

# misty cowl and hat

## **ABBREVIATIONS:**

st[s] = stitch(es) inc = increase(s) = knit dec = decrease(s) = continue = purl cont = pattern = repeat patt rep = stocking stitch st st = remain rem **k2tog** = knit 2 sts together RS = right side p2tog = purl 2 sts together ws = wrong side = through the back loop

#### PATT FOR MODEL A OG B:

Round 1-2: \*k2, p2\* rep from \* to \* the rest of the round. Round 3-4: \*p2, k2\* rep from \* to \* the rest of the round.

#### COWL:

On UK size 7 ( $4\frac{1}{2}$  mm) circular needles with 1 thread Mindful Fraya and 1 thread Friendly Fraya, loosely cast on 232 sts and work even in patt until the cowl measures approx. 30 cm. Cast off loosely. The cast on and cast off edge should be equally stretchy. Weave in the ends.

#### HAT:

On UK size 9 (3½ mm) circular needles cast on 96 sts with 1 thread of Mindful Fraya and 1 thread of Friendly Fraya, work 3 cm of rib, k1, p1.

Switch to size 4,5 mm needles and work in patt.

Round 1: \*K2, p1, yo\*, rep from \* to \* the rest of the round.

**Round 2:** \*K2, p1, p the yo through tbl\* rep from \* to \* the rest of the round, you now have 128 sts on the round.

Round 3 and 4: \*P2, k2\* rep from \* to \* the rest of the round.

Now work in patt as described above until the whole work measures 24 cm.

Now work dec:

Next round: \*K2tog, p2tog\* rep from \* to \* the rest of the round, you now have 64 sts on the round.

**Next round:** \*K1, p1\* rep from \* to \* the rest of the round.

**Next round:** \*k2tog, p2tog\* rep from \* to \* the rest of the round, you now have 32 sts on the round. Cast off the sts.

Weave in the ends, sew the hole on top by sewing between the sts and pulling, weave in the end.

#### YARN

Mindful Fraya 100% Wool 50 g = 350 m

+ Friendly Fraya

70% Super Kid Mohair + 30% Silk

25 q = 210 m

#### YARDAGE

#### Halsrør:

Mindful Fraya 75 g Friendly Fraya 65 g **Hue:** 

Mindful Fraya 50 g Friendly Fraya 45 q

### **GAUGE**

18 sts and 34 rows to  $10 \times 10$  cm in patt on size 4,5 mm needles with 1 thread of Mindful Fraya and 1 thread of Friendly Fraya.

#### SUGGESTED NEEDLE SIZE

UK size 9 and 7 ( $3\frac{1}{2}$  mm and  $4\frac{1}{2}$  mm) circular needles, 60/40 cm

Please note: The needle sizes given above are only suggestions. The size of the needles you need depends on your personal gauge. If you knit firmly you might need a large needle size, if you knit loosely you might need a smaller needle size.
