# coffee run clutch



FRAYA<sup>®</sup>

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**ABBREVIATIONS:**

**st(s)** = stitch(es)  
**db** = double crochet  
**cs** = chain stitch

**sls** = slip stitch  
**tog** = together

Work 15 cs.

Work 14 db, one in each cs but starting in the 2nd cs from the hook, 1 cs, turn.

Turn all rows with 1 cs, work 30 rows or 36 cm.

Cut the yarn.

Fold the bottom 13 cm and crochet tog the sides using sls, also crochet a row of sls around the flap of the clutch.

Weave in the ends.

Cut a piece of metal chain of about 125 cm and a piece of yarn of 170 cm for the strap.

Pull the yarn through the chain - start in the middle of the chain so that you do not "wear down" the yarn more than necessary. This is most easily done using a large needle.

Sew the strap on the clutch, sew on the snap button and button.

Cheerful Fraya  
55% Cotton + 45% Polyamide  
100 g = 50 m

**YARDAGE**

200 g

**SUGGESTED NEEDLE SIZE**

Size 10 mm [UK size 000] crochet  
hook

**NOTIONS**

Chain for the strap, 1 metal snap  
button, 1 button
