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ABBREVIATIONS:

The sweater is worked top to down. First the rib, then short rows to shape the neck and then raglan inc on the yoke, front and back together and the sleeves separately.

Cast on 58 [58] 62 [62] sts with 2 strands of yarn in co 1 on double pointed needles UK size 4 [6 mm]. Place a mrk at the beg of the round and work in rib, k1, p1.

Work 7 cm of rib where you work the last round with the UK size 3 (7 mm) needles. The mrk marks the middle of the back.

Change to colour 2 and st st.

K10 (10) 11 (11), place a mrk, k9 (9) 9 (9), place a mrk, k20 (20) 22 (22), place a mrk, k9 (9) 9 (9), place a mrk, k10 (10) 11 (11). You now have 5 mrks placed between the front/back and the sleeves and one on the middle of the back.

NOW WORK SHORT ROWS TO SHAPE THE NECK:

Round 1: K9 [9] 10 [10], inc, k2, inc, k7, inc, k2, inc, k2, turn **Round 2:** Slip 1 st, p34 [34] 36 [36], inc, p2, inc, p7, inc, p2, inc, p2, turn **Round 3:** Slip 1 st, k35 [35] 37 [37], inc, k2, inc, k9, inc, k2, inc, k5, turn **Round 4:** Slip 1 st, p41 [41] 43 [43], inc, p2, inc, p9, inc, p2, inc, p5, turn **Round 5:** Slip 1 st, k42 [42] 44 [44], inc, k2, inc, k11, inc, k2, inc, k8, turn **Round 6:** Slip 1 st, p48 [48] 50 [50], inc, p2, inc, p11, inc, p2, inc, p8, turn

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Round 7: Slip 1 st, k37 (mid back). You now have 26 sts for the front and back and 15 sts for the sleeves.

SIZES M, L, XL:

Round 7: Slip 1 st, k(49) 51 (51), inc, k2, inc, k13, inc, k2, inc, k11, turn **Round 8:** Slip 1 st, p(55) 57 (57), inc, p2, inc, p13, inc, p2, inc, p11, turn

Round 9: Slip 1 st, k[43] 45 [45] (mid back). You now have [28] 30 [30] sts for the front and back and [17] 17 [17] sts for the sleeves.

ALL SIZÉS:

Remove the mrk in the middle of the back and k to the mrk between the right sleeve and the back so that the round now starts here, this way the co changes will be as invisible as possible. When you have enough sts change to a larger circular needle.

MEASUREMENTS

Width ½ in cm: 47 (51) 55 (61) Length in cm: 60 (62) 64 (66)

YARN

Fluffy Fraya 60% Kid Mohair + 40% Acrylic 50 g = 150 m

YARDAGE

Col. 1: 200 (200) 200 (250) g Col. 2: 50 (50) 100 (100) g Col. 3: 100 (150) 150 (200) g Col. 4: 100 (150) 150 (200) g Col. 5: 100 (150) 150 (200) g

GAUGE

In st st on UK size 3 (7 mm) needles with 2 strands of yarn: 11 sts x 19 rounds = 10 cm x 10 cm

SUGGESTED NEEDLE SIZE

UK size 4 and 3 (6 and 7 mm) circular needles 60/80 cm and doublepointed needles

Please note: The needle sizes given above are only suggestions. The size of the needles you need depends on your personal gauge. If you knit firmly you might need a large needle size, if you knit loosely you might need a smaller needle size.

NOTIONS

markers and stitch holders

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Co changes are done with 20 rounds per co. When 20 rounds of co 2 has been worked change to co 3, then 20 rounds of co 4 and 20 rounds of co 5. On both front and back finish with co 1. Work in the round and work raglan inc on this and every 3rd round a total of 7 [6] 6 [6] times. A total of 40 [40] 42 [42] sts for the front and back and 29 [29] 29 [29] sts for the sleeves. Work in the round and work raglan inc on every following 2nd round a total of 6 [7] 8 [9] times until you have 52 [54] 58 [60] sts for the front and back and 41 [43] 45 [47] sts for the sleeves.

M, L & XL:

Cont in the round and work raglan inc on every following 2nd round just on the front and back a total of [1] 1 [3] times until you have [56] 60 [66] sts for the front and back

ALL SIZES:

When you have 52 [56] 60 [66] sts on the front and back and 41 [43] 45 [47] sts on the sleeves divide the work so that the front and back are finished together and the sleeves are finished separately.

BODY:

Cast on 4 sts and place a mrk in the middle of the new sts, place the sts of the right sleeve on a st holder/string, k the 52 [56] 60 [66] sts of the front, cast on 4 sts and place a mrk in the middle of the new sts, place the sts of the left sleeve on a st holder/string, k the sts of the back. The front and back now have a total of 56 [62] 64 [70] sts each. When you next knit in co 1 work 14 [16] 18 [20] rounds and then change to UK size 4 [6 mm] needles. Work 5 cm of rib, k1, p1. Then cast off all sts in rib.

SLEEVES:

Place the sts of the sleeve on the UK size 3 (7 mm) double pointed needles and cast on 4 sts with a mrk in the middle of the new sts (i.e. under the sleeve), 45 (47) 49 (51) sts in total. Cont in st st with co changes every 20 rounds. When starting co 1 work 26 rounds and then dec for the rib as follows:

KO [2] 1 [0], *k1, k2tog*, rep from * to * the entire round, you now have 30 [32] 33 [34] sts left. Change to the UK size 4 [6 mm] double pointed needles and work 5 cm of rib, k1, p1 and cast off all sts in rib.

Knit the other sleeve in the same way.

FINISHING:

Block lightly and weave in all ends. Fold the rib of the neck double on the WS and seam it on in the same co yarn
