

#PLAINSAILINGSTRIPESSCARF

plain sailing stripes scarf



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ABBREVIATIONS:

st = stitch
k = knit
p = purl
r = row
es = edge stitch: To make a tidy edge, sl 1 at beg of each row and k the last stitch of every row

Using size 6 [5.0mm] knitting needles and two threads of Kid Mohair Col 1, cast on 38 sts. Next row: p with es on each side [see instructions above].

Next 16 rows: St st in Col 1 [k on RS and p on WS]. Next 4 rows: St st in Col 2. NB: es at both sides.

Repeat these 20 patt rows until the work measures approx. 152 cm. To finish, work 15 r St st in Col 1.

Cast off.

Weave in ends and press lightly.

MEASUREMENTS

22 x 160 cm

YARN

Fluffy Fraya

60% Kid Mohair + 40% Acrylic

50 g = 150 m

YARDAGE

Colour 1: 200 g

Colour 2: 50 g

GAUGE

17 sts x 19 r = 10 x 10 cm in stocking stitch on size 6 [5.0mm] knitting needles

SUGGESTED NEEDLE SIZE

Size 6 [5.0mm] knitting needles

Please note: The needle sizes given above are only suggestions. The size of the needles you need depends on your personal gauge. If you knit firmly you might need a large needle size, if you knit loosely you might need a smaller needle size.
