PRAM MOBILE

WHALE:

Body:

Work 6 db in a magic ring.

Round 2: 2 db in each db = 12 db.

Round 3: *1 db in the first db, 2 db in the next db* rep from * to * = 18 db Round 4: *1 db in the first 2 db, 2 db in the next db* rep from * to * = 24 db Round 5: *1 db in the first 3 db, 2 db in the next db* rep from * to * = 30 db Round 6: *1 db in the first 4 db, 2 db in the next db* rep from * to * = 36 db

Round 7: 1 db in each db = 36 db

Round 8: *1 db in the first 5 db, 2 db in the next db* rep from * to * = 42 db

Round 9-12: 1 db in each db = 42 db, 1 sls, cut the yarn.

Stomach:

Crochet 7 cs, turn and start in the 2nd cs from the hook and crochet 5 db back. In the 6th cs crochet 3 db, crochet around the end and back on the other side, crochet 6 db, 3 db in the last st. Place a mrk thread here to mrk the beg of the round.

You now have 16 db on the round.

Round 2: 5 db, 2 db on the next db, 1 db, 2 db in the next db, 5 db, 2 db in the next db, 1 db, 2 db in the next db = 20 db.

Round 3: 6 db, 2 db in each of the next 3 db, 7 db, 2 db in each of the next 3 db, 1 db = 26 db.

Round 4: 8 db, 2 db in the next db, 1 db, 2 db in the next db, 10 db, 2 db in the next db, 1 db, 2 db in the next db = 30 db.

Round 5: 8 db, 2 db in the next db, 1 db, 2 db in the next db, 1 db, 2 db in the next db, 10 db, 2 db in the next db, 1 db, 2 db in the next db, 1 db, 2 db in the next db = 36 db.

Round 6: 10 db, 2 db in the next db, 1 db (you are still 2 sts from the mrk thread) = 42 db on the whole round.

Do not cut the yarn.

Now place the bottom of the whale on top of the hole on the body, WS against WS. Now crochet together the parts by crocheting through both layers, crochet 32 db. Start where the yarn for the stomach ends.

There is now a hole left of about 20 db, with sts from both the stomach and the body, crochet the tail fin across these 20 sts.

Fill the whale with fiber filling.

Tail fin:

Round 1: 9 db, 2 db tog, 8 db, 2 db tog = 18 db. Place a mrk thread.

Round 2: 8 db, 2 db toq, 7 db, 2 db toq = 16 db.

Round 3: 1 db in each db = 16 db.

Round 4: Crochet 4 db, skip 8 db, crochet the last 4 db on the round. You have divided the work in two, with 8 sts for each side. Crochet the two sides separately.

1st half:

Round 5: 1 db in each db = 8 db.

Round 6: *1 db in the first db, 2 db in the next db* rep from * to * = 12 db.

Round 7: 13 db (1 db pass the mrk).

Round 8: *1 db in the first 2 db, 2 db in the next db* rep from * to * = 16 db.

Round 9: 1 db in each db = 16 db.

Round 10: *1 db in the first 2 db, 2 db tog* rep from * to * = 12 db.

Round 11: 1 db in each db = 12 db.

Round 12: *1 db in the first db, 2 db tog* rep from * to * = 8 db.

Round 13: 2 db tog x 4 = 4 db. Cut the yarn and sew the hole neatly.

The other tail fin is crochet across the other 8 sts. Start with round 5.

YARN

Colourful Fraya 100 % Cotton 50 g = 170 m

YARDAGE

Pram mobile: 50 g Teether: 50 g

CROCHET GAUGE

25 fm = 10 cm

SUGGESTED NEEDLE SIZE

UK size 13-12 (2.5) crochet hook

Please note: It is important to obtain gauge. The work should have a close texture. Try with a smaller or larger needle if necessary.

NOTIONS

Pram mobile: Suspender clips, round elastic 3 mm, fiber filling, leftover black and white yarn.

Teether: Fiber filling, leftover black and white yarn, Wooden ring (439 75)

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Back fin:

Work 6 db in a magic ring.

Round 2: *2 db in the first db, 1 db in the next db* rep from * to * = 9 db

Round 3: 1 db in each db = 9 db.

Round 4: *2 db in the first db, 1 db in the next 2 db* rep from * to * = 12 db

Round 5-6: 1 db in each db = 12 db.

End with 1 sls, cut the yarn and crochet another fin the same way. Sew them on the side of the whale.

Fountain:

Crochet 7 cs, turn and start in the 2nd cs from the hook and crochet 4 sls \cdot crochet 5 cs, turn and start in the 2nd cs from the hook and crochet 4 sls \cdot rep from \cdot to \cdot one more time.

Crochet 2 sls in the last 2 cs from the start. Cut the yarn and sew the fountain on the top of the whale.

With black yarn embroider eyes on each side of the whale's head.

CLOUD:

Crochet 15 cs, turn and start in the 2nd cs from the hook and crochet 13 db. In the last cs crochet 3 db, crochet around the end and crochet 13 db, 3 db in the last cs = 32 db. Place a mrk at the beg of the round

Round 2: *13 db, 2 db in the next db, 1 db, 2 db in the next db* rep from * to * one more time = 36 db

Round 3: 14 db, 2 db in the next db, 1 db, 2 db in the next db, 15 db, 2 db in the next db, 1 db, 2 db in the next db, 1 db = 40 db.

Round 4-6: 1 db in each db = 40 db.

First bump on the cloud:

Round 7: 12 db, place another mrk, now crochet 12 db and 2 cs, move the hook to the mrk and work in the round across the 12 db + 2 cs = 14 db. The new round starts after the 2 cs.

Round 8: 1 db in each db = 14 db.

Round 9: 2 db, 2 db tog, 2 db, 2 db tog, 2 db, 2 db tog, 2 db = 11 db.

Round 10: *1 db, 2 db tog* rep from * to * a total of 3 times, 2 db = 8 db.

Round 11: 2 db tog the entire round = 4 db

Cut the yarn and sew the hole neatly with the yarn end.

Middle bump on the cloud:

Round 1: Place the hook in the 5th db from the first mrk, in this db work: 1 cs, cont and work 7 db, 2 db in the 2 cs that were worked when working the first bump. Cont in the round and work 8 db, 2 cs. Now work in the round across the 20 db in total. The cs that were worked first is the first db.

Round 2-3: 1 db in each db = 20 db.

Round 4: *3 db, 2 db tog* a total of 4 times = 16 db.

Round 5: *2 db, 2 db tog* a total of 4 times = 12 db.

Round 6: *1 db, 2 db tog* a total of 4 times = 8 db.

Round 7: 2 db tog the entire round = 4 db.

Cut the yarn and sew the hole neatly with the yarn end.

Now fill fiber filling in the cloud before working the last bump.

The last bump on the cloud:

Place the hook after the middle bump, work 1 cs, 11 db (the cs is the first db on the round). 2 db in the 2 cs that were worked on the middle bump = 14 db. Work another round of 14 db. Now work in the same way as the first bump on the cloud. Fill in a bit more fiber filling in the cloud before closing the hole neatly.

Weave in the ends and shape the cloud with your hands. Work a row of cs and attach it to the top of the cloud for hanging.

Make 2 clouds in total.

DROP:

Work 6 db in a magic ring.

Round 1: 2 db in each db = 12 db.

Round 2: 1 db in each db = 12 db.

Round 3: *1 db in the first db, 2 db in the next db* rep from * to * = 18 db

Round 4: 1 db in each db = 18 db.

Round 5: *1 db in the first 2 db, 2 db in the next db* rep from * to * = 24 db

Round 6: 1 db in each db = 24 db.

Round 7: *1 db in the first 5 db, 2 db in the next db* rep from * to * = 28 db

Round 8: 1 db in each db = 28 db.

Round 9: *1 db in the first 5 db, 2 db tog* rep from * to * = 24 db

Round 10: 1 db in each db = 24 db.

Round 11: *1 db in the first 4 db, 2 db tog* rep from * to * = 20 db

Round 12: 1 db in each db = 20 db.

Round 13: *1 db in the first 3 db, 2 db tog* rep from * to * = 16 db

Round 14-15: 1 db in each db = 16 db.

Fill the drop with fiber filling. When the drop is finished it does not need to have filling in the top so



its only necessary to fill the bottom well while shaping the drop neatly.

Round 16: *1 db in the first 2 db, 2 db tog* rep from * to * = 12 db

Round 17: 1 db in each db = 12 db.

Round 18: *1 db in the first db, 2 db tog* rep from * to * = 8 db

Round 19: 2 db tog 4 times. The hole at the top is now closed. Crochet 10 cs. Cut the yarn.

Crochet a total of 2 drops.

Finishing:

Pull the wooden beads on the round elastic, measure to make sure that the finished mobile fits the stroller/pram, tie a suspender clip on both ends of the elastic, attach the crochet elements to the chain.

TEETHER

Crochet a whale, see model A.

Piece to connect to the wooden ring:

Crochet 12 cs, turn and start in the 2nd cs from the hook and crochet 11 sts back.

*turn with 1 cs, crochet 11 db * rep from * to * until you have 11 rows or the work can reach around the ring tightly. Sew the piece around the ring. Sew the whale securely on the crochet piece.
