## BEAR

## HEAD:

Cast on 12 sts on the UK size 13-12 [ 2 ¹/2 mm] double pointed needles, divide them so that you have 3 sts on each of 4 needles.
Round 1: K
Round 2: *k1, yo, k2, yo, k1* rep from * to * a total of 3 times
Round 3: K18
Round 4: *k1, yo, k4, yo, k1* rep from * to * a total of 3 times
Round 5-8: K24
Round 9: *k1, yo* rep from * to * the entire round
Round 10-19: K48
Round 20: *k2tog, k6* rep from * to * the entire round
Round 22: К42
Round 23: *k2tog, k5* rep from * to * the entire round
Round 24: K36
Round 25: *k2tog, k4* rep from * to * the entire round
Round 26: K30
Round 27: *k2tog, k3* rep from * to * the entire round
Round 28: K24
Round 29: *k2tog, k2* rep from * to * the entire round
Round 30: K18
Round 31: *k2tog, k1* rep from * to * the entire round
Cut the yarn and pull the yarn through the last 12 sts but do not pull yet.
Now pull the yarn end from the start through the cast on sts, pull tight and weave in the end.
Fill the head with fiber filling, pull tight and weave in the end.
Sew a thread through the 8th round [the last round with 24 sts], pull lightly to form a snout, tie a secure knot, weave in the ends.

## BEAR EARS:

Cast on 18 sts on the UK size 13-12 [ $2^{1 ⁄ 2} \mathrm{~mm}$ ] double pointed needles, divide them onto 4 needles. K 5 rounds even
Round 6: *k2togtbl, k5, k2tog* rep from * to * one more time
Round 7: K14
Round 8: *k2togtbl, k3, k2tog* rep from * to * one more time
Round 9: *k2togtbl, k1, k2tog* rep from * to * one more time
Cut the yarn and pull the yarn through the last 6 sts, pull tightly and weave in the end well.
Knit another ear in the same way, sew them on the head.
Embroider face on the head with leftover black yarn.

## LOVEY:

Cast on 24 sts on the UK size 11 [ 3 mm ] needles and divide them so that you have 8 sts on each of 3 needles.
Round 1: K
Round 2: * k1tbl, yo, k3, yo, k1tbl, yo, k3, yo* rep from * to * another 2 times
Round 3: *k1tbl, yo, k1, k3tog, k1, yo, k1tbl, yo, k1, k3tog, k1, yo*
Round 4: * k1tbl, yo, k5, yo, k1tbl, yo, k5, yo*
Round 5: *k1tbl, yo, k2, k3tog, k2, yo, k1tbl, yo, k2, k3tog, k2, yo*
Round 6: * k1tbl, yo, k7, yo, k1tbl, yo, k7, yo*

approx. 35 cm

## YARN

Colourful Fraya
100\% Cotton
$50 \mathrm{~g}=170 \mathrm{~m}$

## YARDAGE

50 g

## GAUGE

24 sts and 36 rows to $10 \times 10 \mathrm{~cm}$ in st st on size 3.0 mm needles

## SUGGESTED NEEDLE SIZE

UK size 13-12 and 11 [ $2^{1 ⁄ 2}$ and 10 mm ], double pointed needles, UK size 11 ( 3 mm ], 60 cm circular needles

Please note: The needle sizes given above are only suggestions. The size of the needles you need depends on your personal gauge. If you knit firmly you might need a large needle size, if you knit loosely you might need a smaller needle size.

## NOTIONS

approx 15 g of fibre filling, blacck left over yarn for face

Round 7: *k1tbl, yo, k3, k3tog, k3, yo, k1tbl, yo, k3, k3tog, k3, yo*
Round 8: * k1tbl, yo, k9, yo, k1tbl, yo, k9, yo*
Round 9: *k1tbl, yo, k4, k3tog, k4, yo, k1tbl, yo, k4, k3tog, k4, yo*
Round 10: * k1tbl, yo, k11, yo, k1tbl, yo, k11, yo*
Round 11: *k1tbl, yo, k5, k3tog, k5, yo, k1tbl, yo, k5, k3tog, k5, yo*
Round 12: * k1tbl, yo, k13, yo, k1tbl, yo, k13, yo*
Round 13: *k1tbl, yo, k6, k3tog, k6, yo, k1tbl, yo, k6, k3tog, k6, yo*
Round 14: * k1tbl, yo, k15, yo, k1tbl, yo, k15, yo*

Round 38: * k1tbl, yo, k35, yo, k1tbl, yo, k35, yo*
Round 39: *k1tbl, yo, k17, k3tog, k17, yo, k1tbl, yo, k17, k3tog, k17, yo*

## Round 40: P

Round 41: * k1tbl, yo, k37, yo, k1tbl, yo, k37, yo*
Round 42: *k1tbl, yo, k18, k3tog, k18, yo, k1tbl, yo, k18, k3tog, k18, yo*
Round 43: P
Round 44: K
Round 45: P
Cast off all sts loosely.
Pull the yarn end in the middle though the cast on sts and pull to that the hole is closed. Weave in the end well.
Weave in the ends.
Sew the head on in the middle of the lovey.

## DOG EARS:

Cast on 10 sts UK size 13-12 [ $21 / 2 \mathrm{~mm}$ ] needles.
Row 1: Slip 2 sts with the yarn in from, k8
Repeat row 1 a total of 14 times
Row 15: Slip 2 sts with the yarn in from, k2tog, k2, k2tog, k2
Row 16: Slip 2 sts with the yarn in from, k6
Row 17: Slip 2 sts with the yarn in from, k2tog, k2tog, k2
Row 18: Slip 2 sts with the yarn in from, k4
Row 19: Slip 2 sts with the yarn in from, k2tog, k2
Cut the yarn and pull the yarn end through the 5 sts, pull tightly and weave in the end well. Knit another ear in the same way, sew them on the head.
Embroider face on the head with leftover black yarn.
