ABBREVIATIONS:

PATT:

Divisible by 4 sts Row 1-6: Work in st st starting with a k row [the first row is the RS]. Row 7: K1, *yo, p2tog*, rep from * to * until the last st, k1. Row 8: P. Row 9: K. Row 10: P. Row 11: K2, *yo, p2tog*, rep from * to * until the last st. Row 12: P. Row 13: K. Row 14: P Row 15-22: Rep row 7-14 one more time. Row 23: K. Row 24: P. Row 25: K1, *yo twice, k1*, rep from * to *until the last st, k1. Row 26: *Slip 1 st and let the two yo's fall so that you now have a long st, rep 3 more times so that you have 4 long sts on the right needle, place the 4 long sts back on the left needle, p1, k1, p1 through all the 4 long sts, let the long sts slide off the left st*, rep from * to *. Row 1-26 creates the patt. FRONT: On the UK size 10-9 (31/2 mm) needles cast on 92 (100) 108 (116) 124 sts. Row 1-7: *K1, p1*. Change to UK size 8 (4 mm) needles. Work in eyelet patt as described above row 1-26. Now rep row 1-26 of the eyelet patt 2 more times, i.e. 2 rep. Next: Rep row 1-12. Cont the patt rep and inc 1 st on each side on every second row the next 8 rows, a total of 100 [108] 116 [124] 132 sts.

Next: Cont patt rep from row 21-26 as normal.

Work the patt rep one more time.

Next: K. Next: P.

Sizes M and L: Work row 3-12 of the patt rep and cont the rep at the neck. Size XL: Work row 3-22 of the patt rep and cont the rep at the neck. **SIZES** XS (S) M (L) XL

YARN

Colourful Fraya 100% Cotton 50 g = 170 m

YARDAGE 250 (250) 300 (350) 400 g

GAUGE

20 sts and 32 rows to 10 x 10 cm in st st on UK size 8 (4 mm) needles

SUGGESTED NEEDLE SIZE

UK size 10-9 and 8 (3½ mm and 4 mm) needles,

Please note: The needle sizes given above are only suggestions. The size of the needles you need depends on your personal gauge. If you knit firmly you might need a large needle size, if you knit loosely you might need a smaller needle size.

Copyright © 2021 FRAYAYARN.COM Neck opening all sizes: Next: 37 [41] 45 [49] 53 sts of patt, k2tog, k22, k2togtbl, 37 [41] 45 [49] 53 sts of patt. Next: 36 [40] 44 [48] 52 sts of patt, p2tog, p1, turn the work so that you finish each side separately (place the rem sts on a st holder). Next: Cont in patt and dec 1 st at the neck opening on every row until 22 [26] 30 [34] 38 sts rem. Sizes XS-S: Work in st st from here. Cont dec 1 st at the neck on every second row until 18 [22] 26 [30] 34 sts rem. Cast off all shoulder sts. Place the middle 20 sts on a st holder and start on the WS at the neck opening. Dec 1 st at the neck opening and cont to p. Cont in patt and dec 1 st on every row until 22 [26] 30 [34] 38 sts rem. BACK: Knit as the front until the neck opening. Cont in patt until row 22 of patt. Neck opening: Next row: K19 [23] 27 [31] 35, k2toq, k58, k2toqtbl, k19 [23] 27 [31] 35. Next row: P21 [25] 29 [33] 37, turn the work so that you finish each side separately.

Next: Dec 1 st at the neck and k the rest of the row.

Next: P.

Rep the last 2 rows until 18 (22) 26 (30) 34 sts rem. Cast off loosely for shoulder. Place the middle 56 sts on a st holder and work the other side in the same way. Block lightly and sew the left shoulder seam.

NECK RIB:

Start at the right shoulder seam and pick up sts along the neck opening with UK size 10-9 ($3\frac{1}{2}$ mm) needles until you have a total of approx. 136 sts. Now work 7 rows of rib, k1, p1 and cast off on the 8th row.

Sleeve edge on both sleeves:

Pick up approx. 74 (74) 84 (84) 94 sts along the sleeve edge with the UK size 10-9 (3½ mm) needles. Now work 7 rows of rib, k1, p1 and cast off on the 8th row.

FINISHING:

Seam the right shoulder seam, sew the side seam with small invisible sts and weave in all ends. Rinse in tepid water, let dry and carefully pull into shape.
