#### FRAYA 3016

#GROUNDEDSOCKS

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#### **ABBREVIATIONS:**

st(s) = stitch(es)
k = knit

**p** = purl

**tbl** = through the back loop

tog = together
RS = right side
WS = wrong side
beg = beginning
rep = repeat
rem = remain[ing]
st st = stocking st

dec = decrease(s)
cont = continue

Cast on 40 (44) 48 (52) 56 (60) 60 (64) sts loosely. Divide on 4 double pointed needles with 10 (11) 12 (13) 14 (15) 15 (16) sts on each needle. Work in rib (1st st on the 1st row = mid back) k1, \*p2, k2\*. Rep from \* to \* and end with p2, k1. Work even (i.e. in rib) for 12 (13) 14 (15) 16 (17) 19 (20) cm.

**HEAL:** Place the sts of needle 1 and 4 on one needle.

Work 4 (4) 4,5 (5) 5,5 (6) 7 (7,5)cm st st back and forth across the 20 (22) 24 (26) 28 (30) 30 (32)sts, end with a p row.

K until 9 (10) 11 (12) 13 (14) 14 (15) sts rem on the needle, k2togtbl, k1, turn, slip 1 st, p until 9 (10) 11 (12) 13 (14) 14 (15) sts rem on the needle, p2tog, p1, turn, slip 1 st, k until 7 (8) 9 (10) 11 (12) 12 (13) sts rem, [=1] st before the previous turn, k2togtbl, k1. Turn and cont in this way until there are 12 (12) 14 (14) 16 (16) 16 (18) sts on the needle. P 1 row.

Knit up sts for the gusset as follows: 12 (12) 13 (15) 17 (19) 21 (23) sts along the one side of the heel, work the sts of the 2nd and 3rd needles, then knit up 12 (12) 13 (15) 17 (19) 21 (23) sts along the other side of the heel. Divide the sts on 4 needles (from mid back) as follows: Needle 1: 18 (18) 20 (22) 25 (27) 29 (32) sts. Needle 2: 10 (11) 12 (13) 14 (15) 15 (16) sts. Needle 3: 10 (11) 12 (13) 14 (15) 15 (16) sts. Needle 4: 18 (18) 20 (22) 25 (27) 29 (32) sts.

**GUSSET:** Now continue in the round working in st st under the foot and rib over the foot.

Needle 1: K until 2 sts rem, k2tog.

Needle 2 and 3: Rib.

Needle 4: K2toqtbl, k the rest of the sts on the needle.

Cont working these dec on every round until 10 [11] 12 [13] 14 [15] 15 [16] sts rem on all needles. Cont until the foot measures 7 [9] 10,5 [12] 13,5 [15] 18 [20] cm after the heel (where you knit up the sts for the gusset). End in the middle of the under foot.

TOE: Cont in st st.

### Toe sizes. 22 - 29:

K until 3 sts rem on the needle, k2tog, k1, next needle: k1, k2togtbl, k the rest of the needle, next needle: K until 3 sts rem on the needle, k2tog, k1, next needle: k1, k2togtbl, k the rest of the needle. Rep these dec on every second round until 6 sts rem on each needle, now work the dec on every round until 3 sts rem on each needle.

Sew tog the toe with Kitchener sts or turn the sock WS out. K2tog, 1 st from each side of the toe, while at the same time casting off the sts.

Knit another sock in the same way.

#### Toe sizes. 31 - 44:

Now work dec for the toe as follows:

K until 3 sts rem on the needle, k2tog, k1, next needle: k1, k2togtbl, k the rest of the needle, next needle: K until 3 sts rem on the needle, k2tog, k1, next needle: k1, k2togtbl, k the rest of the needle. Rep these dec on every second round until 8 sts rem on each needle, now work the dec on every row until 4 sts rem on each needle.

Sew tog the toe with Kitchener sts or turn the sock WS out. K2tog,  $\bf 1$  st from each side of the toe, while at the same time casting off the sts.

Knit another sock in the same way.

Weave in the ends.

#### SIZES

22/23 (25/26) 28/29 (31/32) 34/35 (37/38) 40/41 (43/44)

#### YARN

Reliable Fraya
70% Wool + 30% Polyamide
50 g = 150 m
or
Steady Fraya
70% Wool + 30% Polyamide
50 g = 150 m

#### YARDAGE

50 g (50 g) 50 g (100 g) 100 g (100 g) 100 g (100 g)

#### **GAUGE**

In st st on size 12-10 [3 mm] needles: 30 sts x 40 rows = 10 cm x 10 cm

#### SUGGESTED NEEDLE SIZE

UK Size 12-10 (3 mm) double pointed needles

Please note: The needle sizes given above are only suggestions. The size of the needles you need depends on your personal gauge. If you knit firmly you might need a large needle size, if you knit loosely you might need a smaller needle size.
