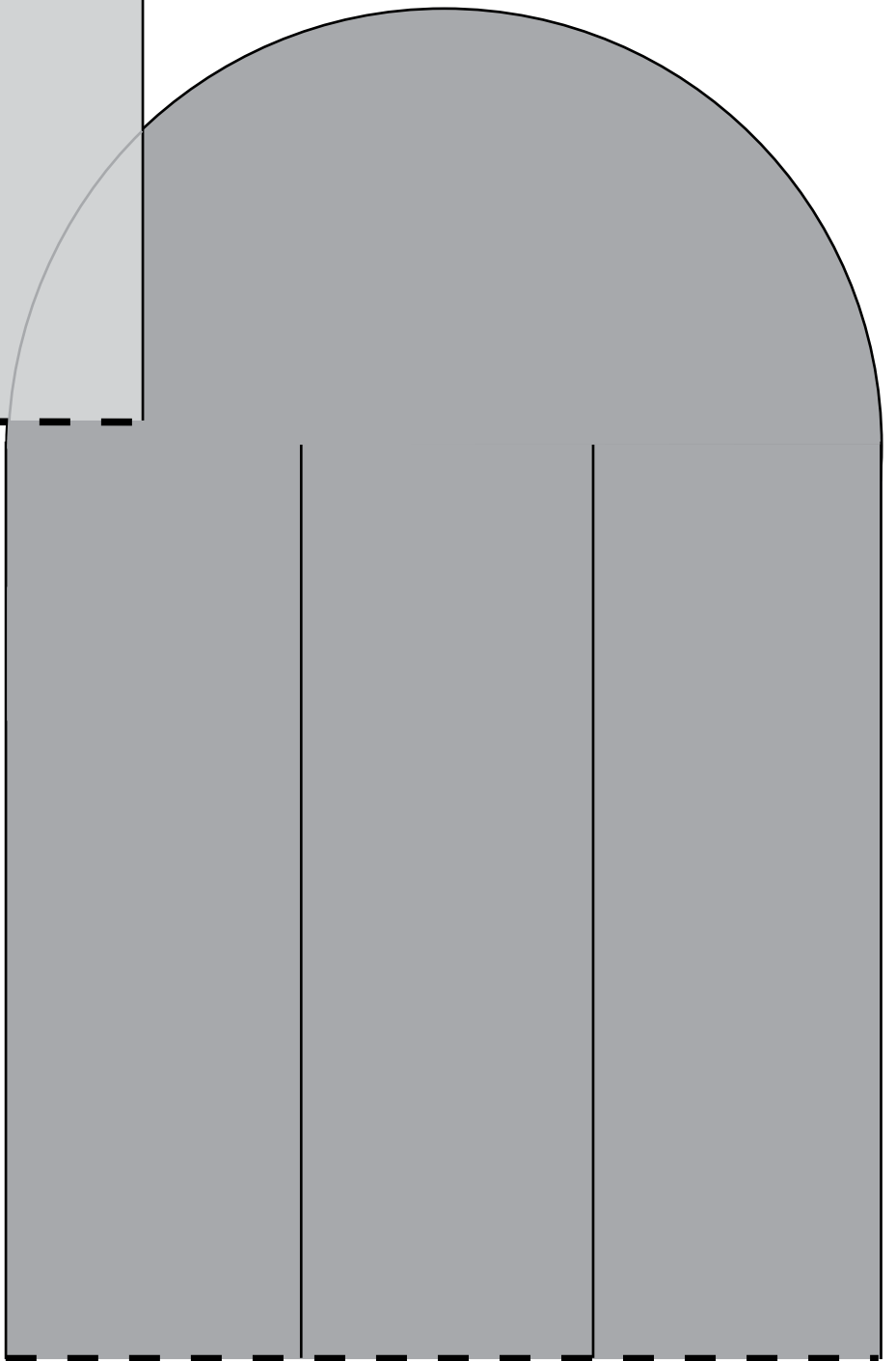
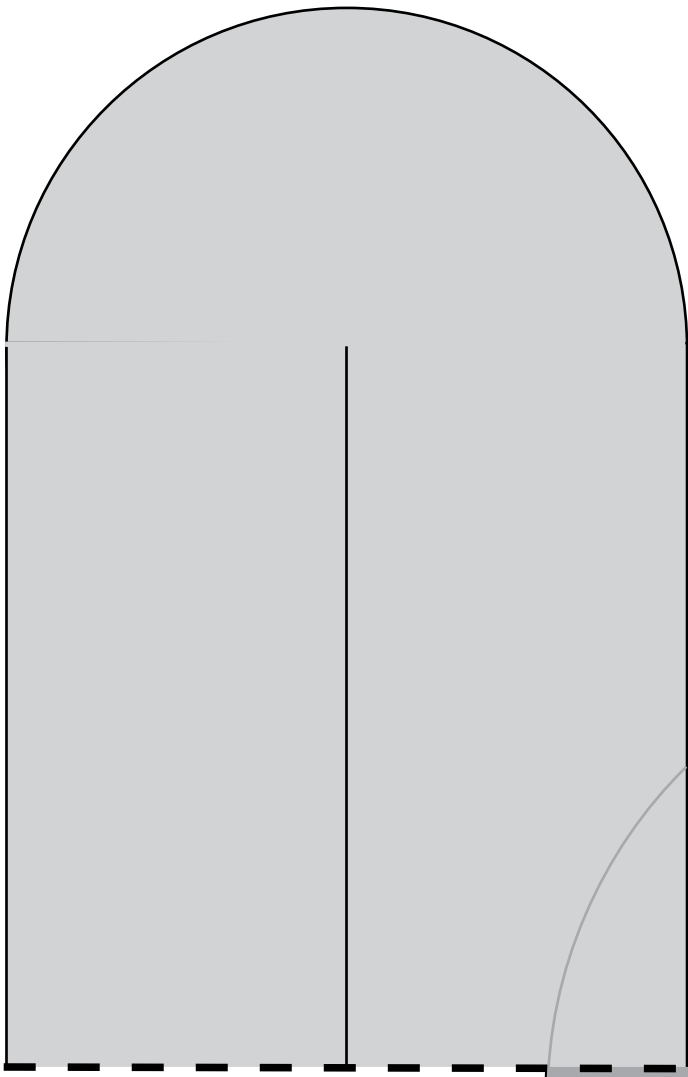


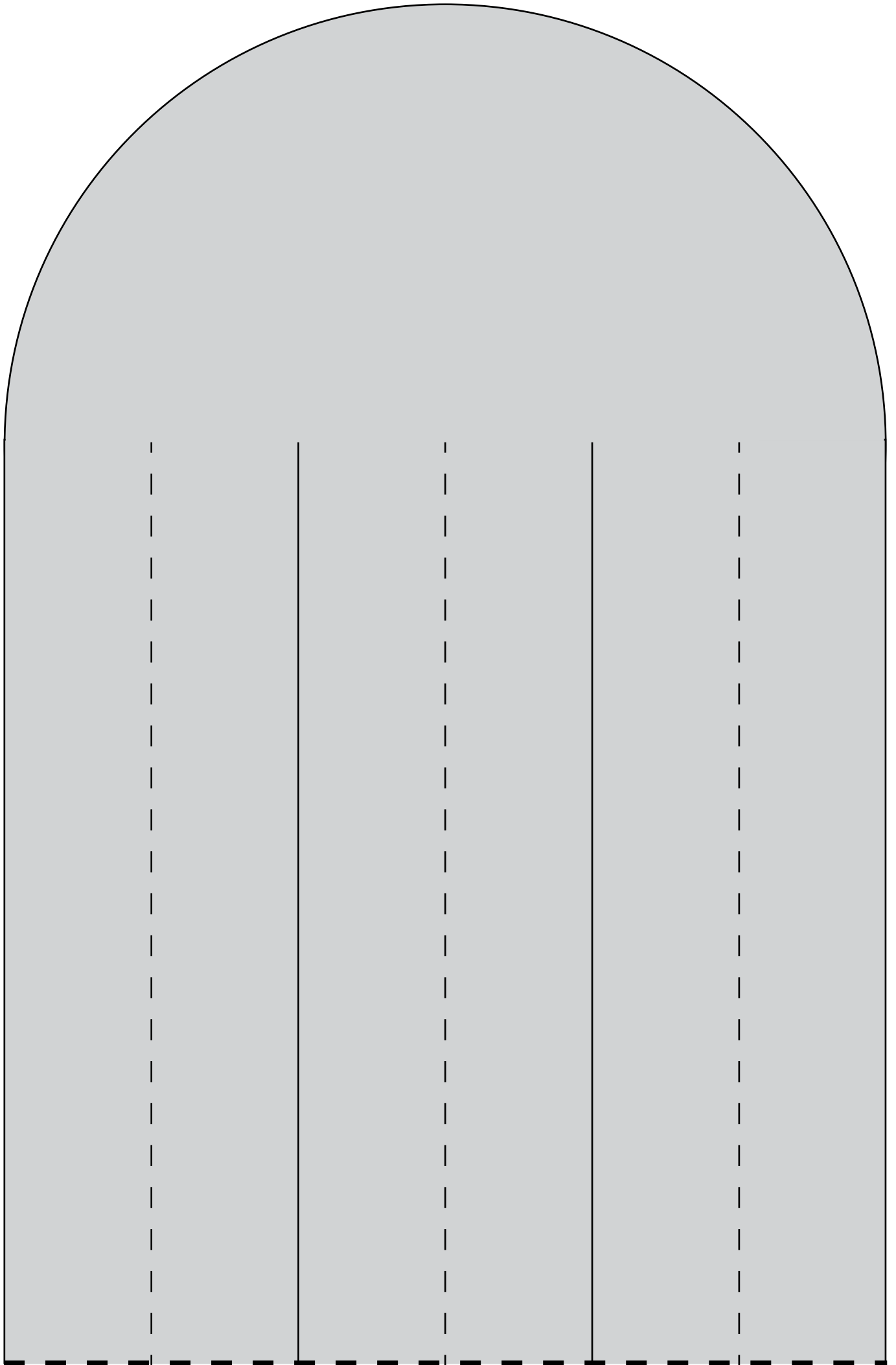
**6.** Cut a piece of ribbon (e.g. grosgrain ribbon). Attach firmly to the inside of the heart with tape or a glue gun.

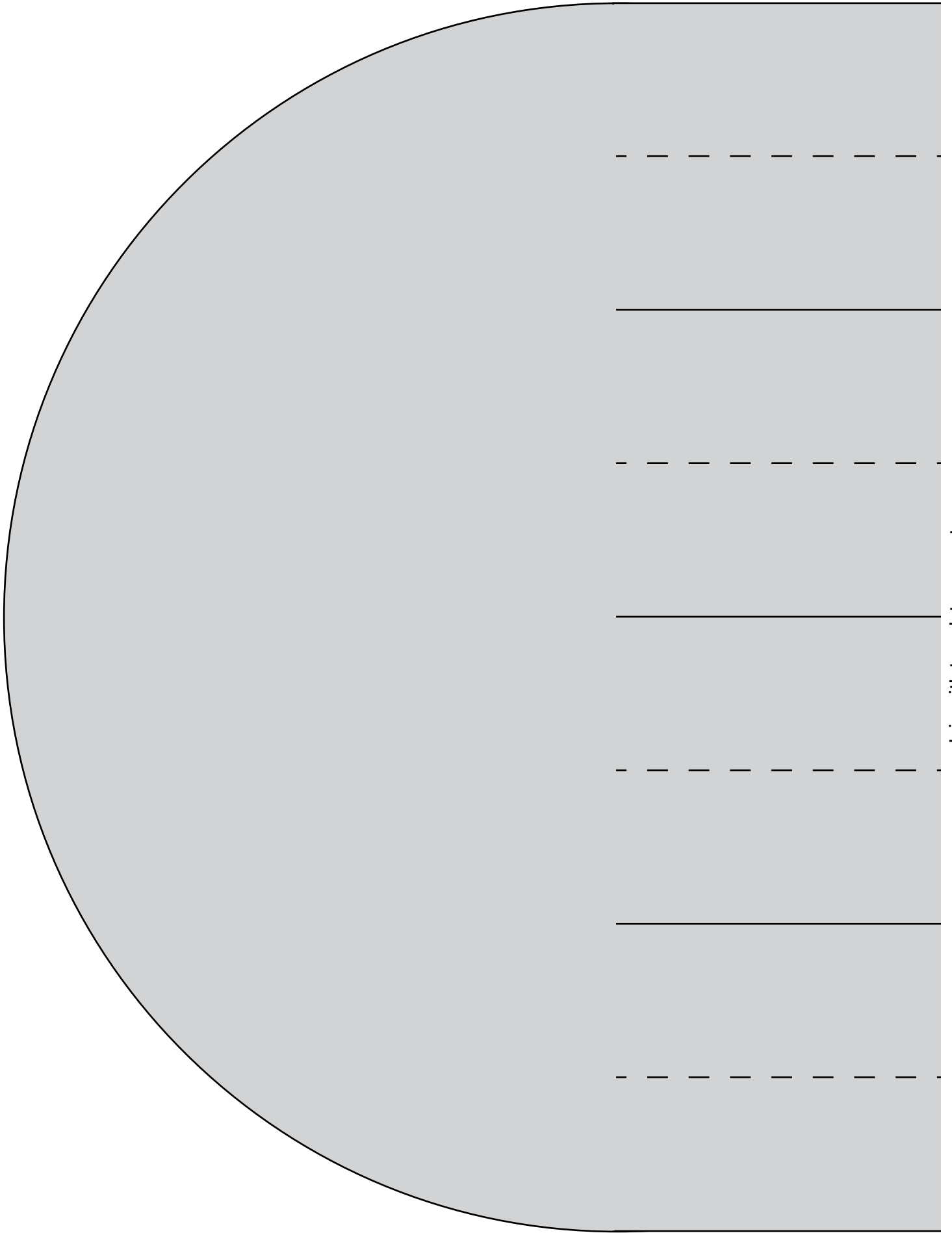
