# Best friend beanie



♥ WARM YOUR EARS WITH THIS CHARMING AND COOL BEANIE. IF YOU ARE AN ADVANCED BEGINNER OR INTERMEDIATE KNITTER THIS HAT IS QUICKLY CONJURED - SO GET KNITTING AND HAVE FUN CHOOSING YOUR FAVOURITE COLOUR.



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**ABBREVIATIONS:**

<b>st(s)</b>	= stitch(es)
<b>k</b>	= knit
<b>p</b>	= purl
<b>RS</b>	= right side
<b>WS</b>	= wrong side
<b>tog</b>	= together
<b>tbl</b>	= through the back loop(s)

**PATTERN:**

Cast on 54 sts on a UK size 2 [7 mm] circular needle with colour 1 [cast on loosely, so the edge does not become too tight].

Begin by working a row before joining the work in the round as follows: \*k1, p1\*, repeat from \* to \* to end of row.

Now join the work in the round and place a marker for the beginning of the round.

Rib: \*k1, p1\*, repeat from \* to \* to end of round.

Work in rib until the work measures 11 cm.

Change to colour 2 and continue in rib until the work measures 25 cm. Place the following markers on the last round: Work 18 sts in rib, place marker work 18 sts in rib, place marker, work to end of round in rib.

The work is now divided into 3 sections with 18 sts in each.

Now work decreases as follows:

\*k3tog tbl, work in rib to 4 sts before marker, k3tog, p1, slip marker \*, repeat from \* to \* to end of round.

Work 1 round in rib.

Repeat the last 2 rounds until there are 18 sts left on the needle.

Break the yarn leaving a 30 cm long tail.

Pull the end through the remaining sts on the needle and pull tight. Weave in the end well, so it does not unravel.

Weave in all ends.

**MEASUREMENTS**

Circumference approx. 47 cm

Height approx. 31 cm

**YARN**

Comfy Fraya

50% Wool + 40% Acrylic + 10%

Alpaca

50 g = 80 m

**YARDAGE**

Colour 1: 50 g

Colour 2: 50 g

**GAUGE**

Gauge in rib on a UK size 2 [7 mm]

needle: 9 sts = 10 cm

**SUGGESTED NEEDLE SIZE**

UK size 2 [7 mm] circular needle, 40 cm

UK size 2 [7 mm] double-pointed needles

Please note: The needle sizes given above are only suggestions. The size of the needles you need depends on your personal gauge. If you knit firmly you might need a large needle size, if you knit loosely you might need a smaller needle size.
