The sweater is worked top down on circular needles.

PATTERN:

Cast on 92 (100) 108 (116) sts with 1 strand of Fine Wool and 1 strand of Fine Mohair on the size 10/9 (3.5 mm) 40 cm circular needles. Place a mrk at the beg of the round (between the left sleeve and the back).

K 1 round.

Work 6 rounds of rib, k1, p1. Change to size 8 (4 mm) 40 cm circular needles.

K 1 round and place mrks as follows: K41 (45) 49 (53) (back), mrk, k5 (right sleeve), marker, k41 (45) 49 (53) (front), mrk, k5 (left sleeve).

Work inc mid front and mid back according to the mid chart and inc for the sleeves:

Round 1: K18 (20) 22 (24), work round 1 of the mid chart, k18 (20) 22 (24), mrk, yo, k until the mrk, yo, mrk, k18 (20) 22 (24), work round 1 of the mid chart, k18 (20) 22 (24), mrk, yo, k until the mrk, yo, mrk. You now have 100 (108) 116 (124) sts.

Round 2: K 1 round. K the yo's through the front loop so that you create an eyelet.

Round 3: K18 (20) 22 (24), work round 3 of the mid chart, k18 (20) 22 (24), mrk, yo, k until the mrk, yo, mrk, k18 (20) 22 (24), work round 3 of the mid chart, k18 (20) 22 (24), mrk, yo, k until the mrk, yo, mrk. You now have 104 (112) 120 (128) sts.

Round 4: K 1 round. K the yo's through the front loop so that you create an eyelet.

Cont in this way with inc for the sleeves and according to the mid chart.

When 20 rounds of the mid chart have been worked rep the chart on the front and back. Change to size 4 mm, 80 cm circular needles when necessary.

Cont with sleeve inc until you have 73 (73) 87 (87) sts on the sleeve, 75 (79) 87 (91) sts on the front and back.

Sizes S (M): The mid chart has now been worked 3 times + 4 rounds.

Sizes L (XL): The mid chart has now been worked a total of 4 times.

Now divide the sts for body and sleeves.

Let the 2 outermost sts on each side of the sleeve be part of the body as follows: K2, place 69 [69] 83 [83] sts from the sleeve on a st holder, cast on 5 [7] 9 [11] sts. K the last 2 sts on the sleeve, work 75 [79] 87 [91] sts of the front, k the first 2 sts of the sleeve, place 69 [69] 83 [83] sts from the sleeve on a st holder, cast on 5 [7] 9 [11] sts, work the 75 [79] 87 [91] sts of the back. K2 [5] 6 [8] in the middle of the sleeve. Place a marker.

MEASUREMENTS

¹⁄₂ width i cm: 42 (45) 50 (53) Length i cm: 57 (58) 59 (60)

YARN

Mindful Fraya 100% Wool 50 g = 350 m

Friendly Fraya 70% Super Kid Mohair + 30% Silk 25 g = 210 m

YARDAGE

Mindful: 200 (200) 200 (250) g Friendly: 175 (175) 175 (225) g

If you want to knit the edges in another colour, you will need 1 ball of Mindful and 1 ball of Friendly

GAUGE

On size 4 mm needles with 1 strand of Mindful and 1 strand of Fine: 20 sts x 30 rounds = 10 cm x 10 cm

SUGGESTED NEEDLE SIZE

ize 10/9 and 8 (3½ and 4 mm) circular needles, 40 and 80 cm, Size 10/9 and 8 (3½ and 4 mm) double pointed needles

Please note: The needle sizes given above are only suggestions. The size of the needles you need depends on your personal gauge. If you knit firmly you might need a large needle size, if you knit loosely you might need a smaller needle size.

NOTIONS

stitch holders, markers

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FRONT AND BACK:

Cont in st st and mid chart until the chart has been worked a total of 5 times. Now cont in st st until the work measures 55 (56) 57 (58) cm mid back. Change to the size 10/9 (3.5 mm) 80 cm circular needles and work 5 rounds of rib, k1, p1. Cast off all sts loosely in rib.

SLEEVES:

Place the 69 [69] 83 [83] sts of the sleeve on the size 8 [4 mm] 40 cm circular needles. Pick up 5 [7] 9 [11] sts under the sleeve and k the 69 [69] 83 [83] sts on the sleeve. You now have 74 [76] 92 [94] sts. Place a mrk in the middle of the new sts under the sleeve. Work in st st while at the same time dec 1 st on each side of the mrk on every 8th [8th] 5th [5th] round. Continue working the dec until you have 42 [44] 44 [46] sts left and work in st st until the work measures 46 cm from the armhole. Change to size 10/9 [3.5 mm] double pointed needles and work 5 rounds of rib, k1, p1. Cast off all sts loosely. Work the other sleeve in the same way.

FINISHING:

Weave in all ends and block lightly.
