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ABBREVIATIONS:

st(s)	= stitch(es)	rep	= repeat
db	= double crochet	rem	= remain
sls	= slip stitch	tog	= together
cs	= chain stitch	dec	= decrease
beg	= beginning	co	= colour

DEC: To create a neat, invisible dec (crochet 2 db tog) do as follows: insert the hook into the front loop on the next two db, yo, pull the yarn through both loops, yo, pull the yarn through two loops = 2 db crochet tog.

BEAR**THE PART AROUND THE RING:**

Work 24 cs. Starting in the 2nd loop from the needle work 23 db.

Turn each row with 1 cs. Work 8 rows, cut the yarn but let the end be long enough so that you can use it for sewing around the ring.

HEAD:

Work 6 db in a magic ring.

Round 1: 2 db in each db = 12 db.

Round 2: *1 db in the first db, 2 db in the next db* rep from * to * = 18 db

Round 3: *1 db in the first 2 db, 2 db in the next db* rep from * to * = 24 db

Round 4: *1 db in the first 3 db, 2 db in the next db* rep from * to * = 30 db

Round 5: *1 db in the first 4 db, 2 db in the next db* rep from * to * = 36 db

Round 6: *1 db in the first 5 db, 2 db in the next db* rep from * to * = 42 db

Round 7-11: 1 db in each db = 42 db

Round 12: *1 db in the first 5 db, crochet 2 db tog (see explanation at the top)* rep from * to * = 36 db

Round 13: *1 db in the first 4, crochet 2 db tog (see explanation at the top)* rep from * to * = 30 db

Round 14: *1 db in the first 3 db, crochet 2 db tog (see explanation at the top)* rep from * to * = 24 db

Fill with fiber filling and put the rattle box in the head.

Round 15: *1 db in the first 2 db, crochet 2 db tog (see explanation at the top)* rep from * to * = 18 db

Round 16: *1 db in the first db, crochet 2 db tog (see explanation at the top)* rep from * to * = 12 db

Cut the yarn. The nose is to be sewn over this hole.

If necessary put a bit more fiber filling in the head.

NOSE:

Work 6 db in a magic ring.

Round 1: 2 db in each db = 12 db.

Round 2: *1 db in the first db, 2 db in the next db* rep from * to * = 18 db

Round 3: *1 db in the first 2 db, 2 db in the next db* rep from * to * = 24 db

Round 4-6: 1 db in each db = 24 db.

Cut the yarn. Sew the nose across the hole in the head.

EARS:

Work 6 db in a magic ring.

Round 1: 2 db in each db = 12 db.

Round 2: 1 db in each db = 12 db.

Round 3: *1 db in the first db, 2 db in the next db* rep from * to * = 18 db

Round 4-6: 1 db in each db = 18 db.

YARN

Colourful Fraya

100% Cotton

50 g = 170 m

YARDAGE

Col. 1: 50 g

Col. 2: 50 g

CROCHET GAUGE

25 db = 10 cm

SUGGESTED NEEDLE SIZE

Crochet needle UK size 13/12 [2½ mm]

Please note: It is important to obtain gauge. The work should have a close texture. Try with a smaller or larger needle if necessary.

NOTIONS

Black and white left over yarn, fiber filling, rattle box, wooden ring

Round 7: *1 db in the first db, crochet 2 db tog* rep from * to * = 12 db
Cut the yarn. Crochet another ear. Fold the ear double and sew it on the head.

FINISHING:

Sew the crochet piece around the ring with invisible sts. With black yarn embroider eyes, nose and mouth, see front page.

Sew the bears head on the ring. Make sure it is securely fastened on there.

BAMBI

THE PART AROUND THE RING:

Work 24 cs. Starting in the 2nd loop from the needle work 23 db.

Turn each row with 1 cs. Work 8 rows, cut the yarn but let the end be long enough so that you can use it for sewing around the ring.

HEAD:

With cream co yarn work 8 db in a magic ring.

Round 2: *1 db in the first db, 2 db in the next db* rep from * to * = 12 db

Round 3-4: 1 db in each db = 12 db.

Change to co 2.

Round 5: *1 db in each of the next 2 db, 2 db in the next db* rep from * to * = 16 db

Round 6: 1 db in the first 4 db, 2 db in the next db, 1 db in the next db, 2 db in the next db, 1 db in the next 2 db, 2 db in the next db, 1 db in the next db, 2 db in the next db, 1 db in the next 4 db = 20 db

Round 7: 1 db in the first 4 db, 2 db in the next db, 1 db in the next 3 db, 2 db in the next db, 1 db in the next 2 db, 2 db in the next db, 1 db in the next 3 db, 2 db in the next db, 1 db in the next 4 db = 24 db

Round 8: 1 db in each db = 24 db.

Round 9: 1 db in the next 7 db, 2 db in the next db, 1 db in the next 8 db, 2 db in the next db, 1 db in the next 7 db = 26 db

Round 10: 1 db in the first 6 db, 2 db in the next db, 1 db in the next 3 db, 2 db in the next db, 1 db in the next 4 db, 2 db in the next db, 1 db in the next 3 db, 2 db in the next db, 1 db in the next 6 db = 30 db

Round 11: 1 db in each db = 30 db

Round 12: 1 db in the first 11 db, 2 db in the next db, 1 db in the next 6 db, 2 db in the next db, 1 db in the next 11 db = 32 db

Round 13: 1 db in each db = 32 db

Round 14: 1 db in the first 10 db, 2 db in the next db, 1 db in the next 10 db, 2 db in the next db, 1 db in the next 10 db = 34 db

Round 15-16: 1 db in each db = 34 db

Round 17: 1 db in the first 7 db, crochet 2 db tog, 1 db in the next 4 db, crochet 2 db tog, 1 db in the next 4 db, crochet 2 db tog, 1 db in the next 4 db, crochet 2 db tog, 1 db in the next 7 db = 30 db

Round 18: *1 db in the first 3 db, crochet 2 db tog* rep from * to * = 24 db

Fill fiber filling and the rattle box in the head.

Round 19: *1 db in the first 2 db, crochet 2 db tog* rep from * to * = 18 db

Round 20: *1 db in the first db, crochet 2 db tog* rep from * to * = 12 db

Round 21: Crochet the db tog 2 and 2 until 6 db rem. Cut the yarn and leave a tail long enough to sew the hole.

EAR:

Work 6 db in a magic ring.

Round 1: 2 db in the first db, 1 db in the next db* rep from * to * = 9 db.

Round 2-3: 1 db in each db = 9 db

Round 4: 1 db in the first 2 db, 2 db in the next db* rep from * to * = 12 db.

Round 5-6: 1 db in each db = 12 db

Round 7: 1 db in the first 2 db, crochet 2 db tog* rep from * to * = 9 db.

Round 8: 1 db in each db = 9 db

Cut the yarn. Crochet another ear. Sew them on the head.

EYES:

With black co yarn work 6 db in a magic ring. Cut the yarn.

Change to white. Insert the needle into the first db, work 1 sls with the white yarn. Now work 2 db in each of the black db from the previous round. End with one sls. Sew a couple of sts with the white yarn in the middle of the eye. Crochet another eye in the same way and sew them on the head.

FINISHING: Sew the crochet piece around the ring with invisible sts. Embroider a snout with black yarn. Embroider with white yarn dots with French knots on the cheeks and on the part around the ring. Sew the head on the ring. Make sure it is securely fastened on there.
