

SMALL CHICKENS

**MATERIALS**

- Fabric remnants
- Beads for eyes
- Felt
- Fibre filling
- Plastic granulate

CUT

- 1 piece of fabric for the body measuring 7.5 cm x 15 cm
- 1 piece of fabric for the beak and 1 piece for the comb in orange felt

STITCH

1. Place comb and beak approx. 1 cm from one corner, fold fabric in half and stitch together with 0.5 seam. See fig. 1.
2. Fold body into a pyramid shape and stitch base together, stitch seam to fit across centre, leaving one 3 cm gap open for turning through. See fig. 2.
3. Turn right side out, stuff fibre filling in chicken, stuff a little plastic granulate in the 2 bottom corners, stitch hole closed with small invisible stitches.
4. Stitch beads on for eyes.

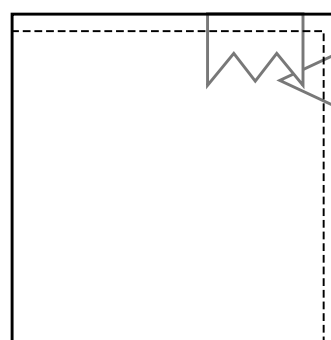
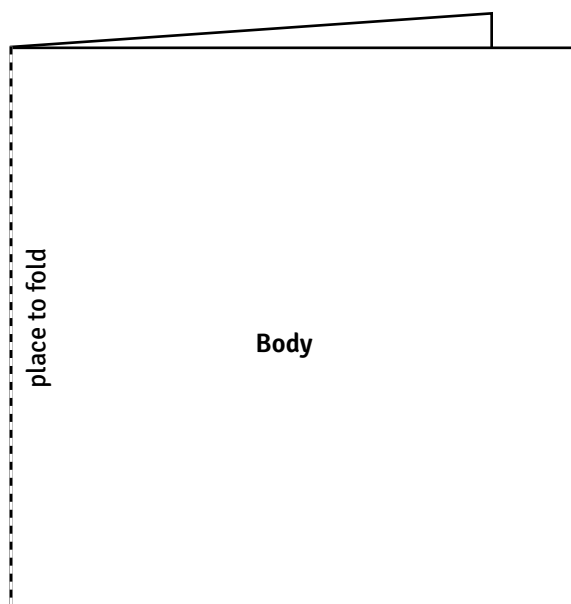
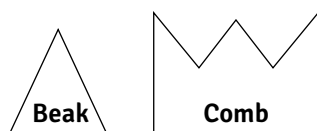

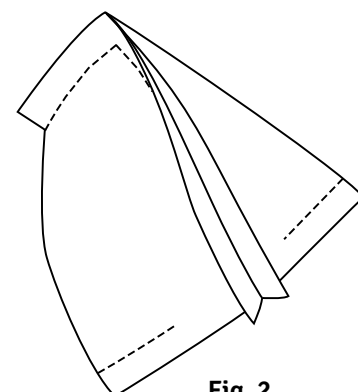
