

#SNOWPATROLHATANDSCARF

snow patrol hat and scarf

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ABBREVIATIONS:

st(s) = stitch(es)
k = knit
p = purl
tog = together
beg = beginning

rep = repeat
dec = decrease(s)
inc = increases(s)
cont = continue
mrk = marker

SCARF:

Cast on 82 sts on the size 6 [5 mm] needles.

Row 1, 3, 5 and 7: K2, *p2, k2*, rep from * to * the entire row.

Row 2, 4 and 6: P2, *k2, p2*, rep from * to * the entire row.

Row 8: P2, *place the next 4 sts on a cable needle behind the work, k2, p the 2 sts furthest to the back, k the last 2 sts on the cable needle, p2*, rep from * to * the entire row.

Row 9, 11, 13 and 15: K2, *p2, k2*, rep from * to * the entire row.

Row 10, 12 and 14: P2, *k2, p2*, rep from * to * the entire row.

Row 16: P2, k2, *p2, place the next 4 sts on the cable needle in front of the work, k2, p the 2 sts furthest back, k the last 2 sts on the cable needle*, rep from * to * until the last 6 sts, end with p2, k2, p2.

Rep row 1-16 until the work measures 155 cm. End with 6 rows of rib and cast off all sts.

HAT:

Cast on 112 sts on the size 6 [5 mm], 40 cm circular needles. Place a mrk at the beg of the round.

Round 1-7: *K2, p2*, rep from * to * the entire round.

Round 8: *Place the next 4 sts on a cable needle behind the work, k2, p the 2 sts furthest to the back, k the last 2 sts on the cable needle, p2*, rep from * to * the entire round.

Round 9-15: *K2, p2*, rep from * to * the entire round.

Round 16: K2, p2* place the next 4 sts on a cable needle in front of the work, k2, p the 2 sts furthest to the back, k the last 2 sts on the cable needle, p2*, rep from * to * until the last 4 sts before the mrk, make the last cable by taking off the mrk and rep * to * one more time. Place the mrk. Work 1 round and place the mrk back where it was. i.e. 4 sts before its present place.

Rep round 1-16 one more time.

DEC:

Round 1-7: *K2, p2*, rep from * to * the entire round.

Round 8: *Place the next 4 sts on a cable needle behind the work, k2, p the 2 sts furthest to the back, k the last 2 sts on the cable needle, p2*, rep from * to * the entire round.

Round 9-11: *K2, p2*, rep from * to * the entire round.

Round 12: *K2, p2tog*, rep from * to * the entire round.

Round 13-15: *K2, p1*, rep from * to * the entire round.

SIZES

One size

YARN

Warm Hearted Fraya
 100% Organic Wool
 50 g = 100 m

YARDAGE

Scarf: 400 g
 Hat: 100 g

GAUGE

In st st on size 5 mm needles: 17 sts
 x 22 rounds = 10 cm x 10 cm

SUGGESTED NEEDLE SIZE

Scarf: UK size 6 [5 mm] needles,
 cable needle
 Hat: Uk size 6 [5 mm] 40 cm circular
 needle and doublepointed needles,
 cable needle

Please note: The needle sizes given above are only suggestions. The size of the needles you need depends on your personal gauge. If you knit firmly you might need a large needle size, if you knit loosely you might need a smaller needle size.

NOTIONS

a fur pompom [optional]

Round 16: P2, k1, *place the next 3 sts on a cable needle in front of the work, k2, p the st furthest to the back, k the last 2 sts on the cable needle, p1* rep from * to * until 3 sts before the mrk, make the last cable by taking off the mrk and rep * to * one more time. Place the mrk. Work 1 round and place the mrk back where it was. i.e. 3 sts before its present place.

Round 17-19: *K2, p1*, rep from * to * the entire round.

Round 20: *K2tog, p1* rep from * to * the entire round = 56 sts.

Round 21: *K3tog, p1* rep from * to * the entire round = 26 sts.

Change to the double pointed needles if your sts can not reach around the circular needle.

Pull the yarn through all sts. Weave in all ends and sew on a fur pompom on the top [optional].
