MODEL A:

Bottom:

Crochet 44 cs.

Round 1: 2 db in the 2nd cs from the hook, 41 db, 4 db in the next cs, cont by working across the underside of the db that you just worked, 41 cs, 3 db in the next cs [the same as the first st of the 2 db), a total of 92 db.

tr

Round 2: 2 db in each of the next 2 sts, 42 db, 2 db in each of the next 4 sts, 42 db, 2 db in each of the next 2db, a total of 100 db, place a mrk thread and let it follow up through the work.

Round 3: 1 db, 2 db in the next st, 1 db, 2 db in the next st, 43 db, *2 db in the next st, 1 db* rep from * to * a total of 3 times, 2 db in the next st, 43 db, 2 db in the next st, 1 db, 2 db in the next db, a total of 108 db.

Round 4: 2 db, 2 db in the next st, 2 db, 2 db in the next st, 44 db, *2 db in the next st, 2 db* rep from * to * a total of 3 times, 2 db in the next st, 44 db, 2 db in the next st, 2 db, 2 db in the next db, a total of 116 db.

Round 5: 3 db, 2 db in the next st, 3 db, 2 db in the next st, 45 db, *2 db in the next st, 3 db* rep from * to * a total of 3 times, 2 db in the next st, 45 db, 2 db in the next st, 3 db, 2 db in the next db, a total of 124 db.

Round 6: 124 db.

Round 7: 2 db, 2 db in the next st, 4 db, 2 db in the next st, 46 db, *2 db in the next st, 4 db* rep from * to * a total of 3 times, 2 db in the next st, 46 db, 2 db in the next st, 4 db, 2 db in the next db,

Round 8: 3 db, 2 db in the next st, 5 db, 2 db in the next st, 47 db, *2 db in the next st, 5 db* rep from * to * a total of 3 times, 2 db in the next st, 47 db, 2 db in the next st, 5 db, 2 db in the next db, 2 db, a total of 140 db.

Round 9: 140 db.

Round 10: 3 db, 2 db in the next st, 6 db, 2 db in the next st, 48 db, *2 db in the next st, 6 db* rep from * to * a total of 3 times, 2 db in the next st, 48 db, 2 db in the next st, 6 db, 2 db in the next db, 3 db. a total of 148 db.

Round 11: 4 db, 2 db in the next st, 7 db, 2 db in the next st, 49 db, *2 db in the next st, 7 db* rep from * to * a total of 3 times, 2 db in the next st, 49 db, 2 db in the next st, 7 db, 2 db in the next db, 3 db, a total of 156 db.

Round 12: 156 db.

Round 13: 4 db, 2 db in the next st, 8 db, 2 db in the next st, 50 db, *2 db in the next st, 8 db* rep from * to * a total of 3 times, 2 db in the next st, 50 db, 2 db in the next st, 8 db, 2 db in the next db,

Round 14: 5 db, 2 db in the next st, 9 db, 2 db in the next st, 51 db, *2 db in the next st, 9 db* rep from * to * a total of 3 times, 2 db in the next st, 51 db, 2 db in the next st, 9 db, 2 db in the next db, 4 db, a total of 172 db.

Round 15: 5 db, 2 db in the next st, 10 db, 2 db in the next st, 52 db, *2 db in the next st, 10 db* rep from * to * a total of 3 times, 2 db in the next st, 52 db, 2 db in the next st, 10 db, 2 db in the next db, 5 db, a total of 180 db.

Side:

Round 17-31: 180 db, when you crochet in the round, the beg of the round can move so fold the bottom/side and crochet to the side of the net, crochet the last st as a sls.

The round now starts here.

Crochet patt according to chart 1 or 2, all the rounds start with 3 cs which takes the place of a tr and all the rounds are finished with a sls in the top of the 3 sc. Rep the chart a total of 6 times around.

Work even in patt until the chart has been worked 3 times vertically.

Now crochet 15 rounds of db across the 180 sts, finish on the side with 1 db, cut the yarn. Weave in the ends. Sew on the straps, there should be about 18-19 cm between the straps.

Colourful Frava 100 % Cotton 50 q = 170 m

CROCHET GAUGE

28 db = 10 cm

SUGGESTED NEEDLE SIZE

Uk size 13-12 (2.5 mm) crochet

Please note: It is important to obtain gauge. The work should have a close texture. Try with a smaller or larger needle if necessary.

NOTIONS

A: Leather straps

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MODEL B:

Crochet 89 cs.

Round 1: Crochet 2 db in the second st from the hook, 86 db, 4 db in the last db, now work 89 db at the bottom of the cs chain, end with 2 db in the last st, a total of 180 db.

Work a total of 15 rounds of db, when you crochet in the round the beg of the round can move so fold the bottom and crochet to the side of the net, crochet the last st as a sls.

The round now starts here.

Crochet patt according to chart 1 or 2, all the rounds start with 3 cs which takes the place of a tr and all the rounds are finished with a sls in the top of the 3 sc. Rep the chart a total of 6 times around.

Work even in patt until the chart has been worked 3 times vertically.

Now crochet 7 rounds of db across the 180 sts, fold the net and crochet to the side of the net, 30 db, crochet 30 cs (for the strap), skip 30 sts, 60 db, crochet 30 cs (for the strap), skip 30 sts, 30 db. Work db across all sts.

When you have worked a total of 15 rounds of db after the patt, finish with 1 sls, cut the yarn.

Variation:

If you want longer straps continue to crochet cs until the strap has the desired length, but still only skip 30 sts. On the next round work 1 db in each cs.






Filet crochet:

Filet crochet consists of a net (alternating between 1 tr and 2 cs) where motifs are crochet to fill out the holes of the net with 2 tr instead of 2 cs, i.e. so that the gitter patt consists of either $3 \, \text{tr}$ or $1 \, \text{tr}$ and $2 \, \text{cs}$.







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
