## Note: All yo's are k on the next round.

The sweater is worked top down and in 2 strands of yarn.

## NECK OPENING AND YOKE:

Cast on 84 [84] 92 [92] sts with 2 strands of Fluffy Fraya on the size 6 [5 mm], 60 cm circular needles.
Work 6 rounds of rib, k1, p1, the round now starts between the left sleeve and the back:
On the first round place the mrks for the back, front and sleeves as follows:
Place a mrk at the beg of the round, work 37 [37] 41 [41] sts of rib *k1, p1*, place a mrk, k5, place a mrk, work 37 [37] 41 [41] sts of rib, *k1, p1*, place a mrk, k5.

## RIB PATT IN THE NECK OPENING:

Round 1: K1 [1] 3 [3], *yo, k2togtbl, 6 sts of rib, p1, k2tog, yo, k1* rep from * to * 2 more times, k0 [0] 2 [2], mrk, k1, inc, k3, inc, k1, mrk, k1 [1] 3 [3], *yo, k2togtbl, 6 sts of rib, p1, k2tog, yo, k1*, rep from * to * 2 more times, k0 [0] 2 [2], mrk, k1, inc, k3, inc, k1, mrk.
Round 2: Work in patt [ $k$ the k's and $p$ the $p$ 's], $k$ all yo's.
Round 3: K2 [2] 4 [4], *yo, k2togtbl, 4 sts of rib, k1, k2tog, yo, k3* rep from * to * 1 more time, yo, k2togtbl, 4 sts of rib, k1, k2tog, yo, k2 [2] 4 [4], mrk, k1, inc, k5, inc, mrk, k2 [2] 4 [4], *yo, k2togtbl, 4 sts of rib, k1, k2tog, yo, k3*, rep from * to * one more time, yo, k2togtbl, 4 sts of rib, k1, k2tog, yo, k2 [2] 4 [4], mrk, k1, inc, k5, 1 inc, k1, mrk.
Round 4: *Work in patt for the next 37 [37] 41 [41] sts, mrk, k1, inc, k7, inc, k1, mrk, work in patt the next 37 [37] 41 [41] sts mrk, k1, inc, k7, inc, k1, mrk.
Round 5: K3 [3] 5 [5], *yo, k2togtbl, 2 sts of rib, p1, k2tog, yo, k5* rep from * to * 1 more time, yo, k2togtbl, 2 sts of rib, p1, k2tog, yo, k3 [3] 5 [5], mrk, k1, inc, k9, inc, mrk, k 3 [3] 5 [5], *yo, k2togtbl, 2 sts of rib, p1, k2tog, yo, k5*, rep from * to * one more time, yo, k2togtbl, 2 sts of rib, p1, k2tog, yo, k 3 [3] 5 [5], mrk, k1, inc, k9, 1 inc, k1, mrk.
Round 6: Work in patt for the next 37 [37] 41 [41] sts, mrk, k1, inc, k11, inc, k1, mrk, work in patt the next 37 [37] 41 [41] sts mrk, k1, inc, k11, inc, k1, mrk.
Round 7: *K4 [4] 6 [6] , yo, k2togtbl, k1, k2tog, yo, k3 [3] 1 [1] * rep from * to * 2 more times, k1 [1] 5 [5], mrk, k1, inc, k13, inc, k1, mrk, *4 [4] 6 [6], yo, k2togtbl, k1, k2tog, yo, k3 [3] 1 [1] * rep from * to * 2 more times, k1 [1] 5 [5], mrk, k1, inc, k13, inc, k1, mrk.

## YARN

Fluffy Fraya
60\% Kid Mohair + 40\% Acrylic
$50 \mathrm{~g}=150 \mathrm{~m}$

400 [450] 500 [550]g

## GAUGE

In 2 strands of on size 4 [ 6 mm ] needles: 11,5 sts $\times 18$ rounds
$=10 \mathrm{~cm} \times 10 \mathrm{~cm}$

## SUGGESTED NEEDLE SIZE

Size 6 and 4 [ 5 and 6 mm ] circular needles 80 cm and double poined needles

Please note: The needle sizes given above are only suggestions. The size of the needles you need depends on your personal gauge. If you knit firmly you might need a large needle size, if you knit loosely you might need a smaller needle size.

## NOTIONS

stitch holders, markers

## VARIATION

You can make the sweater without the eyelet patt at the bottom.

Round 8: Work in patt for the next 37 [37] 41 [41] sts, mrk, k1, inc, k15, inc, k1, mrk, work in patt the next 37 [37] 41 [41] sts mrk, k1, inc, k15, inc, k1, mrk.
Round 9: *K5 [5] 7 [7], yo, k3togtbl, yo, k4 [4] 2 [2]* rep from * to * 2 more times, k1 [1] 5 [5], mrk, k1, inc, k17, inc, k1, mrk, *k5 [5] 7 [7], yo, k3togtbl, yo, k4 [4] 2 [2]* rep from * to * 2 more times, k1 [1] 5 [5] , mrk, k1, inc, k17, inc, k1, mrk.
Round 10: Work in patt for the next 37 [37] 41 [41] sts, mrk, k1, inc, k19, inc, k1, mrk, work in patt the next 37 [37] 41 [41] sts mrk, k1, inc, k19, inc, k1, mrk.
You now have 37 [37] 41 [41] sts on the front and back and 23 sts on the sleeve.
Change to the size 4 [ 6 mm ], 80 cm circular needles an work in st st. Cont working inc on the sleeves on every round until you have 33 sts on each sleeve.
Now work inc on both sides of the front and back and the sleeves on every 4th [4th] 3th [3th] round a total of 7 [8] 9 [11] times until you have 47 [49] 51 (55] sts on each sleeve and 51 [53] 59 [63] sts for the front and back.
Now divide the work for body and sleeves.
Place the sts of the sleeves on st holders, cast on 4 sts under each sleeve, place a mrk in the middle of the 4 new sts so you have 55 [57] 63 [67] sts for the front and back.
Work in st st until the work measures 39 [40] $41[42] \mathrm{cm}$ mid back. Now work in eyelet patt on the next 16 rounds as follows:
Round 1: K1 [2] 2 [1], *k2tog, yo, k1, yo, k2togtbl, k1* rep from * to * until $\mathrm{O}[1] 1[0]$ sts before the mrk, kO [1] 1 [0]. Rep on the front.

## Round 2: K.

Round 3: KO [1] 1 [0], k2tog, *yo, k3, yo, k3togtb|* rep from * to * until 5 [6] 6 [5] sts before the mrk, yo, k3, yo, k2togtbl, kO [1] 1 [0]. Rep on the front.

## Round 4: K.

Round 5: K1 [2] 2 [1], *yo, k2togtbl, k1, k2tog, yo, k1* rep from * to * until O [1] 1 [0] sts before the mrk, $\mathrm{KO}[1] 1$ [0]. Rep on the front.
Round 6: K.
Round 7: K2 [3] 3 [3] r, *yo, k3togtbl, yo, k3* rep from * to * until 5 [6] 6 [5] sts before the mrk, yo, k3togtbl, yo, k2 [3] 3 [2]. Rep on the front.

## Round 8: K.

Rep round 1-8 one more time so that you have worked a total of 16 rounds of eyelet patt.
Now work in st st until the work measures 51 [52] 53 [54] cm. Change to the size 6 [ 5 mm ], 60 cm circular needles and work 8 rounds of rib, k1, p1. Cast off all sts loosely.

## SLEEVES:

Place the sts for the sleeve on the size $4[6 \mathrm{~mm}]$ double pointed needles. Pick up 4 sts under the sleeve and place a mrk in the middle - this marker marks the sleeve seam. You now have 51 [53] 55 [59] sts.
Work in st st and dec 1 st on each side of the sleeve every 6th round until 27 [29] 31 [33] sts rem. Cont in st st until the work measures 43 [43] 43 [44] cm from the armhole. Change to size 6 [5 mm ] double pointed needles and work 8 rounds of rib, k1, p1, cast off all sts loosely.

FINISHING:
Weave in ends and block lightly.
