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ABBREVIATIONS:

st(s) = stitch(es)
k = knit
p = purl
tbl = through the back loop
tog = together
RS = right side
WS = wrong side
beg = beginning

rep = repeat
yo = yarn over
patt = pattern
st st = stocking st
dec = decrease[s]
inc = increase[s]
cont = continue
mrk = marker

The mittens are worked double. First you knit the outer mitten and then the inner mitten

OUTER MITTEN:**Cuff:**

Cast on 44 [48] 52 sts on size 10/9 [3 mm] double pointed needles, k 36 [38] 40 rounds even.

Inc for the thumb:

K14 [15] 16, pick up the thread between the two sts and k it tbl, k6 [18] 20, pick up the thread between the two sts and k it tbl, k14 [15] 16.

K 1 round without inc.

K15 [16] 17, pick up the thread between the two sts and k it tbl, k6 [18] 20, pick up the thread between the two sts and k it tbl, k15 [16] 17.

K 1 round without inc.

K16 [17] 18, pick up the thread between the two sts and k it tbl, k6 [18] 20, pick up the thread between the two sts and k it tbl, k16 [17] 18.

Cont in this way with inc until you have worked a total of 9 [10] 11 inc.

K another 2 rounds without inc.

K22 [24] 26, place 18 [20] 22 sts on a string, k22 [24] 26.

Top:

Work even across the 44 [48] 52 sts. Work 12 rounds, now work dec on both sides, k2tog, k20 [22] 24, k2tog, k20 [22] 24.

Work 11 rounds without dec.

Now work dec on both sides, k2tog, k19 [21] 23, k2tog, k9 [21] 23.

You now have 40 [44] 48 sts on the round.

Work 11 [13] 17 rounds without dec.

Dec as follows:

k2tog, k2 repeat from * to * the entire round, you now have 30 [33] 36 sts on the round.

Work 1 round without dec.

k2tog, k1 repeat from * to * the entire round, you now have 20 [22] 24 sts on the round

Work 2 rounds without dec.

k2tog the entire round, cut the yarn and pull it through the rem sts, weave in the end well.

SIZES

S [M] L

YARN

Mindful Fraya

100 % Wool

50 g = 350 m

YARDAGE

Colour 1 50 g

Colour 2 50 g

GAUGE

24 sts x 32 rounds = 10 cm x 10 cm

SUGGESTED NEEDLE SIZE

UK size 10/9 [3½ mm] double

pointed needles

Please note: The needle sizes given above are only suggestions. The size of the needles you need depends on your personal gauge. If you knit firmly you might need a large needle size, if you knit loosely you might need a smaller needle size.

Thumb:

Place the sts from the string on 3 needles and pick up 2 sts in the transition to the mitten.
K 20 [22] 24 rounds, now dec as follows: *k2tog* rep from * to * the entire round, cut the yarn and pull it through the rem sts, weave in the end well.

INNER MITTEN:

Pick up 44 [48] 52 sts in the cast on edge of the outer mitten and knit the inner mitten in the same way as the outer mitten but instead work 48 [52] 56 rounds for the cuff
Make sure to weave in the ends as you go.
When the inner mitten is complete turn the mitten so that it is double.

Knit another mitten in the same way.
