

#CHRISTMASDINNERHATCHILD

Christmas dinner hat child





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ABBREVIATIONS:

st[s] = stitch(es)
k = knit
p = purl
RS = right side
WS = wrong side
tog = together

The hat is worked in the round on double-pointed needles or a circular needle.

Cast on 88 [92] 96 [100] sts on UK size 2½ [3 mm] double-pointed needles or a circular needle.

Join in the round and place a marker for the beginning of the round. Knit 2 rounds, then work 2 [2] 2 [3] cm of k1, p1 rib.

Change to stockinette stitch and a UK size 6 [4 mm] needle.

Work straight until the hat measures 10 [11] 12 [13] cm.

Work a round where 4 markers are placed 22 [23] 24 [25] sts apart.

Now work decreases every 6th round as follows:

Knit to marker, k2tog, repeat from * to * a total of 4 times.

Continue working decreases until there are 16 sts left on the needle. Work 5 rounds straight, then break the yarn.

Pull the yarn end through the 16 sts on the needle, pull tight and carefully weave in the end.

Make a pompon or a tassel and sew it to the end.

MEASUREMENTS

Head circumference in cm:

45 [47] 50 [52]

Length in cm, approx.:

45 [47] 50 [53]

YARN

Strong Fraya

100% Acrylic

100 g = 340 m

YARDAGE

100 [100] 100 [100] g

GAUGE

22 sts x 30 rows = 10 x 10 cm in
stockinette stitch

SUGGESTED NEEDLE SIZE

UK size 2½ [3 mm] and UK size 6 [4 mm] double-pointed needle, optionally UK size 2½ [3 mm] and UK size 6 [4 mm], 40 cm circular needles

Please note: The needle sizes given above are only suggestions. The size of the needles you need depends on your personal gauge. If you knit firmly you might need a large needle size, if you knit loosely you might need a smaller needle size.
