tog = together Selv = Selvedge

= Selvedge stitch: Slip the first stitch of row purl-wise with the yarn held in front (without knitting it). Knit or purl the last stitch of the row as the chart shows.

PATTERN

Cast on 37 sts on a UK size 2 (7 mm) needle.

Work rib as follows:

Row 1 (WS): 1 selv, k1, *[p1, k1] twice, p1, k2*, repeat from * to * to end of row. **Row 2 (RS):** 1 selv, p1, *[k1, p1] twice, k1, p2*, repeat from * to * to end of row.

Continue in rib until the work measures 5 cm.

Now work in the charted lace pattern, remembering to work selv sts, until the work measures 185 cm. Work 5 cm in rib the same as at the beginning. Cast off all sts. Weave in the ends.

Approx. 30 cm x 190 cm

YARN

Happy Fraya 44% Baby Alpaca + 32% Fine Merino + 22% Polyamid + 2% Viscose 50 g = 110 m


YARDAGE

200 g

SUGGESTED NEEDLE SIZE

UK size 2 (7 mm)

Please note: The needle sizes given above are only suggestions. The size of the needles you need depends on your personal gauge. If you knit firmly you might need a large needle size, if you knit loosely you might need a smaller needle size.
