# happy feet slippers

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**ABBREVIATIONS:**

<b>k</b>	= Knit
<b>ndl</b>	= Needles
<b>rnd</b>	= Round
<b>st(s)</b>	= Stitch (s)
<b>tog</b>	= Together
<b>t</b>	= Knit twisted
<b>grove</b>	= One grove is 2 rounds of knit

The slippers are knitted in stocking stitch. Starting from the top and working down. The stitches are cast off at the middle of the sole.

Cast on 44 [46] 48 [50] 52 [54] 56 m on needles 5 mm, k 42 [44] 46 [48] 50 [52] 54 rnd stocking stitch, = 21 [22] 23 [24] 25 [26] 27 groves.

Place the 16 [17] 17 [18] 18 [19] 19 outer sts on each side on a stitch holder.

Now the upper foot are knitted first.

Continue to k the middle 12 [12] 14 [14] 16 [16] 18 sts, k 28 [32] 36 [40] 44 [48] 52 rnd stocking sts, = 14 [16] 18 [20] 22 [24] 26 groves.

K 2 sts tog in the beginning of the next 4 rnds, there are now 8 [8] 10 [10] 12 [12] 14 sts left and there are knitted total 16 [18] 20 [22] 24 [26] 28 groves on the middle sts.

Now the sides of the foot [from the stitch holder] are knitted.

K 16 [17] 17 [18] 18 [19] 19 sts from the stitch holder on the right side, pick up 16 [18] 20 [22] 24 [26] 28 sts from the middle piece [top of foot], K 8 [8] 10 [10] 12 [12] 14 sts from the middle piece, pick up 16 [18] 20 [22] 24 [26] 28 sts from along the other side of the middle piece, K the 16 [17] 17 [18] 18 [19] 19 sts from the stitch holder on the left side. There are now a total of 72 [78] 84 [90] 96 [102] 108 sts on needles.

K 12 [14] 14 [16] 16 [18] 18 rnds stocking sts = 6 [7] 7 [8] 8 [9] 9 groves, on the last rnd, place a stitch marker after 36 [39] 42 [45] 48 [51] 54 sts.

Now the sole are knitted.

1. rnd: K 2 sts tog, K until there is 3 [4] 5 [6] 7 [8] 9 sts left move the stitch marker, K 2 sts tog, K 2 [4] 6 [8] 10 [12] 14 sts, K 2 tog, K until there is 2 sts left on needles, K 2 tog.

2. rnd: K until there is 2 [3] 4 [5] 6 [7] 8 sts left before the stitch marker, K 2 tog, K 0 [2] 4 [6] 8 [10] 12 sts, K 2 tog, K the rest of the sts.

Continue above rnd 1 and 2 for a further 0 [1] 1 [2] 2 [3] 3 times but where the sts are reduced by 1 before the stitch marker, and the no of sts between the inc is reduced by 2 sts, there are now 66 [66] 72 [72] 78 [78] 84 sts left on needles.

Cast off.

Knit another slipper in the same way.

**FINISHING:**

Secure all ends. Sew the slippers together at the middle back and across the sole.

Slippers are felted in the washing machine at 40 degrees celsius with a towel so they look as if they are too small.

**TIP:** Try the slipper on while they are still wet to get the perfect pass form.

Try Sock Stop so they become non-skid.

**SIZES**

31/32 [33/34] 35/36 [37/38]  
39/40 [41/42] 43/44

**YARN**

Warm Fraya  
100% Wool  
50 g = 100 m

**YARDAGE**

150 [150] 150 [150]  
200 [200] 200 g

**GAUGE**

Work in stocking stitch on needles 5 mm  
15 st x 34 rnd = 10 x 10 cm

**SUGGESTED NEEDLE SIZE**

Needles nr. 5 mm

Please note: The needle sizes given above are only suggestions. The size of the needles you need depends on your personal gauge. If you knit firmly you might need a large needle size, if you knit loosely you might need a smaller needle size.

Stitch holders, optional Sock Stop
