▼ THE LOVELIES KNITTED SLIPOVER FOR COOLER DAYS! ONCE THE SLIPOVER HAS BEEN KNITTED AN PRETTY I-CORD EDGES ALONG ARE WORKED ALONG THE NECK EDGE, ARMHOLES AND HEM FOR A GORGEOUS FINISH TO THE DESIGN. THIS IS JUST THE THING FOR INTERMEDIATE KNITTERS - HAVE FUN!

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ABBREVIATIONS:

st(s) = stitch(es) WS = wrong side

k = knit **tbl** = through the back loop(s)

p = purl **tog** = together

RS = right side

PATTERN

Cast on 100 (108) 116 (124) sts on a UK size 0 (8 mm) needle with one strand of each yarn held together. Join in the round and place a marker for the beginning of the round. Work 10 rounds in stockinette stitch, then begin working the lace pattern according to the chart.

Continue in pattern until the work measures 31 [32] 33 [34] cm. End on a odd numbered row of the chart.

Place a marker after 50 [54] 58 [62] sts on the next round.

Now divide the work into front and back at the markers and finish each section separately.

FRONT

Work back and forth in pattern across the first 50 [54] 58 [62] sts, while at the same time binding off sts for the armholes at the beginning of every row. Bind off 2 [2] 3 [3] sts at the beginning of the first 2 rows, then bind off 2 [2] 2 [2] at the beginning of the next 2 rows, then bind off 2 [3] 3 [4] sts at the beginning of the next 2 rows. There are now 38 [40] 42 [44] sts left on the needle. Work straight in pattern until the armholes measure 14 [15] 16 [17] cm. End the last pattern repeat a couple of cm before the sloping shoulder bind-off is worked. work last part of the front in stockinette stitch.

Now bind off sts for the neck edge and finish each shoulder of the front separately.

Next row (RS): Work 15 [16] 17 [17] sts, place the next 8 [8] 8 [10] sts on a stitch holder, turn and bind off 1 [1] 1 [1] stitch at the neck edge. Work back and forth, while binding off 1 stitch at the neck edge at the beginning of every other round 2 more times. There are now 12 [13] 14 [14] sts left on the shoulder. Work straight until the armhole measures 21,5 [23,5] 25,5 [26,5] cm. Now work the sloping shoulder bind off.

Next row [RS]: Bind off 6 [7] 7 [7] sts, work to end of row.

Next row [WS]: Work to end of row.

Bind off the remaining 6 (6) 7 (7) sts.

Finish the other front shoulder in the same way, only mirror reversed.

BACK

Work back and forth in pattern across the remaining 50 (54) 58 (62) sts for the back, while at the same time binding off sts for the armholes at the beginning of every row. Bind off 2 (2) 3 (3) sts at the beginning of the first 2 rows, then bind off 2 (2) 2 (2) at the beginning of the next 2 rows, then bind off 2 (3) 3 (4) sts at the beginning of the next 2 rows. There are now 38 (40) 42 (44) sts left on the needle.

Work straight in pattern until the armholes measure 21,5 (23,5) 25,5 (26,5) cm.

Now bind off for the neck edge, while at the same time working the sloping shoulder bind-off as follows:

Next row (RS): Bind off 6 (7) 7 (7) sts at the armhole edge, work 8 (8) 9 (9) sts, turn.

Next row (WS): Bind off 1 (1) 1 (1) stitch at the neck edge, work to end of row.

Bind off the remaining 7 [7] 8 [8] sts.

Finish the second shoulder the same way as the first, only mirror reversed.

MEASUREMENTS

Length approx. 55 (57) 60 (62) cm

Half chest circumference approx. 48 [52] 55 [59] cm

YARN

Comfy Fraya

50% Wool+40% Acrylic+10% Alpaca 50 g = 80 m

Friendly Fraya

70% Super Kid Mohair+30% Silk 25 q = 210 m

YARDAGE

Comfy Fraya

250 (300) 300 (350) g

Friendly Fraya

50 (50) 50 (75) g

GAUGE

In stockinette stitch with 1 strand of Comfy and 1 strand of Friendly held together on a UK size 2 [7 mm] needle:

 $10^{1/2}$ sts x 17 rows = 10 cm x 10 cm

SUGGESTED NEEDLE SIZE

UK size 2 (7 mm) circular needle, 80 cm

UK size 0 (8 mm) circular needle, 80 cm

Please note: The needle sizes given above are only suggestions. The size of the needles you need depends on your personal gauge. If you knit firmly you might need a large needle size, if you knit loosely you might need a smaller needle size.

NOTIONS

Stitch markers, stitch holders

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FINISHING

Sew the shoulder seams from the RS. Weave in all ends.


Work an i-cord edge around the neck edge, armhole edges and hem as follows:

Pick up and knit sts with a US size 2 (7 mm) needle along the neck edge and knit across the sts on the stitch holders front and back. Cast on 3 new sts using the knitted cast-on technique. *K2, k2tog, slip the 3 sts back on the left needle*, repeat from * to * until all the sts on the needle have been worked. Bind off the last 3 sts.

Work the armhole edges and the hem in the same way.
